





#### **General Information about Emirate of Ajman**


Ajman Emirate consists of three different and separated regions as per the topographic and its distance from Arab gulf These regions are Ajman city, Masafwat region-Manama region. The Emirate is characterized by moderate climate and humidity. Humidity increases during summer but in winter, the temperature drops.

#### **Ajman City**

Ajman City is the capital of the Emirate where the residence of Ajman's ruler as well as other governmental departments, companies, banks, and factories are located, its seaport and port overlooks the Arabian Gulf coast. Owing to its strategic location and economic growth, Ajman City has become a center of attraction forinvestors and entrepreneurs, facilitating amasterful renaissance, characterized by a unique blend of modern architecture and ancestral heritage.



#### **Masfout Region**

The Masfout Region is about 110 kilometers to the southeast, and consists of the City of Masfout, as well as the Mazeyrah Region and Al Sabgah. Its residents are descendants of prominent tribes, such as the Bedouin tribe and the Bani Ka'eb tribe. The region is known for its fertile soil, expansive valleys and mild climate, making Masfout Region a magnet for tourism. The region is also characterized by its magnificent natural scenery, boasting with high mountains such as Mount Dafta, Mount Leshan and the White Mountain. Some of the most prominent wide valleys in the region include the Ghalfa Valley, Al-Sawmar Valley, Masfout Valley, Khanfariyah, and the Wadi dafda



#### **Manama Region**

The Manama Region It is about 60 KM far from Ajman towards east. Along the road there is a route passing by sharjah and Fujairah Emirates. At Manama there is a level full of stones and sands. Manama area is characterized by the breathtaking nature where the high mountains are full of Magnesium and curium and building bricks. Its valleys are known to be very fertile and productive.

Figure (1-1): Live Births & Deaths in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019







Figure (1-2): Vital Statistics by Gender & Nationality in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019







Figure (1-3): Live Births by Gender, Nationality and Month of Birth in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019






Figure (1-4): Deaths by Gender, Nationality and Month in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019








Figure (1-5): Deaths by Age Groups in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019

#### Figure (1-6): Marriage Contracts in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






# Figure (1-7): Marriage Contracts by Nationality of Husband & Wife in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019





## Figure (3-4): New and Renew Licenses in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2017–2019








Figure (4-1): Renewal Licenses for Companies in Ajman Free Zone by Months during the Years 2017-2019






#### Figure (4-2): Free Zone Affiliates by License Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2017-2019








Figure (5-2): Tenancy Contracts Registered by Nationality in the Emirate of Ajman for Masfout and Manama Region during the Year 2019





# Figure (5-3): Number of Building Licenses Issued, Classified by Building Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






# Figure (5-4): \*Certificates of Achievement Issued by Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019



### Figure (5-9): Number of Sales of Real Estate Units by Project Name in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019











Figure (6-3): Public Parks Data in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019

#### Figure (6-5): Landscaping and Green Spaces Data in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019







Figure (6-6): Productivity of the Agriculture by Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019


## Figure (6-12): Number of Sheeps by Gender and Age in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2018



#### Figure (8-2): Classrooms Classified by Level of Government Education in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Years 2017/2018-2019/2020








Figure (8-3): Classrooms Classified by Level of Private Education in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Years 2017/2018-2019/2020




#### Figure (8-4): Students by Level of Government Education, Nationality and type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Year 2019/2020






### Figure (8-5): Students by Level of Private Education, Nationality and Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Year 2019/2020




#### Figure (8-7): Students by Level of Technical Education in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Years 2017/2018-2019/2020


#### Figure (8-8): Distribution of Teachers by Level of Government Education by Gender in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Year 2019/2020




### Figure (8-9): Distribution of Teachers by Level of Private Education in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Year 2019/2020


## Figure (8-12): Graduate Students at Ajman University of (Ajman Branch) Classified by Nationality during the Academic Years 2016/2017-2019/2020


#### Figure (8-13): Graduate Students from Colleges Ajman University of (Ajman Branch) by Nationality and Gender during the Academic Year 2019/2020





#### Figure (8-15): Registered Female Students By Nationality at University College for Mother and Family Science during the Academic Years 2016/2017-2019/2020






## Figure (8-16): Registered Female Students by Nationality at University College for Mother and Family Science during the Academic Years 2016/2017-2019/2020




#### Figure (8-17): Female Students Registered at University College for Mother and Family Science By specialty during the Academic Year 2019/2020


#### Figure (8-18): Students Enrolled at the City University College of Ajman by Nationality and Gender during the Academic Years 2016/2017-2019/2020






### Figure (8-20): Graduate Students at City University College in Ajman Classified by Nationality during the Academic Years 2016/2017-2019/2020






Figure (8-22): Total of Higher Education Institutions by Sector in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Year 2019/2020




Figure (9-1): Summary of the Statistics of Khalifa Medical City in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2017–2019	105






Figure (9-6): New and Repeated Cases of Patients at Khalifa Hospital and Khalifa Hospital for Women and Childbirth by Specialty, Type and Nationality in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019








#### Figure (10-2): Activities of Health Division Municipality & Planning Department in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019




#### Figure (10-3): Results of Food Laboratory Analysis in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






#### Figure (10-4): Number of Tests that have been Conducted by the Municipality & Planning Department by Type of Analysis in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






#### Figure (10-5): Fines and Warnings Issued by the Municipality General Hygiene Department in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019





#### Figure (10-6): Samples Tested in Ajman Municipality Laboratory during the Years 2016-2019






## Figure (10-7): Health Division Activities in Ajman Municipality and Planning Department by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019




#### Figure (10-8): Total Processing Quantities of Ajman Sewerage (private) Limited by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






#### Figure (10-9): Quantities of Non-Hazardous Industrial, Household, Commercial and Medical Wastes in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019




Figure (10-10): Quantity of Wastes Received for the Waste Recycling Plant and the Amount of Waste that has been Sorted or Converted to Organic Fertilizer in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019


#### Figure (10-14): Environmental Protection Section Statistics in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019












### Figure (10-20): Monthly Average and Maximum Value of Nitrogen Dioxide Concentration by Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019




Figure (10-21): Wastewater Treatment Plant Cccording to the Design Water Capacity, the Actual Water Vapacity and the Volume of Treated Water Produced in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2015-2019






# Figure (10-22): Wastewater Treatments Plant According to the Designed and Actual Organic Capacity and Quantity of Produced Dried Sludge in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019





#### Figure (11-2): Traffic Accidents According to the Degree of Injury and Deaths during the Years 2016-2019






Figure (11-3): Traffic Accidents According to the Degree of Injury and Deaths by Months during the Year 2019

#### Figure (11-4): Number of Registered and Renewed Vehicles' Licenses during the Years 2016-2019







Figure (11-5): Registered Vehicles (Renewal and 1st Time Registration) and Transferred Vehicles to Other Emirates during the years 2016-2019






#### Figure (11-6): Issued Driving Licenses in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






### Figure (11-7): Vehicles and Technical Equipment of the Department of Civil Defense by Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






#### Figure (11-8): Annual Training Courses and Their Attendees of Civil Defense Department in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019





#### Figure (11-9): Fire, Drowning, Rescue and Ambulance Reports in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019






### Figure (11-10): Public Administration Centers for Civil Defense by Regions in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2017-2019

Figure (12-1): Number of Mosques in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019







Figure (12-2): Mosques Employees by Occupation and Nationality in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019


#### Figure (12-5): Quran Memorization Centers by Regions in Ajman Emirate during the Years 2016-2019


#### Figure (12-8): Distribution of Mosques by the Source of Construction in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016–2019




# Figure (13-3): Number of Hotels Establishments, Beds and Rooms in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2019–2018






# Figure (13-4): Hotel Room & Hotel Apartments Occupancy in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019





# Figure (13-5): Number of Guests in Hotels and Hotel Apartments by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016–2019












### Figure (13-6): Number of Ajman Museum Visitors during the Years 2016-2019



Figure (15-2): Total Cash Withdrawal from ATMS of Banks in Ajman during the Year 2019 190




### Figure (15-1): Total ATMs of Banks in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2019






# Figure (16-1): \*Beneficiaries of Projects and Initiavities from Humaid Bin Rashid Al Nuaimi Charity during the Years 2018-2019







### Figure (16-2): \*Beneficiaries of Assistance from Humaid Bin Rashid Al Nuaimi Charity during the Years 2018-2019






# Figure (16-3): Rehabilitation of Disabled People by Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019

# Figure (16-4): Beneficiaries by Type of Assistance of Dar Al Ber Society in Ajman Branch during the Years 2016-2019






# Figure (16-5): Programs and Projects of Dar Al Ber Society in Ajman Branch during the Years 2016-2019




# Figure (16-6): Developed and Beneficiary Families by Type of Assistance from Dar Al Ber Society Ajman Branch during the Year 2019






# Figure (16-7): Activities and Events of Dar Al Ber Society in Ajman Branch during the Years 2016-2019






# Figure (16-8): Social Assistance Granted by the Ministry of Community Development by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019





# Figure (16-9): Number of Granted Cards from Social Assistance by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019







Figure (17-2): Annual Growth Rate (Inflation) by Major Groups of Expenditure in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 208 2017-2019




#### Figure (17-1): Average Yearly Consumer Price Indicesand by Major Groups of Expenditure in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2017-2019






#### Figure (17-2): Annual Growth Rate (Inflation) by Major Groups of Expenditure in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2017-2019



### Figure (18-1): Minimum and Maximum Temperature by Month and Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019






Figure (18-2): Total Rainfall Quantity and Number of Rainy Days by Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2016-2019





### Figure (18-3): Average Temperature (Maximum and Minimum) by month and station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019







### Figure (18-4): Maximum and Minimum of Relative Humidity by Month and Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019










#### Figure (18-5): Mean Minimum and Maximum Average of Relative Humidity by Month & Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019






#### Figure (18-6): Measurements of Atmospheric Pressure at Sea Level by Month and Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019







#### Figure (18 -7): Wind Speed by Month & Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2019
