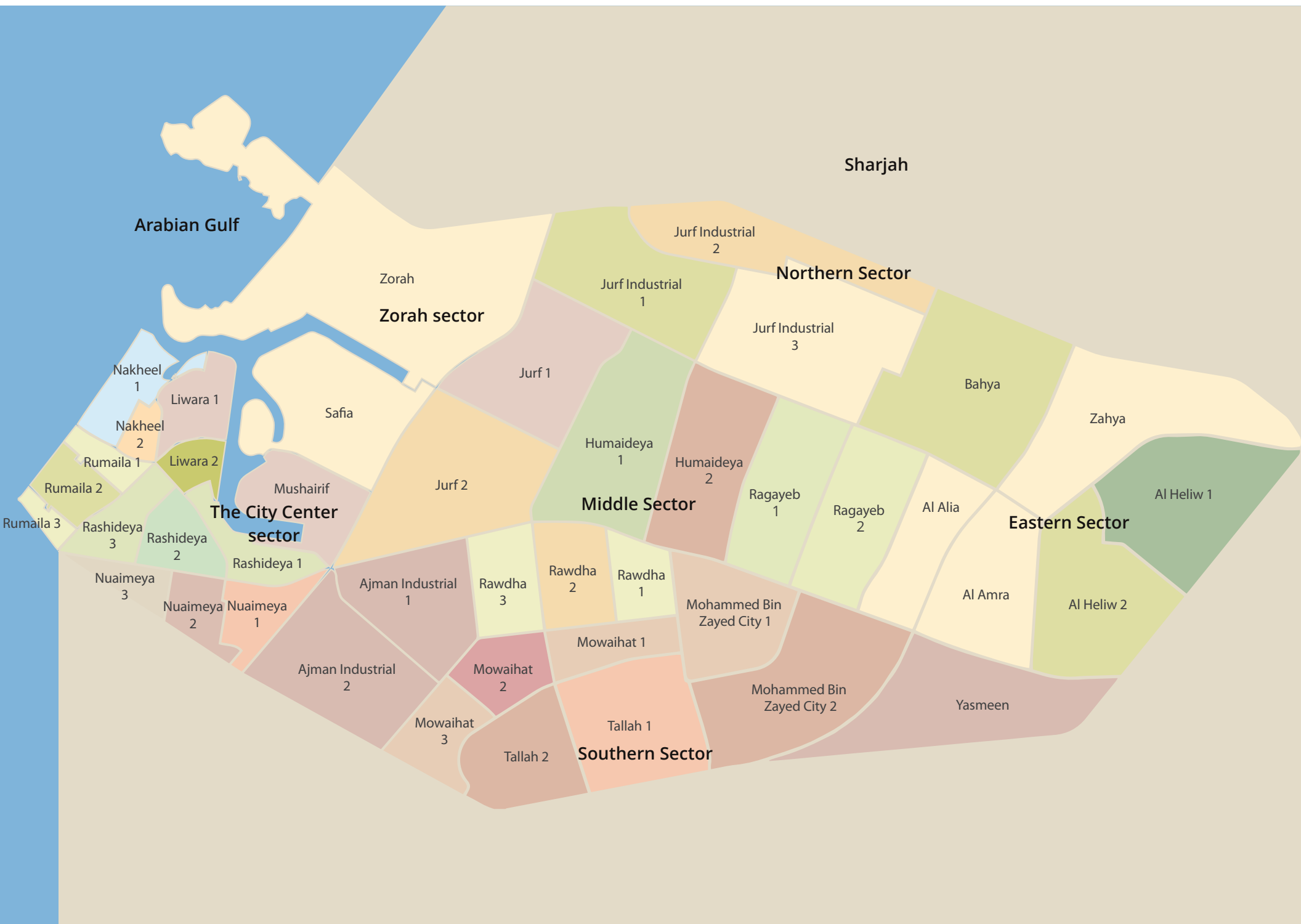

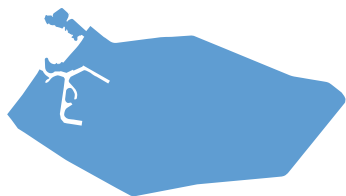


## General Information about Emirate of Ajman

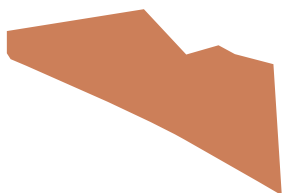

### Ajman City



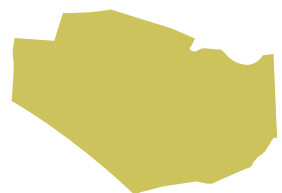
Ajman City is the capital of the Emirate where the residence of Ajman's ruler as well as other governmental departments, companies, banks, and factories are located, its seaport and port overlooks the Arabian Gulf coast. Owing to its strategic location and economic growth, Ajman City has become a center of attraction for investors and entrepreneurs, facilitating a masterful renaissance, characterized by a unique blend of modern architecture and ancestral heritage.

### Masfout Region



The Masfout Region is about 110 kilometers to the southeast, and consists of the City of Masfout, as well as the Mazeyrah Region and Al Sabgah. Its residents are descendants of prominent tribes, such as the Bedouin tribe and the Bani Ka'eb tribe. The region is known for its fertile soil, expansive valleys and mild climate, making Masfout Region a magnet for tourism. The region is also characterized by its magnificent natural scenery, boasting with high mountains such as Mount Dafta, Mount Leshan and the White Mountain. Some of the most prominent wide valleys in the region include the Ghalfa Valley, Al-Sawmar Valley, Masfout Valley, Khanfariyah, and the Wadi dafda

### Manama Region



The Manama Region It is about 60 KM far from Ajman towards east. Along the road there is a route passing by sharjah and Fujairah Emirates. At Manama there is a level full of stones and sands. 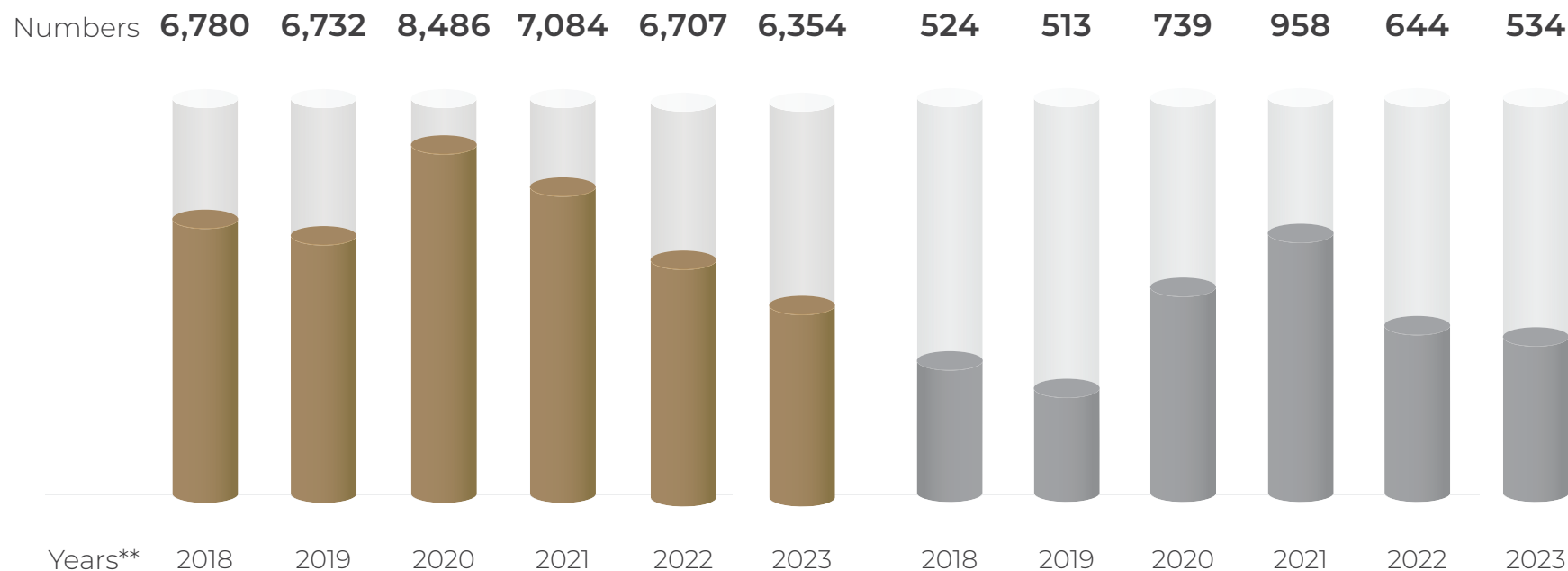
Figure (1-1): Live Births & Deaths in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023\*

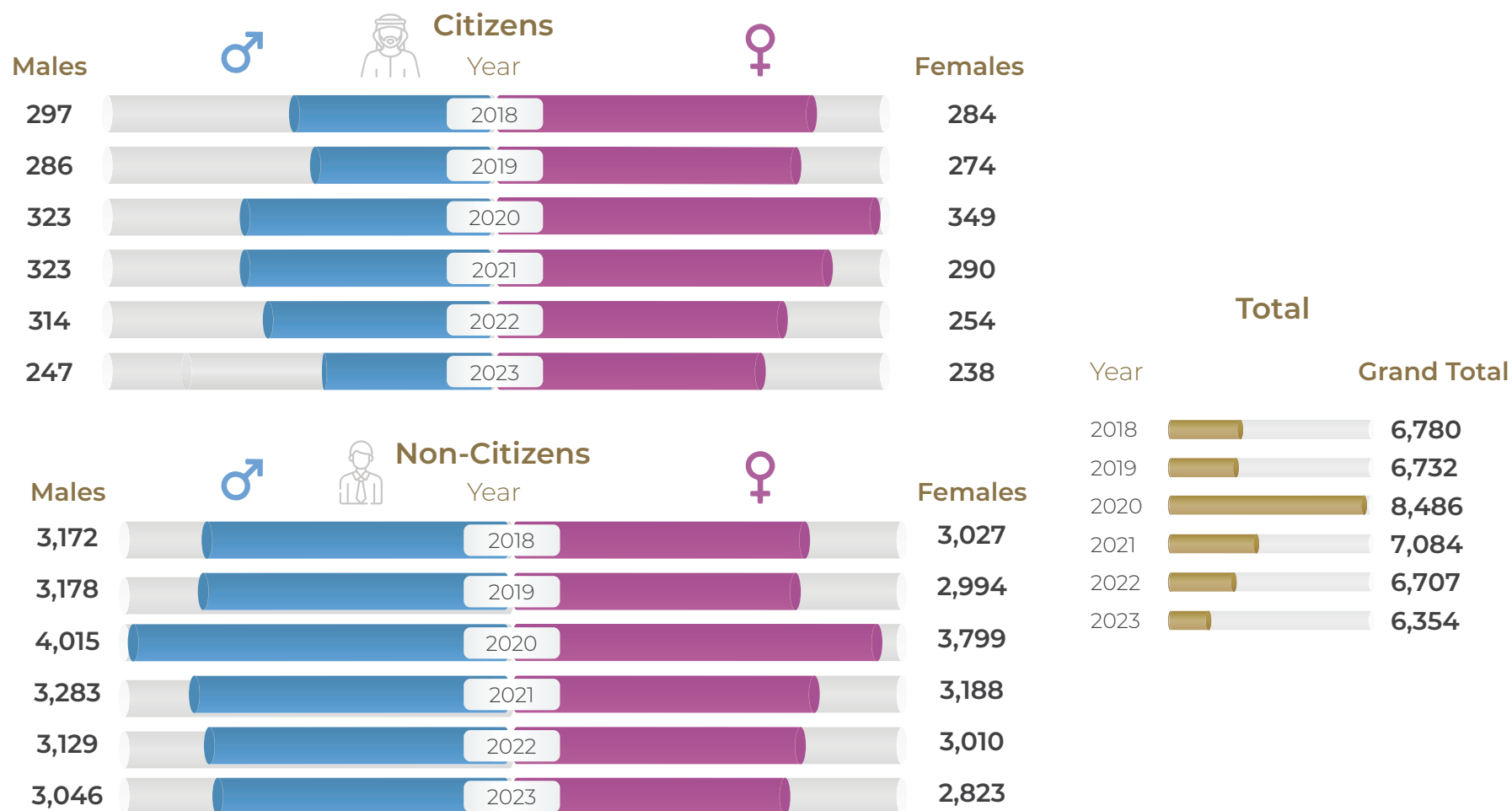

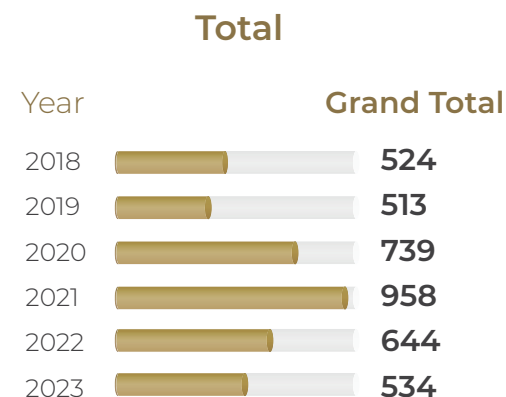

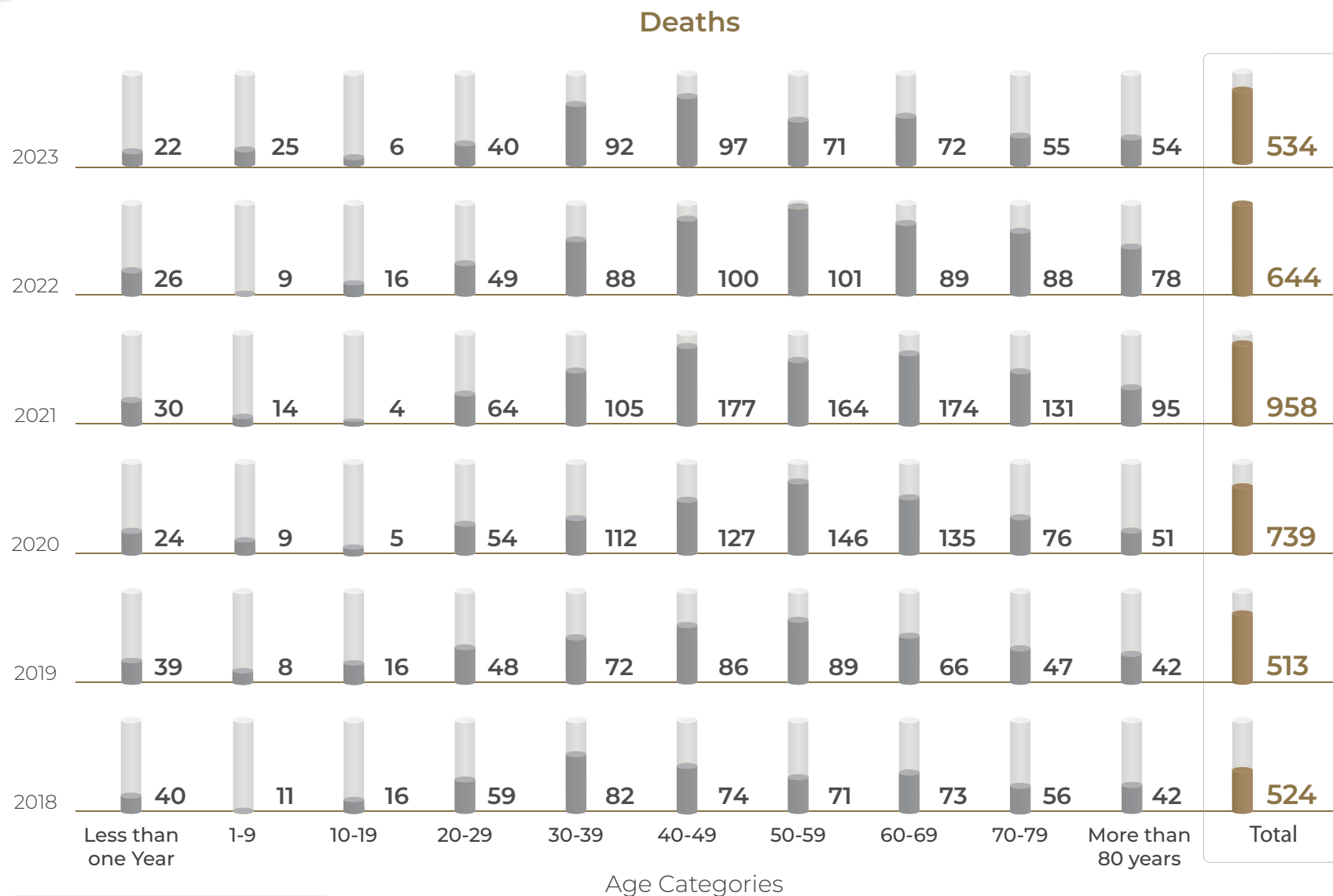


Figure (1-4): Deaths by Gender, Nationality and Month in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

**Figure (1-5): Deaths by Age categories in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023**

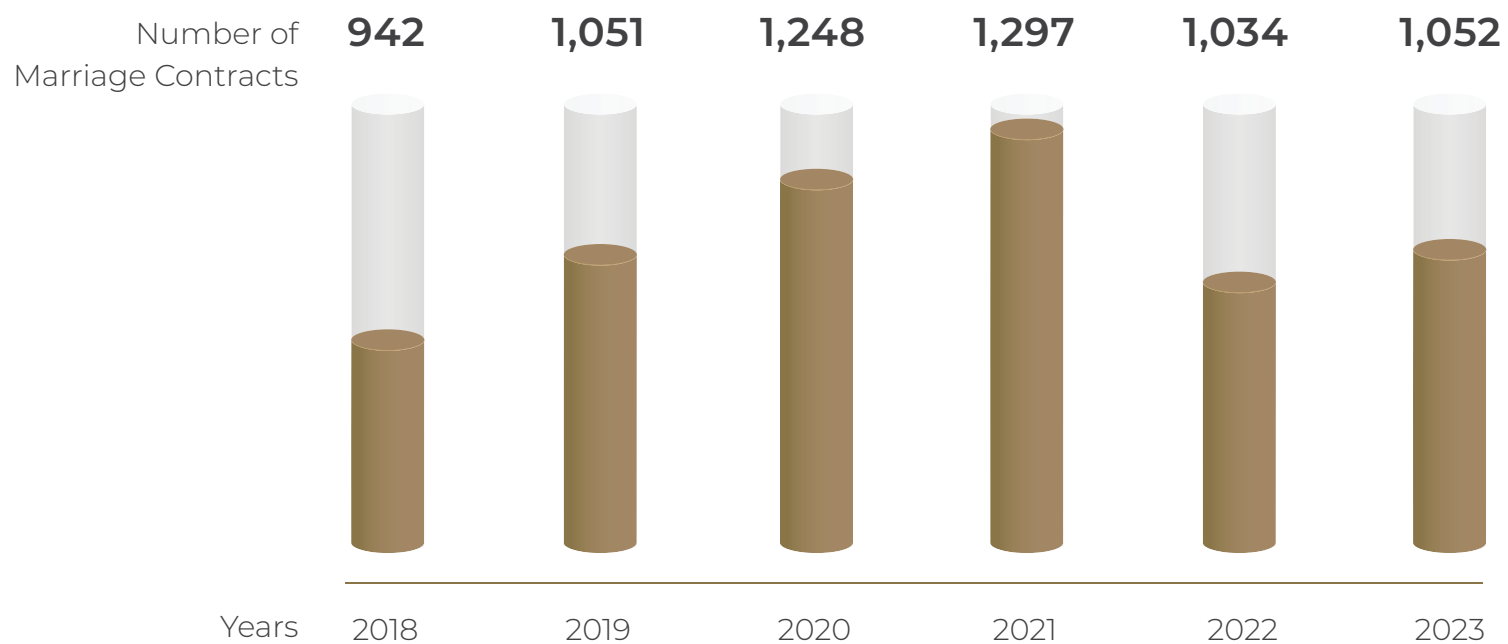

Figure (2-1): Total Registered Employees in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023\*

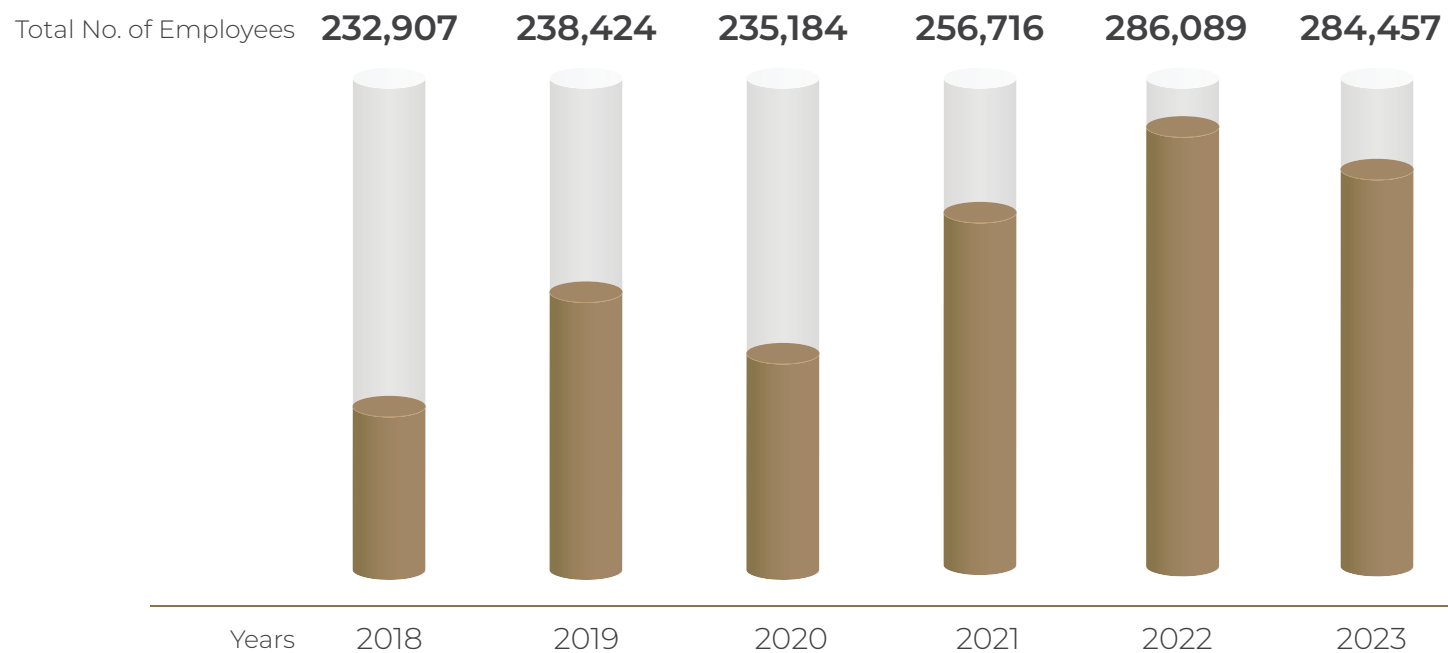




Figure (2-2): Registered Employees in the Ministry of Human Resources and Emiratisation by Gender in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023\*

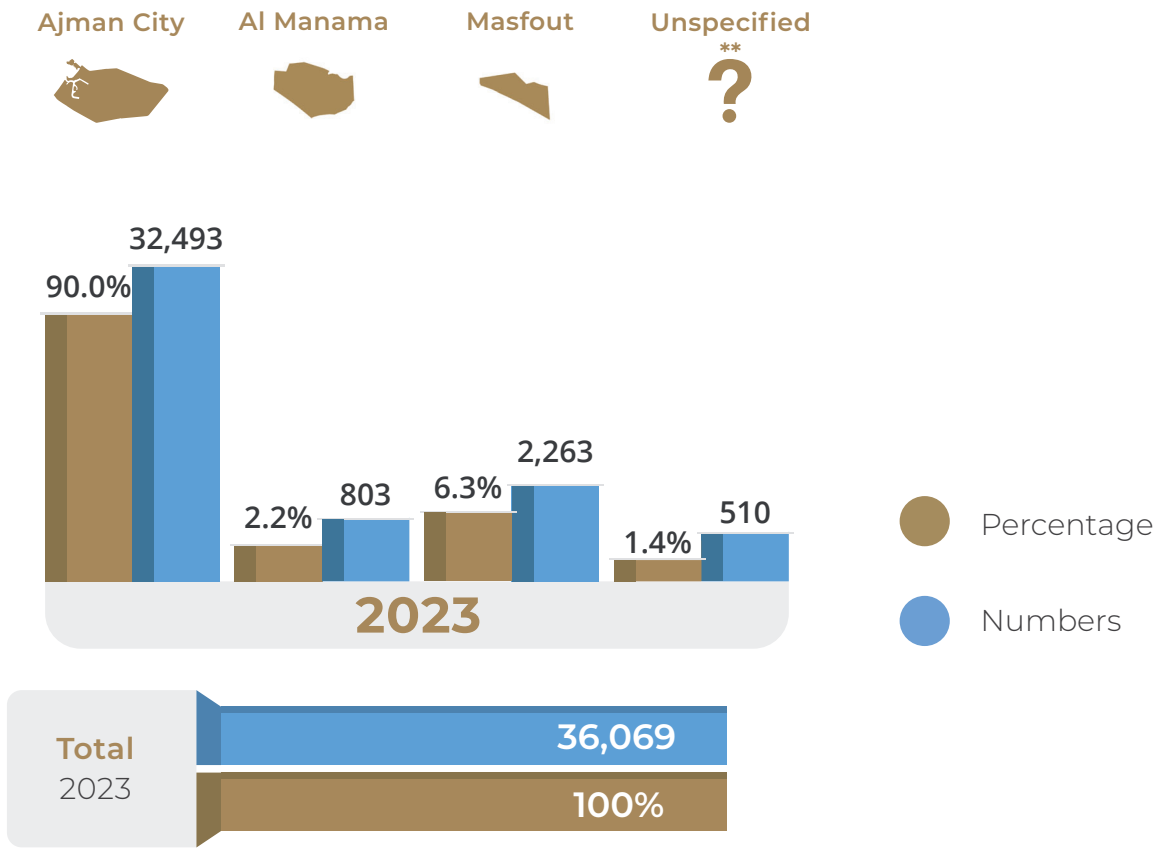

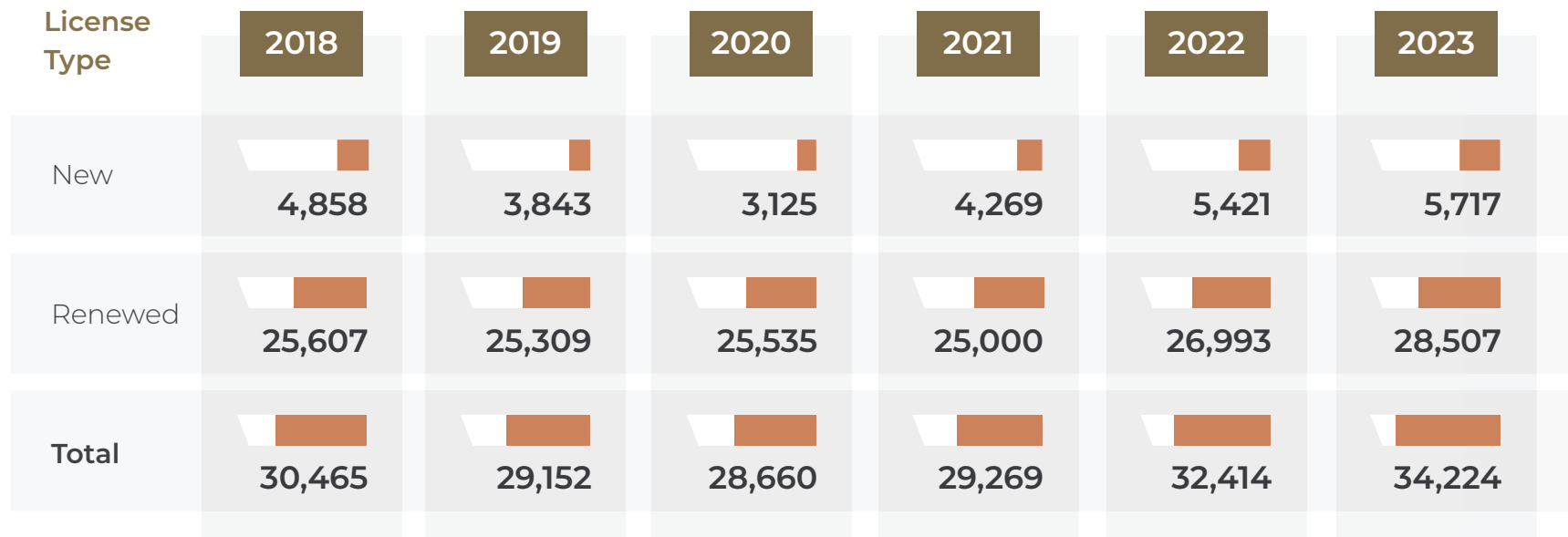

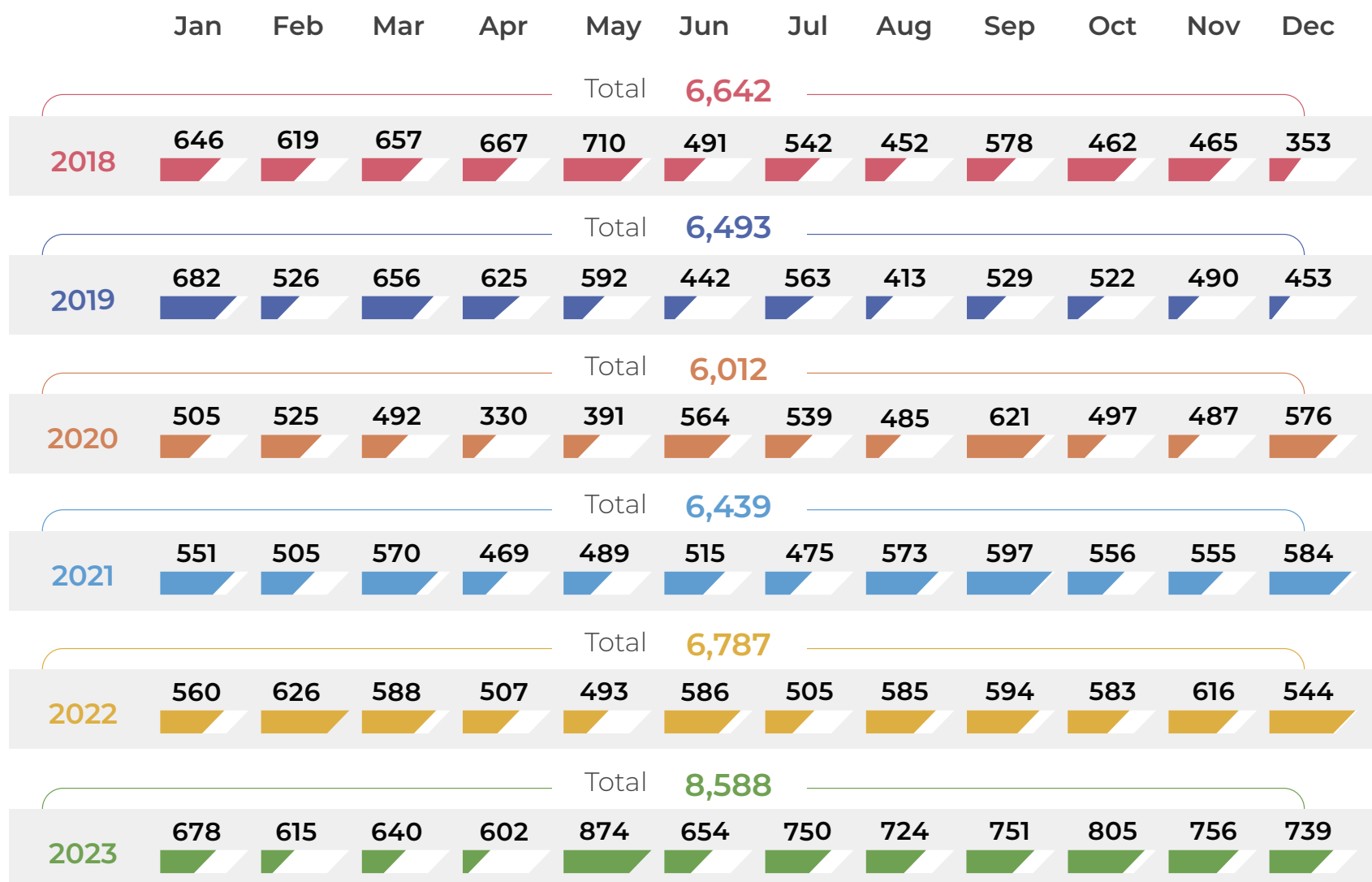

Figure (4-2): Free Zone Affiliates by License Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

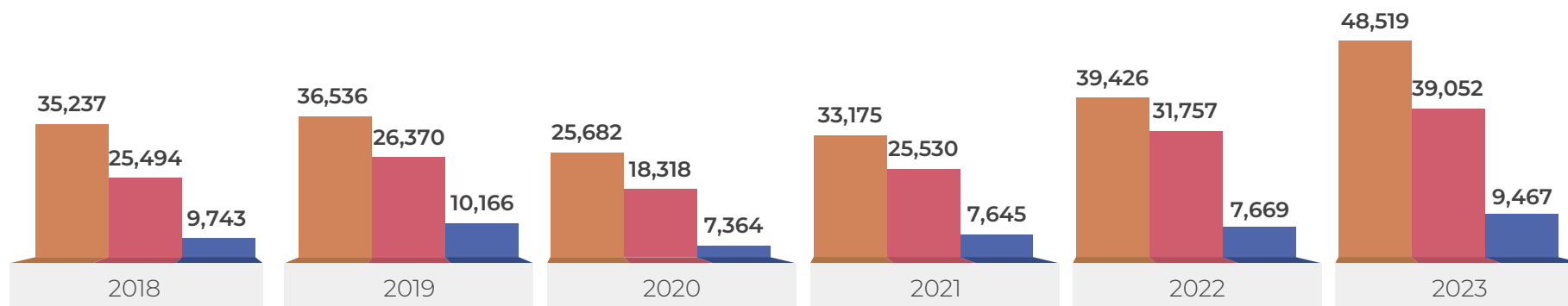

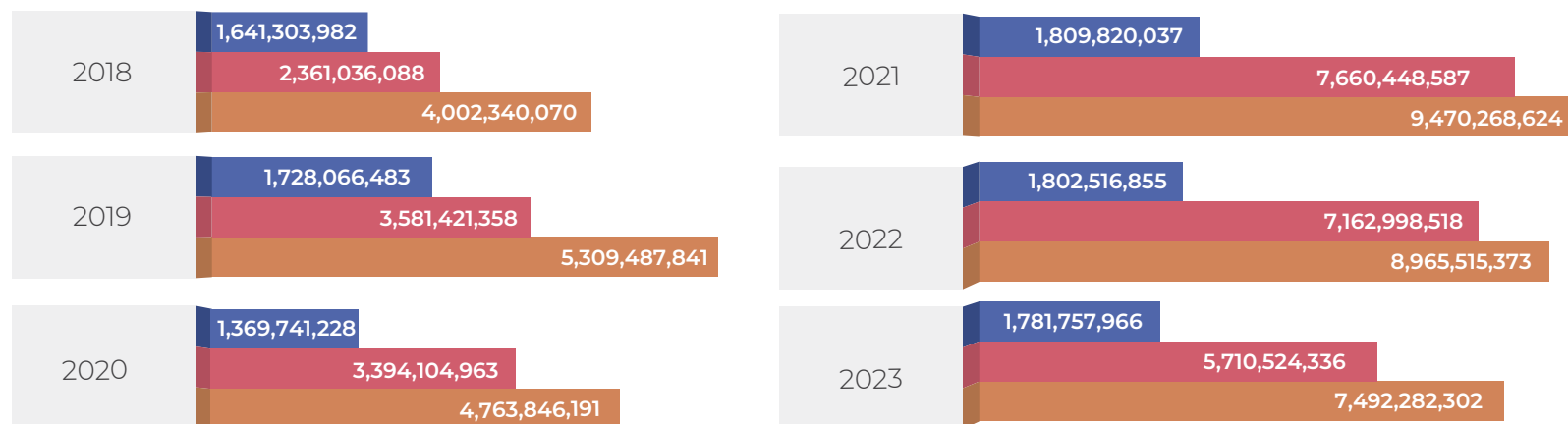


Figure (4-3): Number and Values of Certificates of Origin (Trade) in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023

Figure (5-1): Residential Tenancy Contracts Registered by Nationality in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023

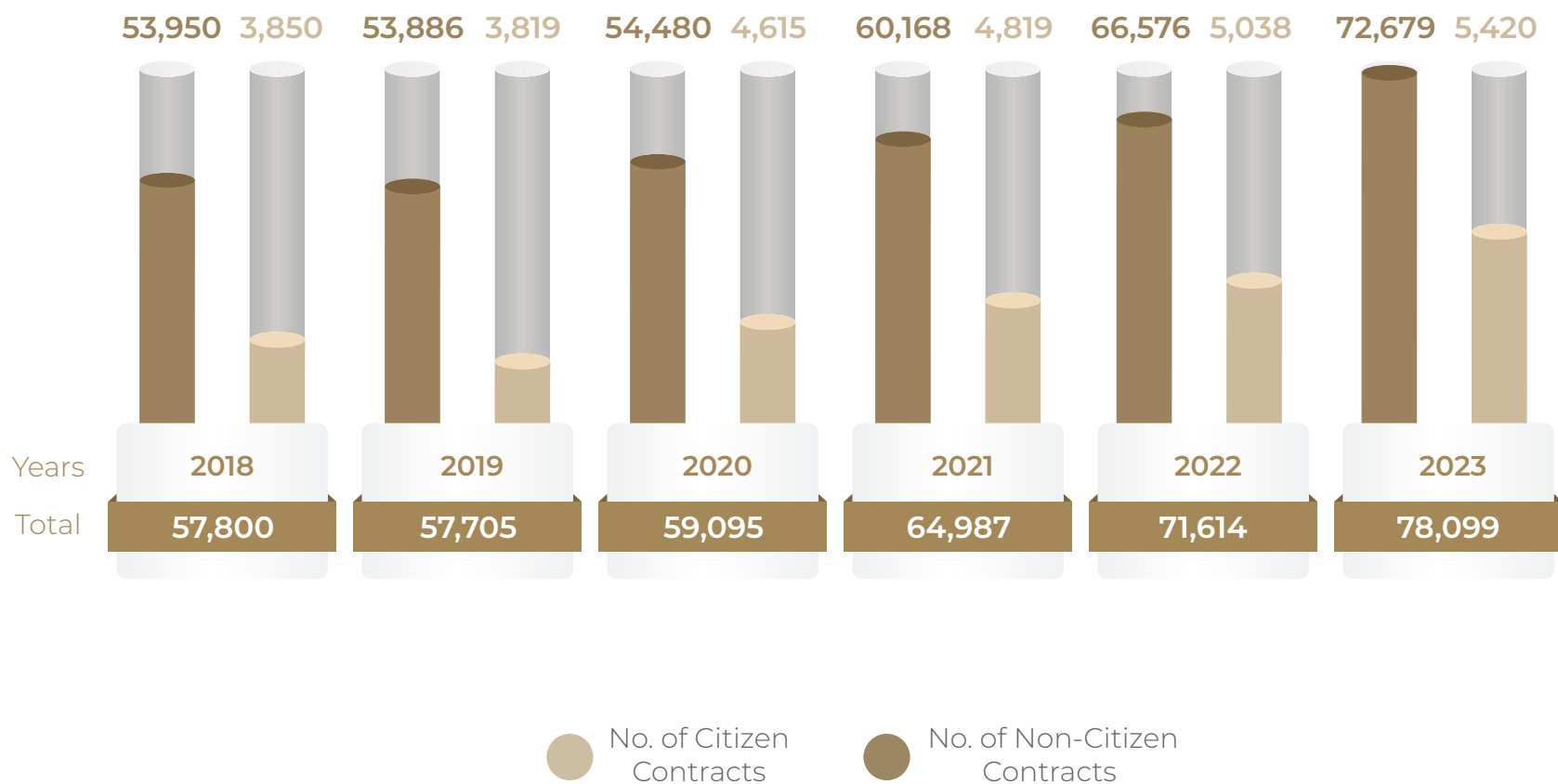
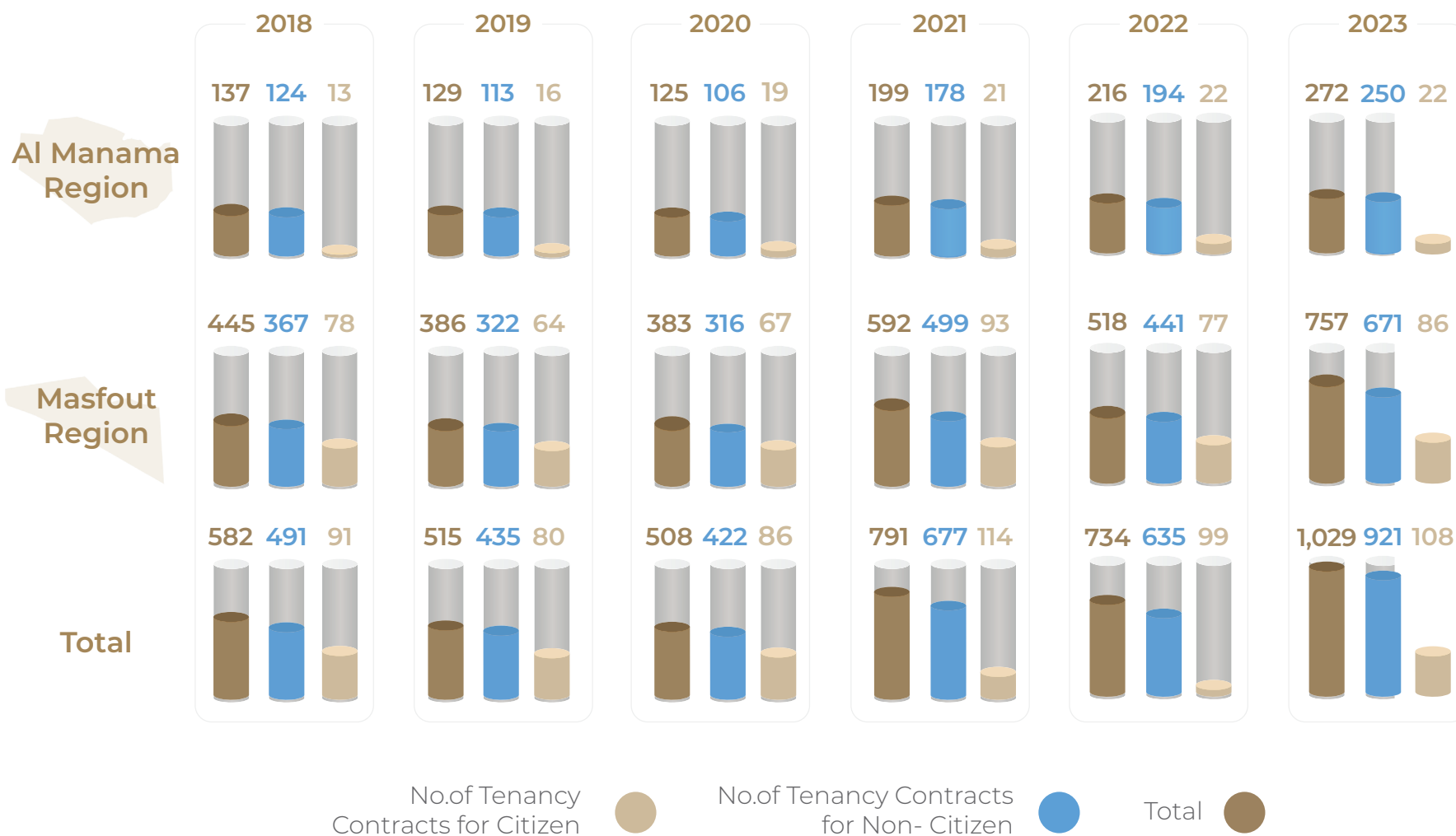




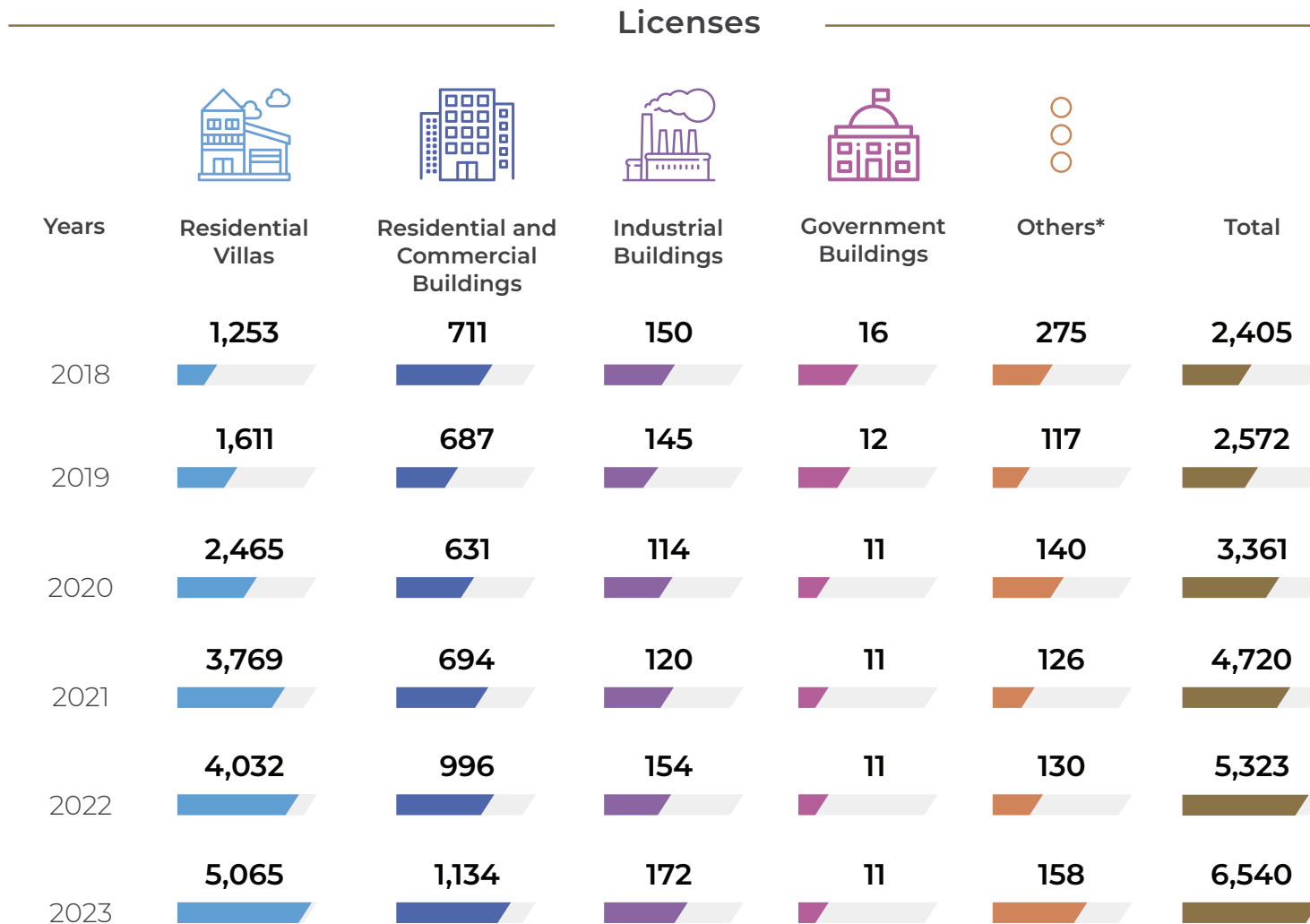
Figure (5-2): Residential Tenancy Contracts Registered by Nationality in the Emirate of Ajman for Masfout and Manama Region during the Years 2018-2023

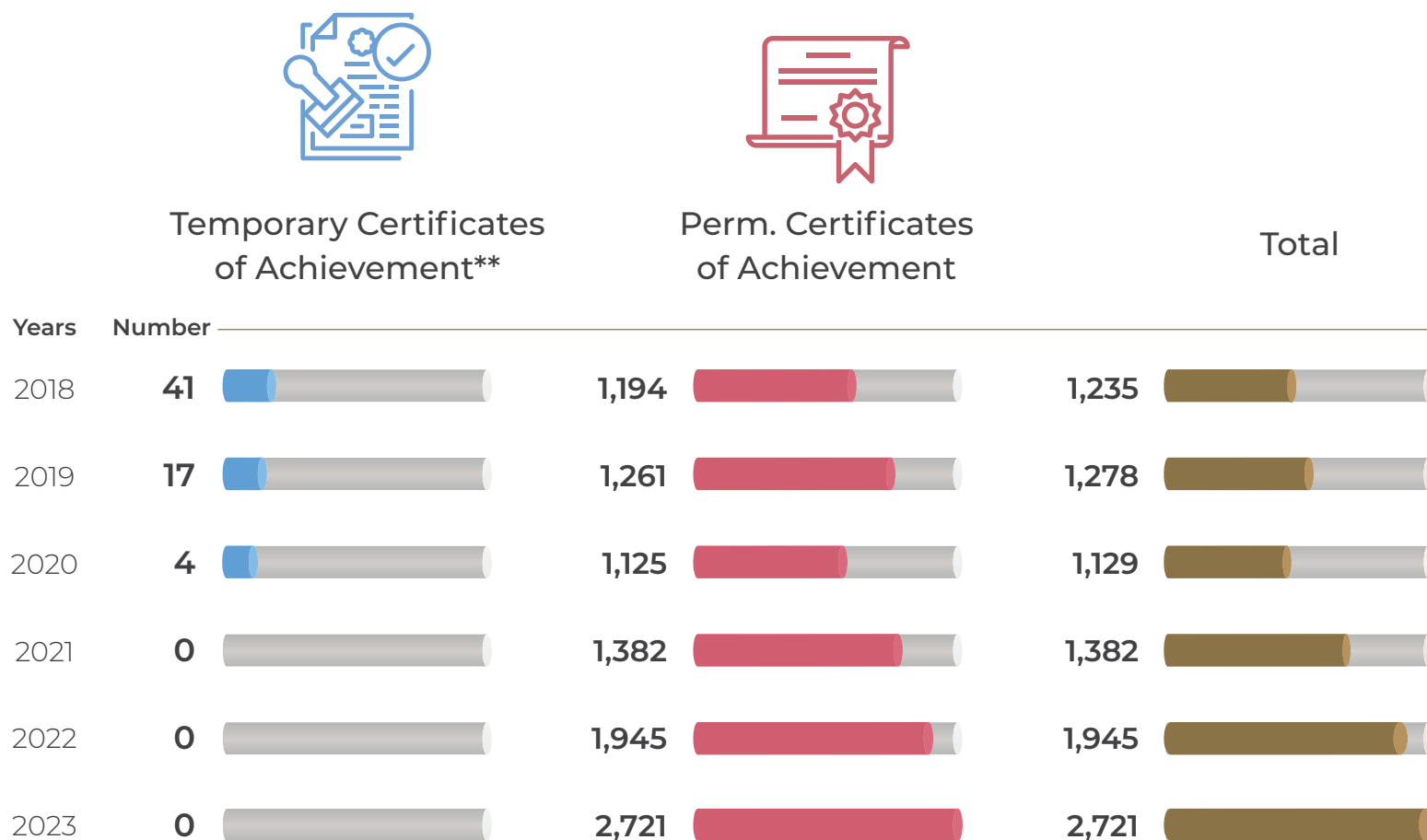
Figure (5-3): Number of Issued Building Licenses, Classified by Building Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023

Figure (5-4): Issued Certificates of Achievement by Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023\*



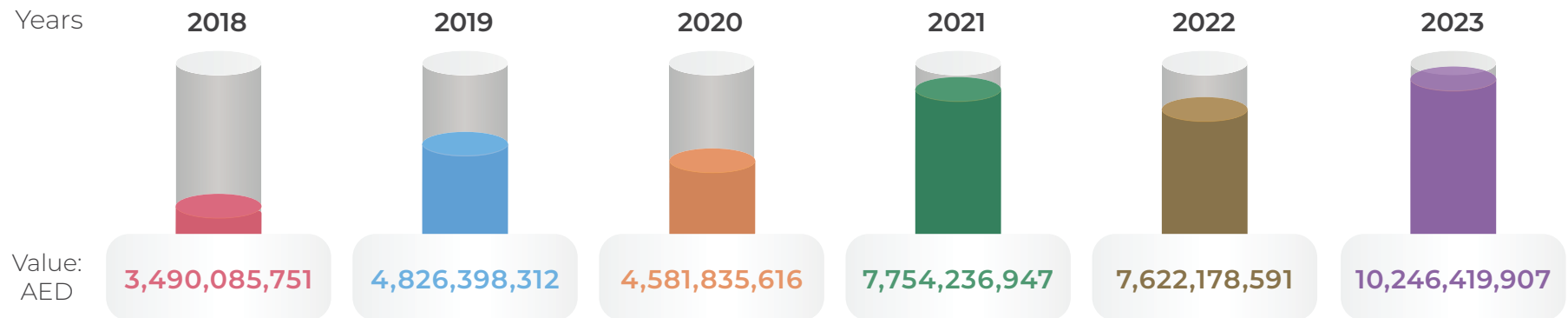

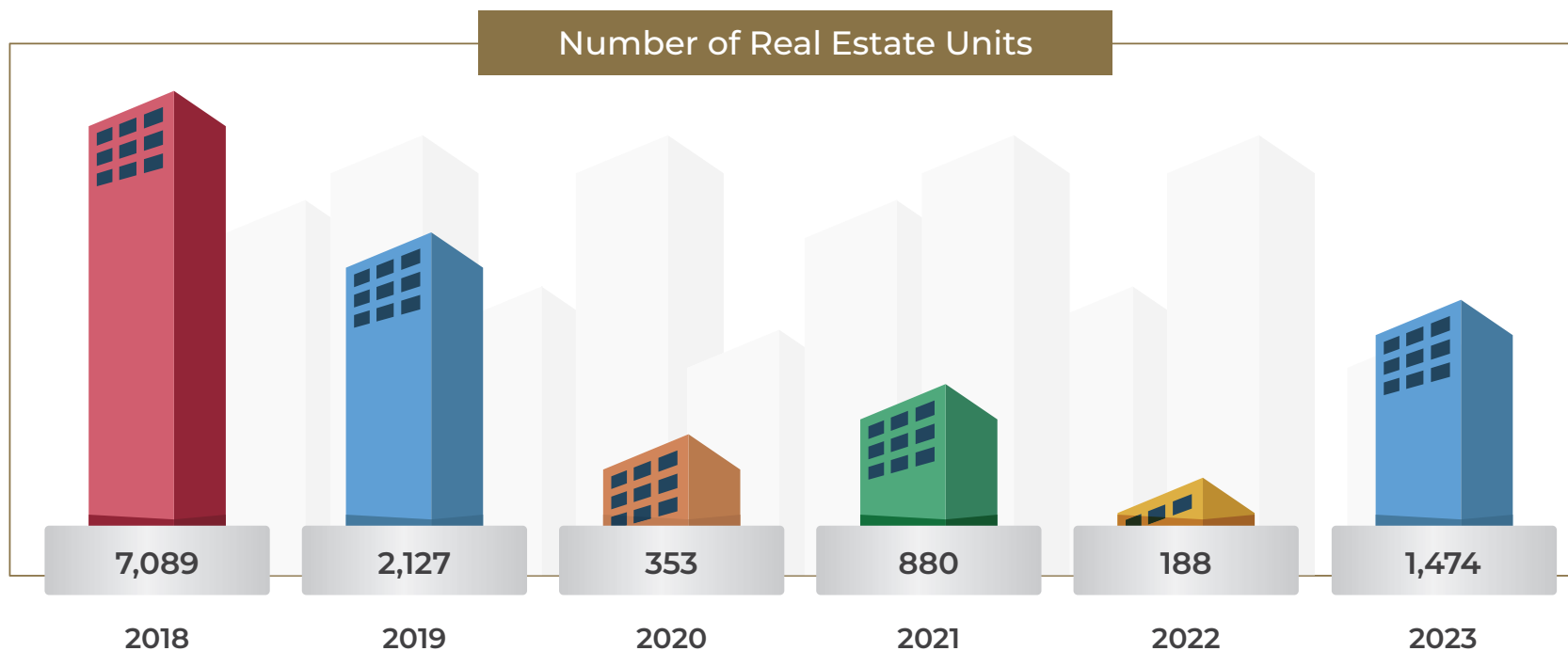
**Figure (5-7): Transactions of Department of Land and Real Estate Regulation by Real Estate Registration Type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023**

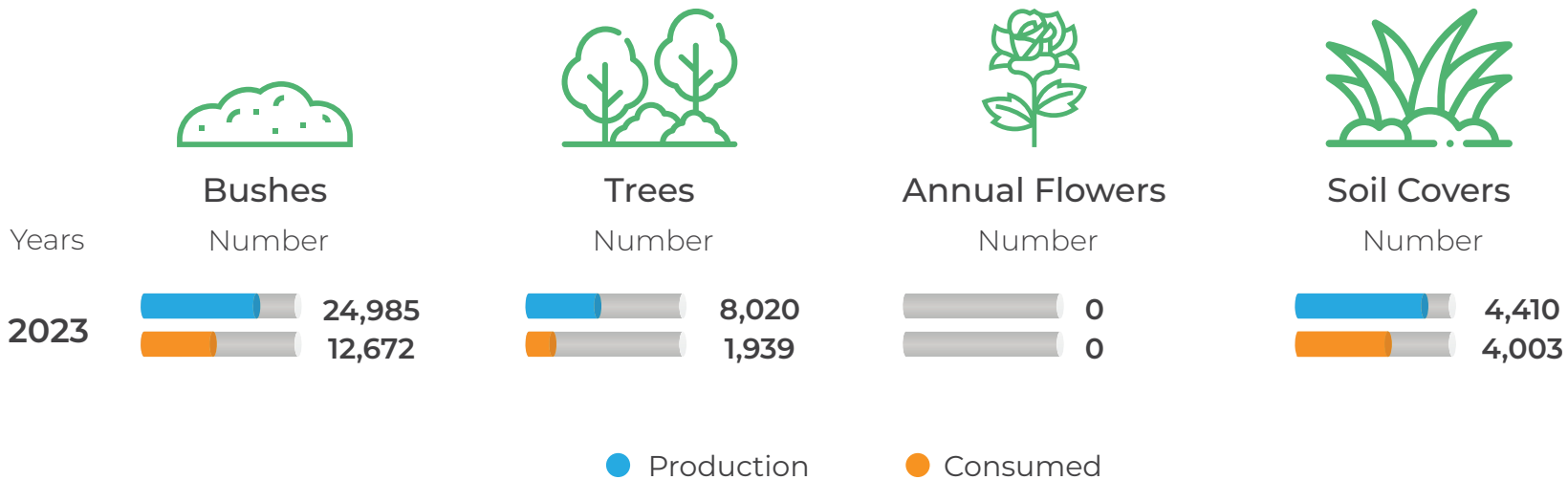
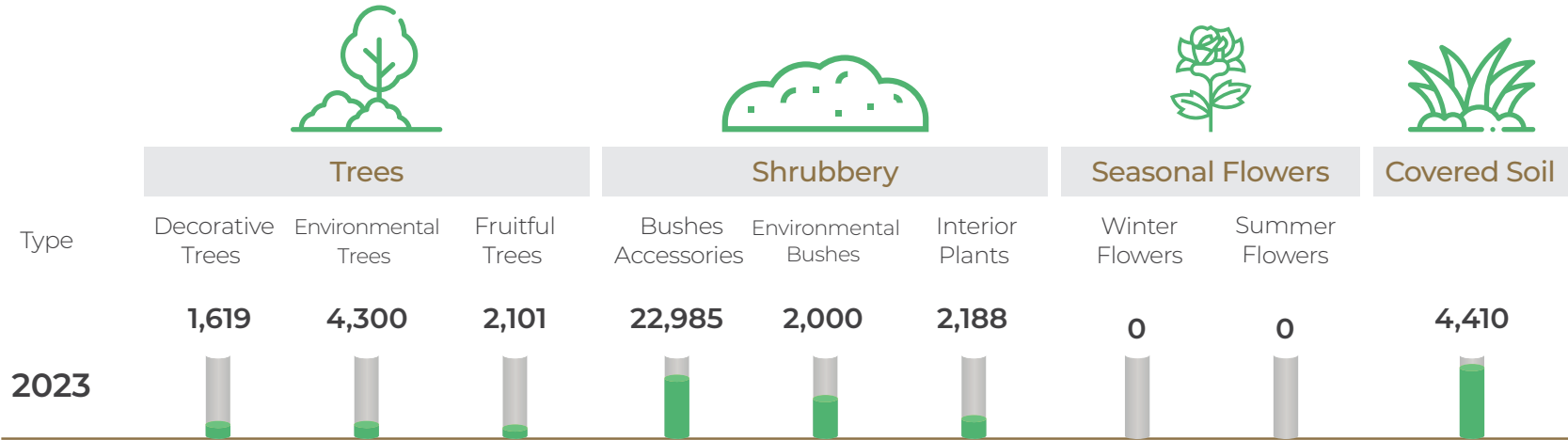




Figure (6-2): Productivity of the Agriculture by type in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

Figure (6-3): Greened Areas in the Emirate of Ajman during the years 2018-2023\*

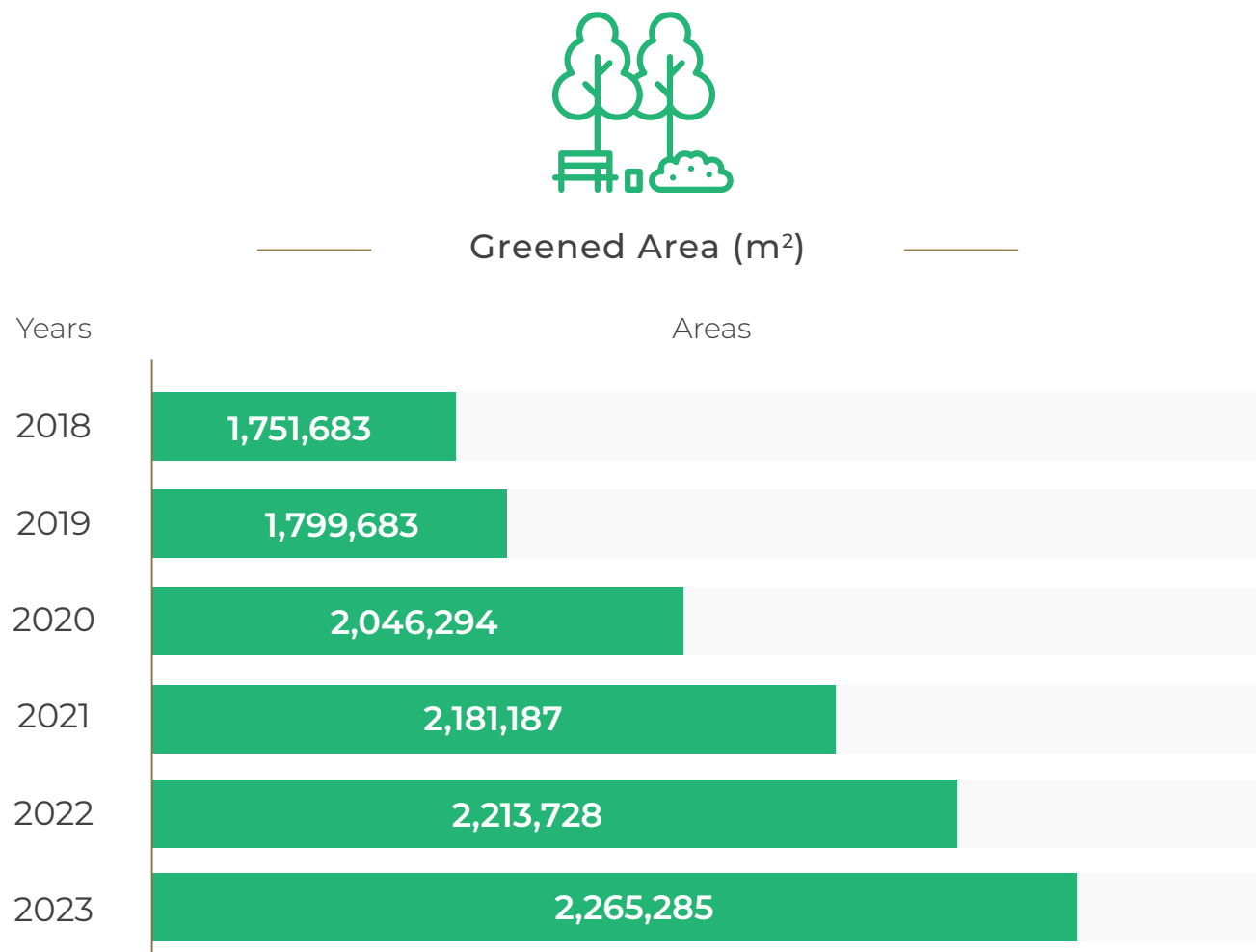
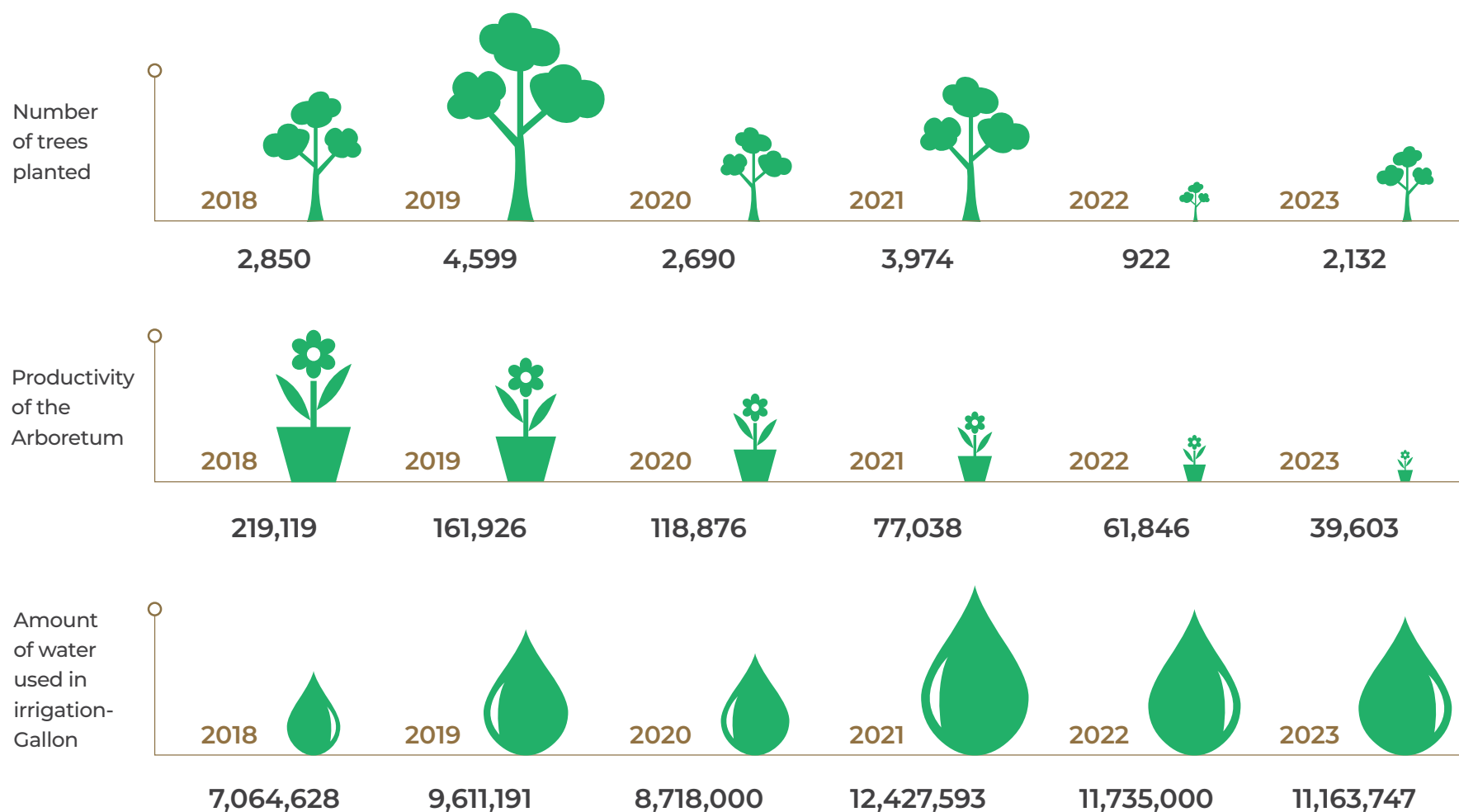








Figure (6-4): Landscaping and Green Spaces data in the Emirate of Ajman during the years 2018-2023

**Figure (6-9): Number of Sheep by Gender and Age in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2022**



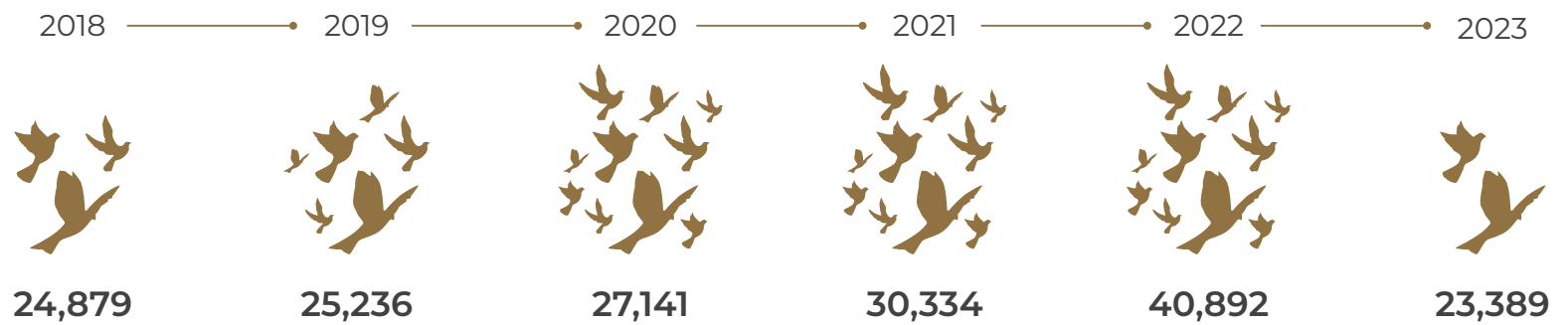

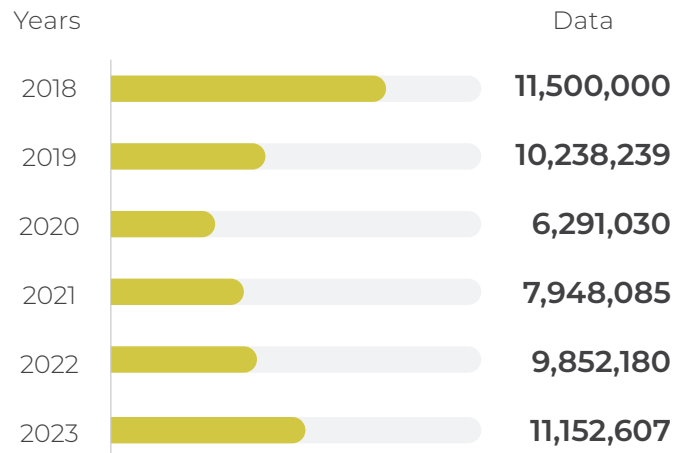

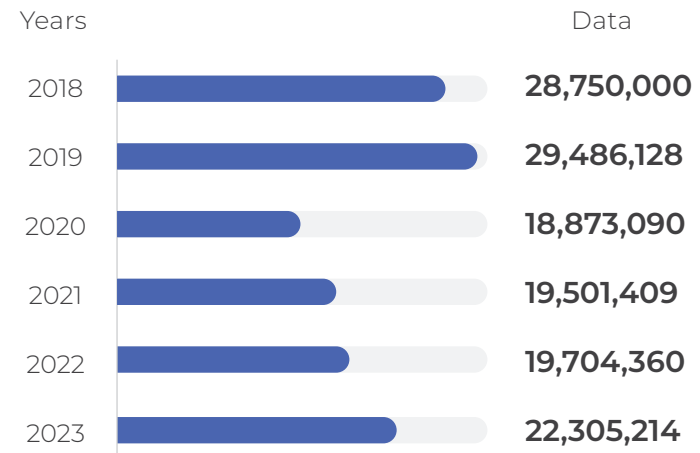




Figure (7-2): Abras by Regions stations in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023

Figure (8-1): Distribution of Schools in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Years 2019/2020-2023/2024



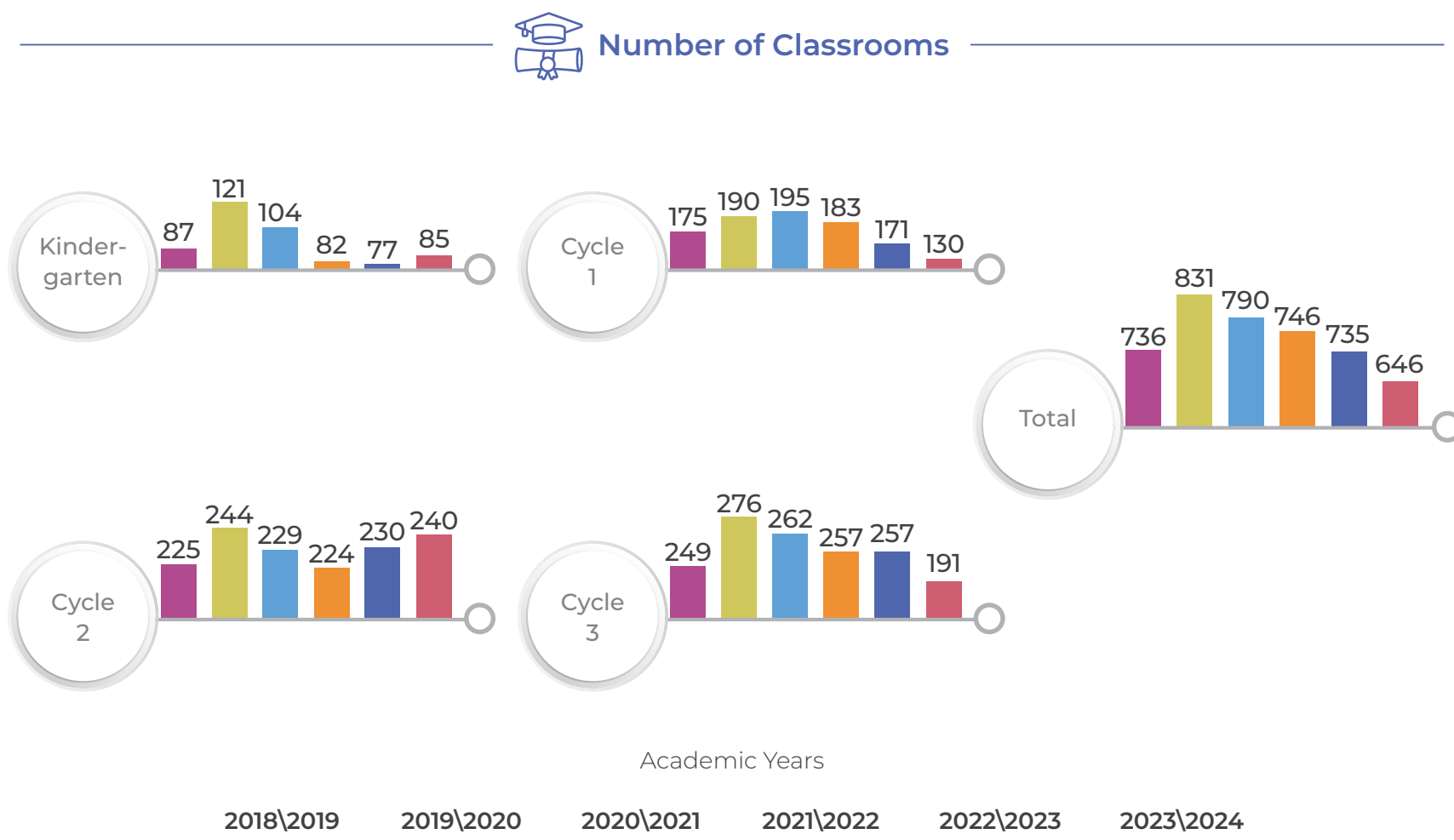

Figure (8-2): Classrooms Classified by Level of Government Education in the Emirate of Ajman during the Academic Years 2018/2019-2023/2024\*



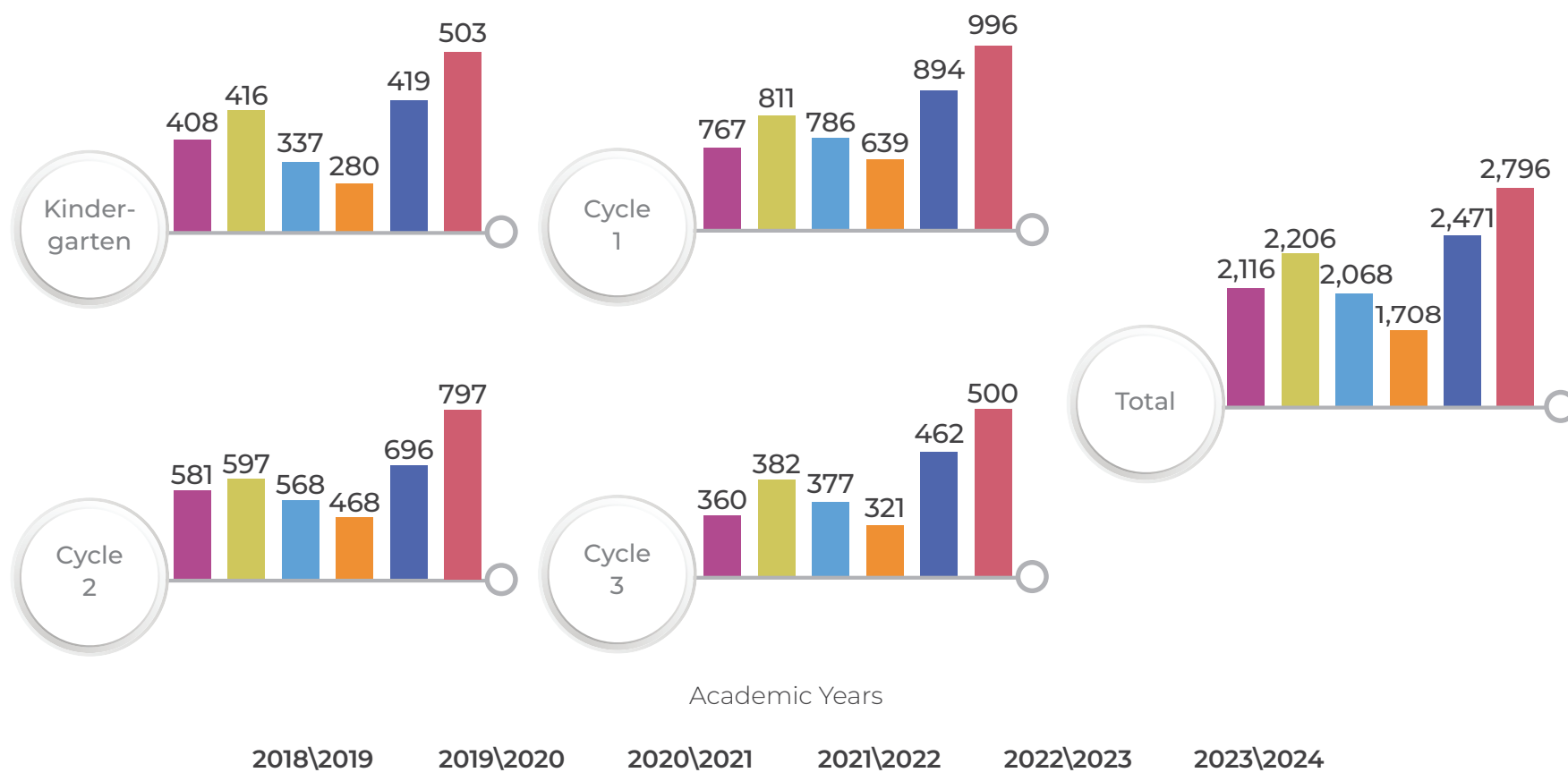

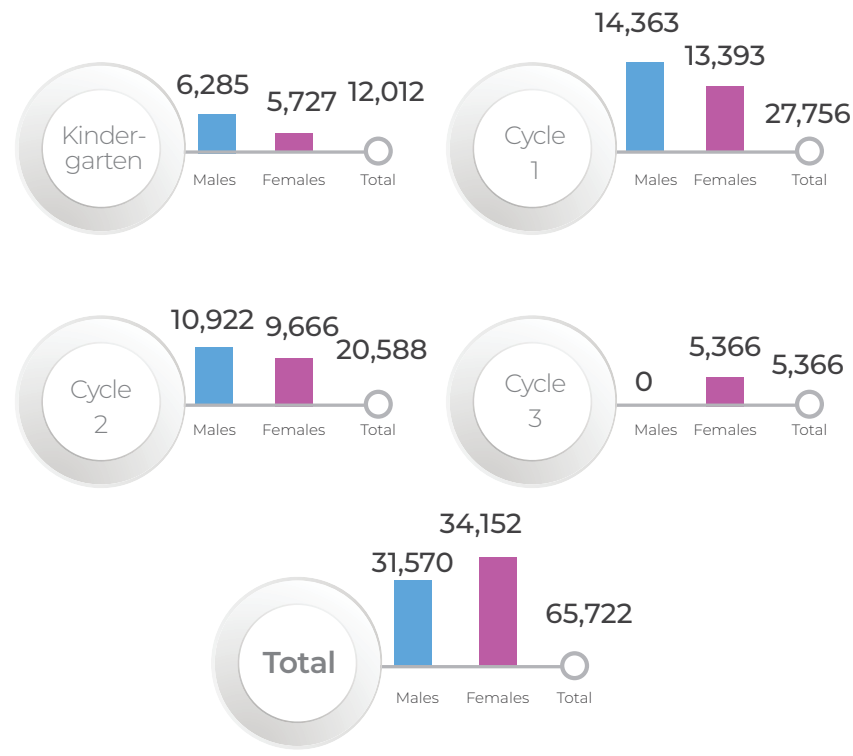

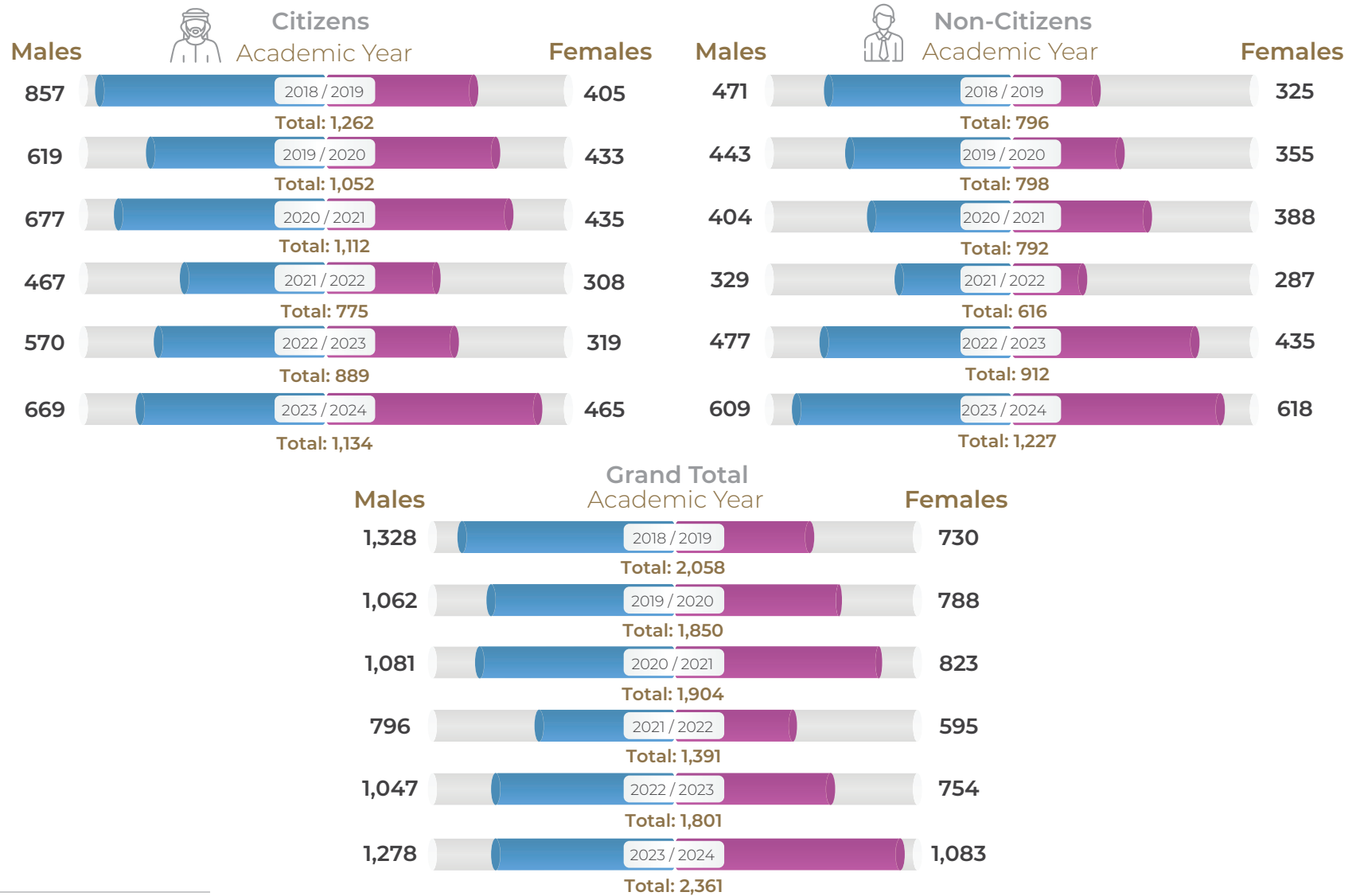
Figure (8-13): Graduate Students from Colleges in Ajman University of (Ajman Branch) by Nationality and Gender during the Academic Year 2023/2024

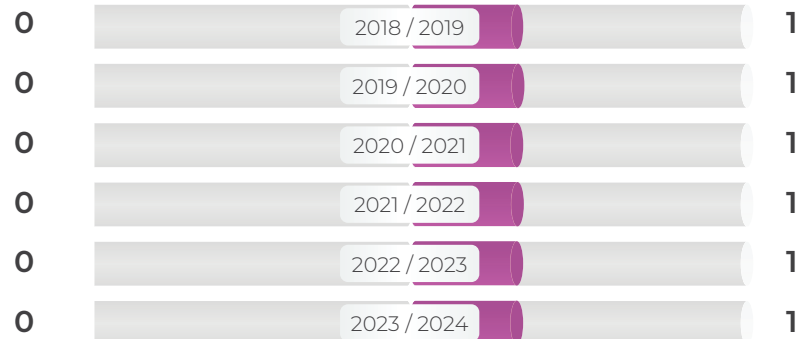

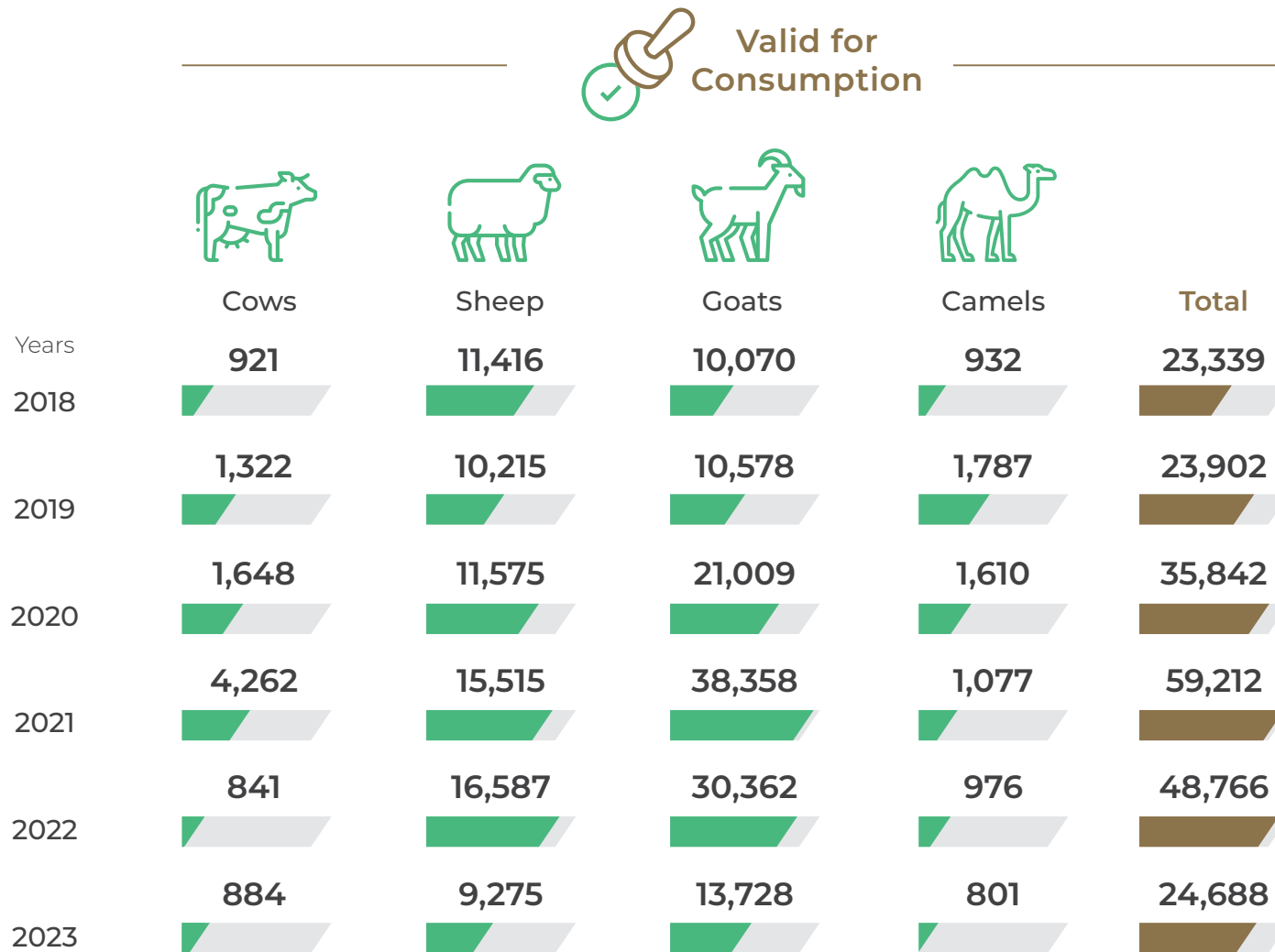

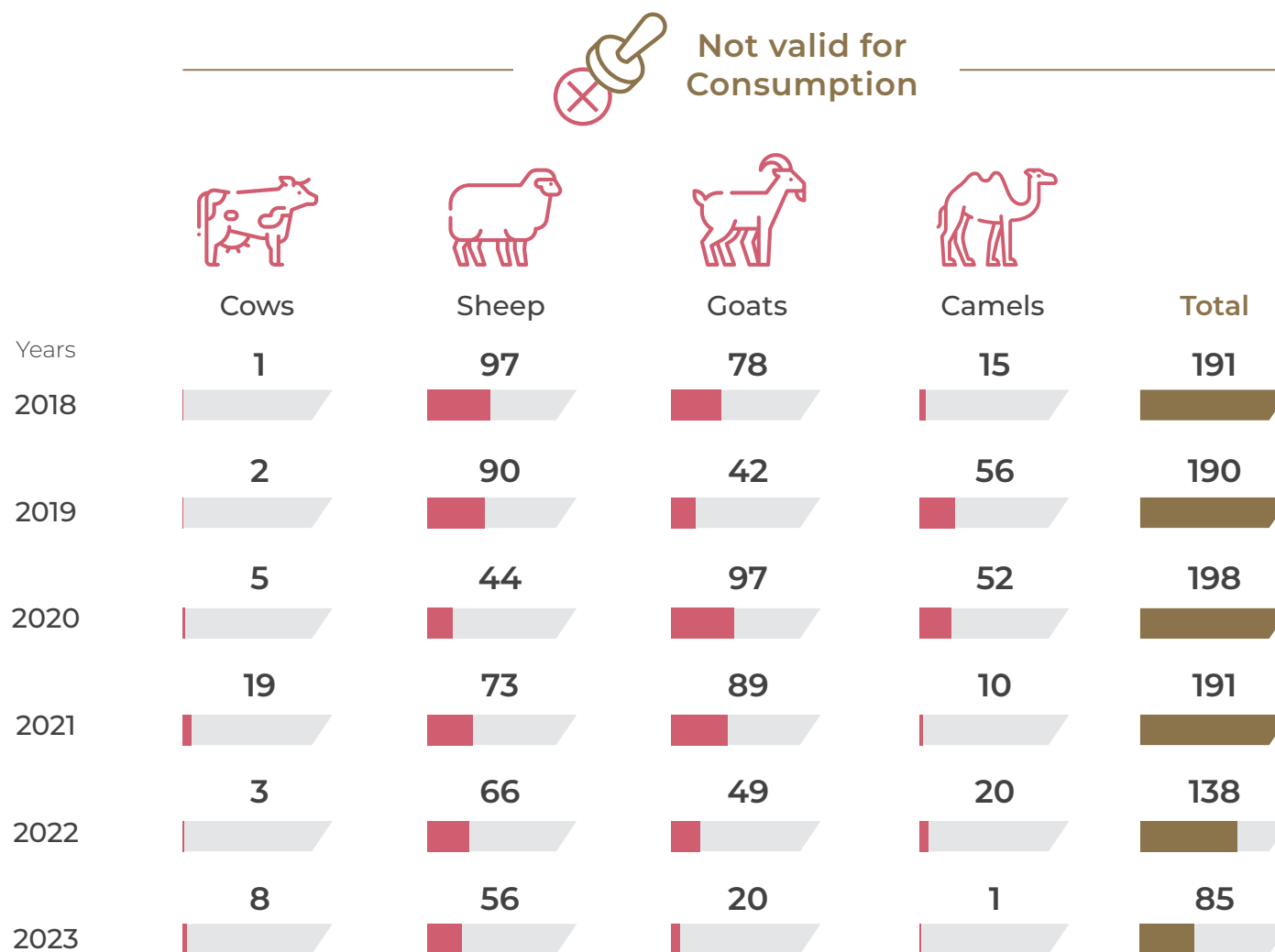


Figure (10-1): Animals Examined are Valid and Not Valid for Consumption in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023

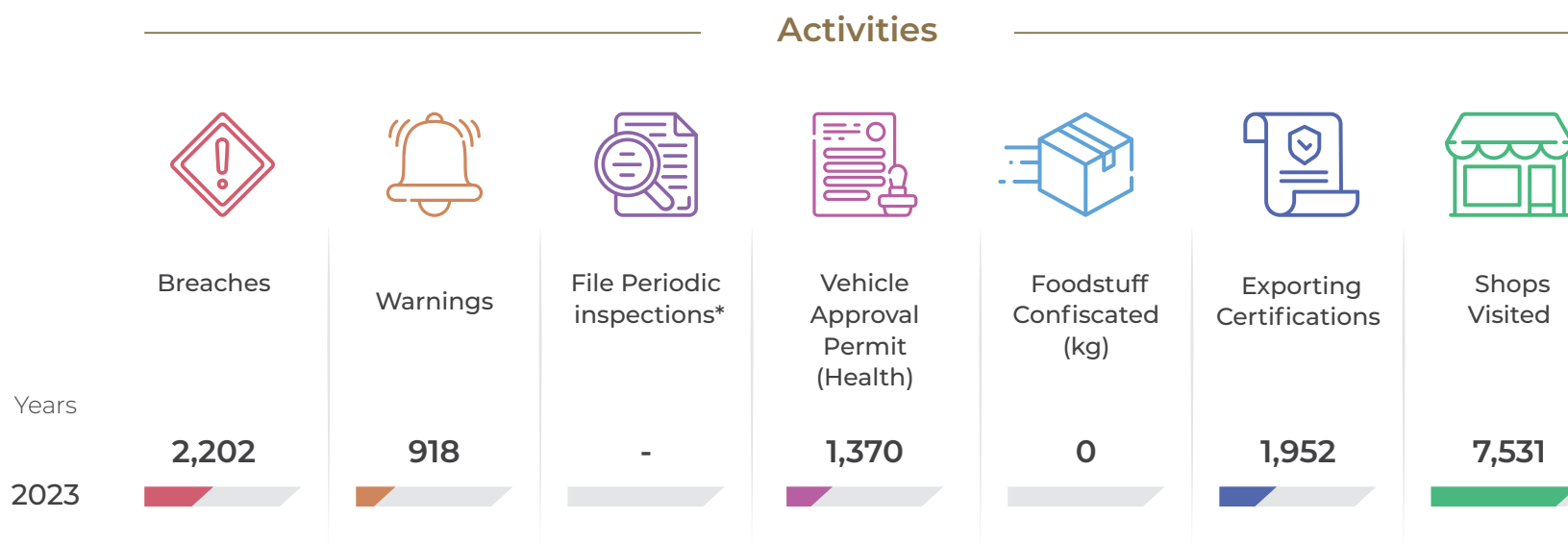


**Figure (10-2): Health Division Activities in Ajman Municipality and Planning Department by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the year 2023**

Figure (10-4): General Health Process in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023







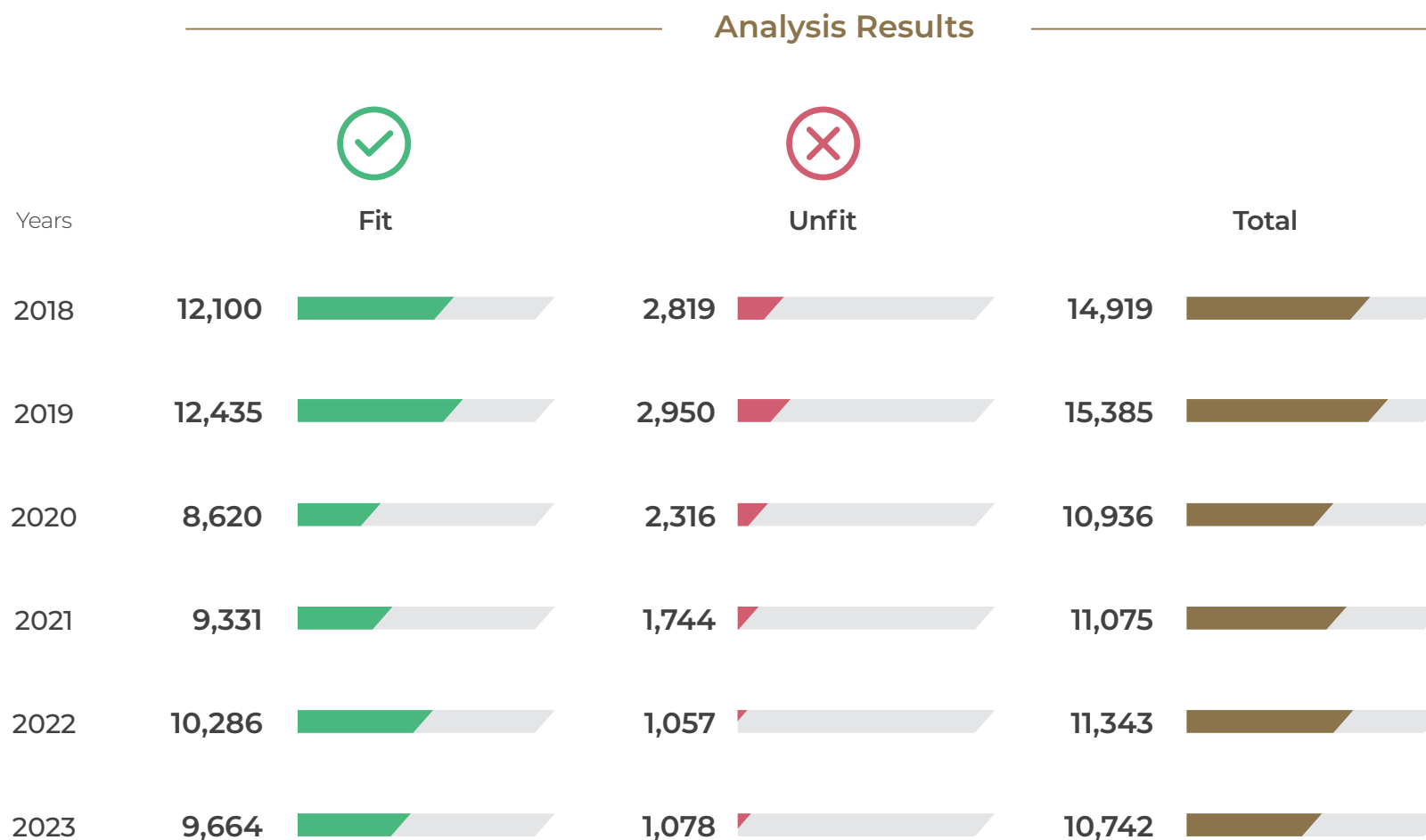

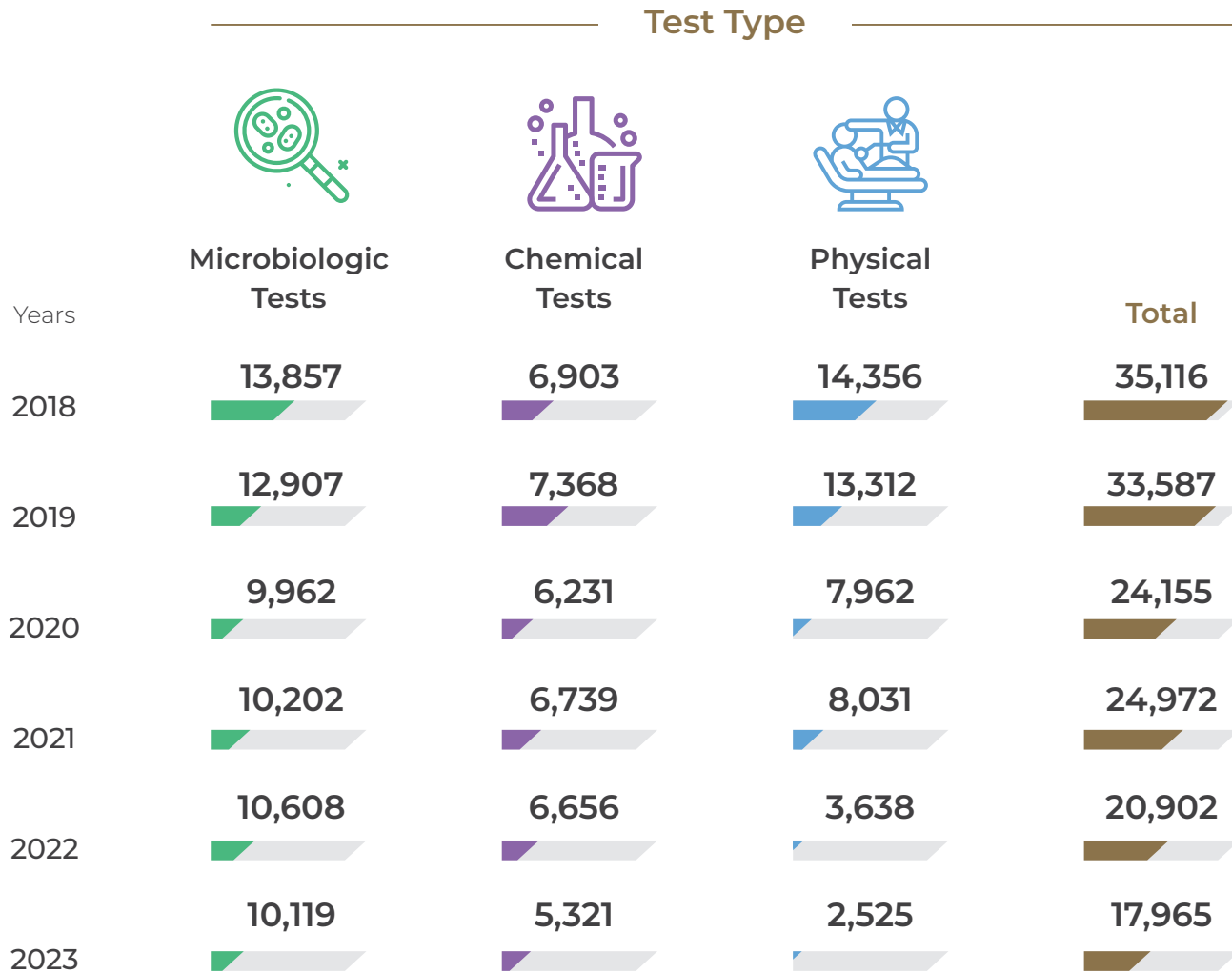
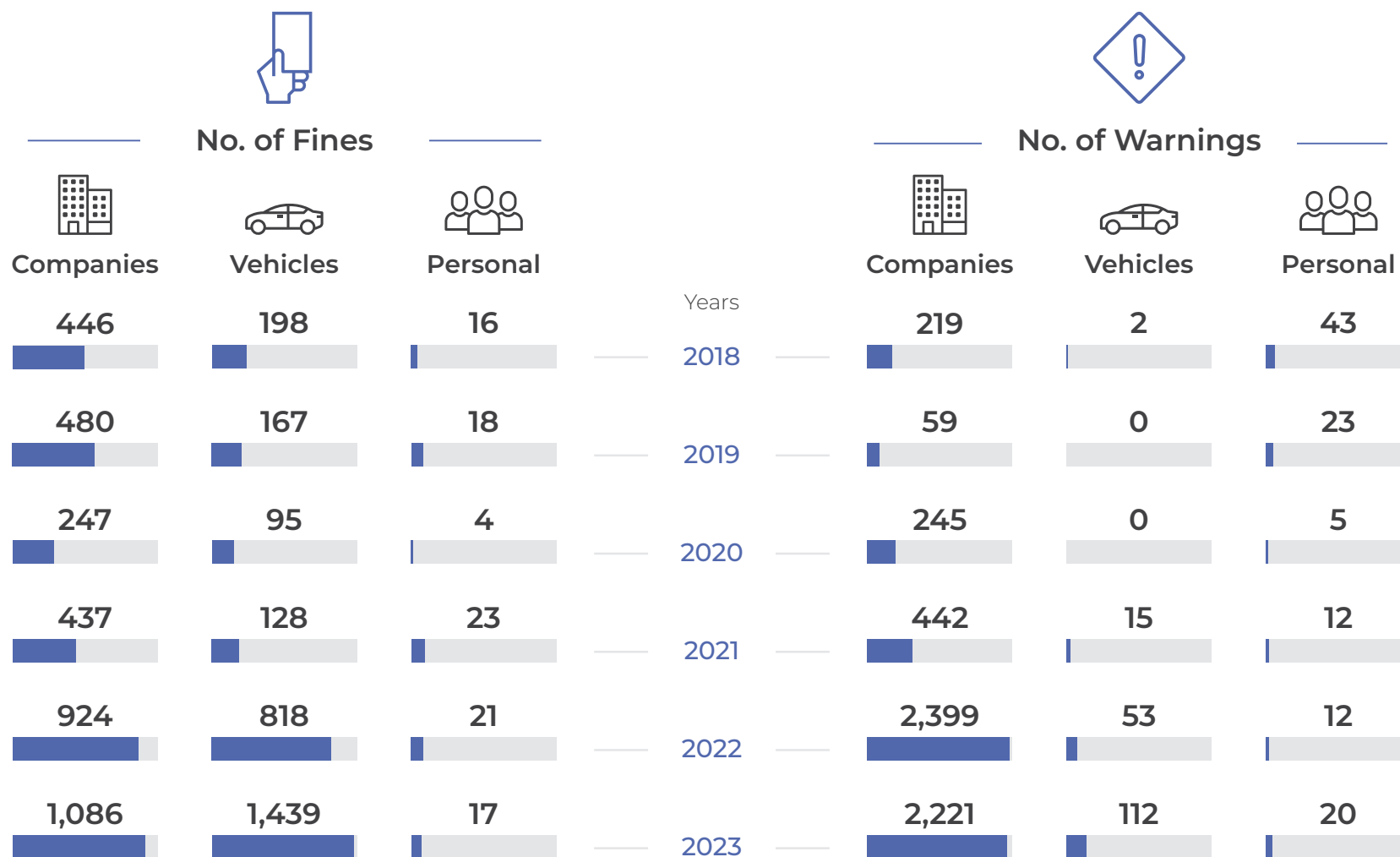




Figure (10-7): Fines, and Warnings issued by the Municipality General Hygiene Department in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023

Figure (10-8): Samples Tested in Ajman Municipality Laboratory during the Years 2018-2023

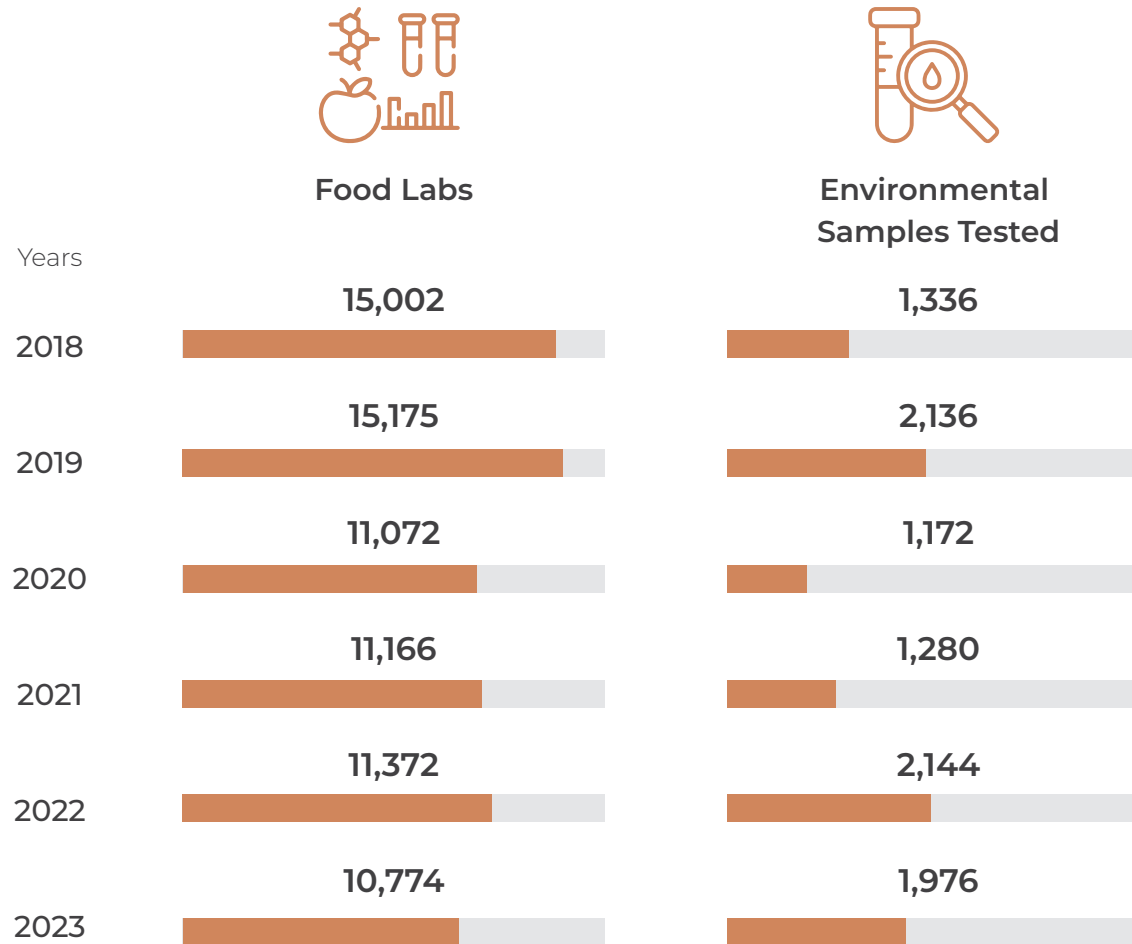




Figure (10-9): Total Processing Quantities of Ajman Sewerage (Private) Limited by Months in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023

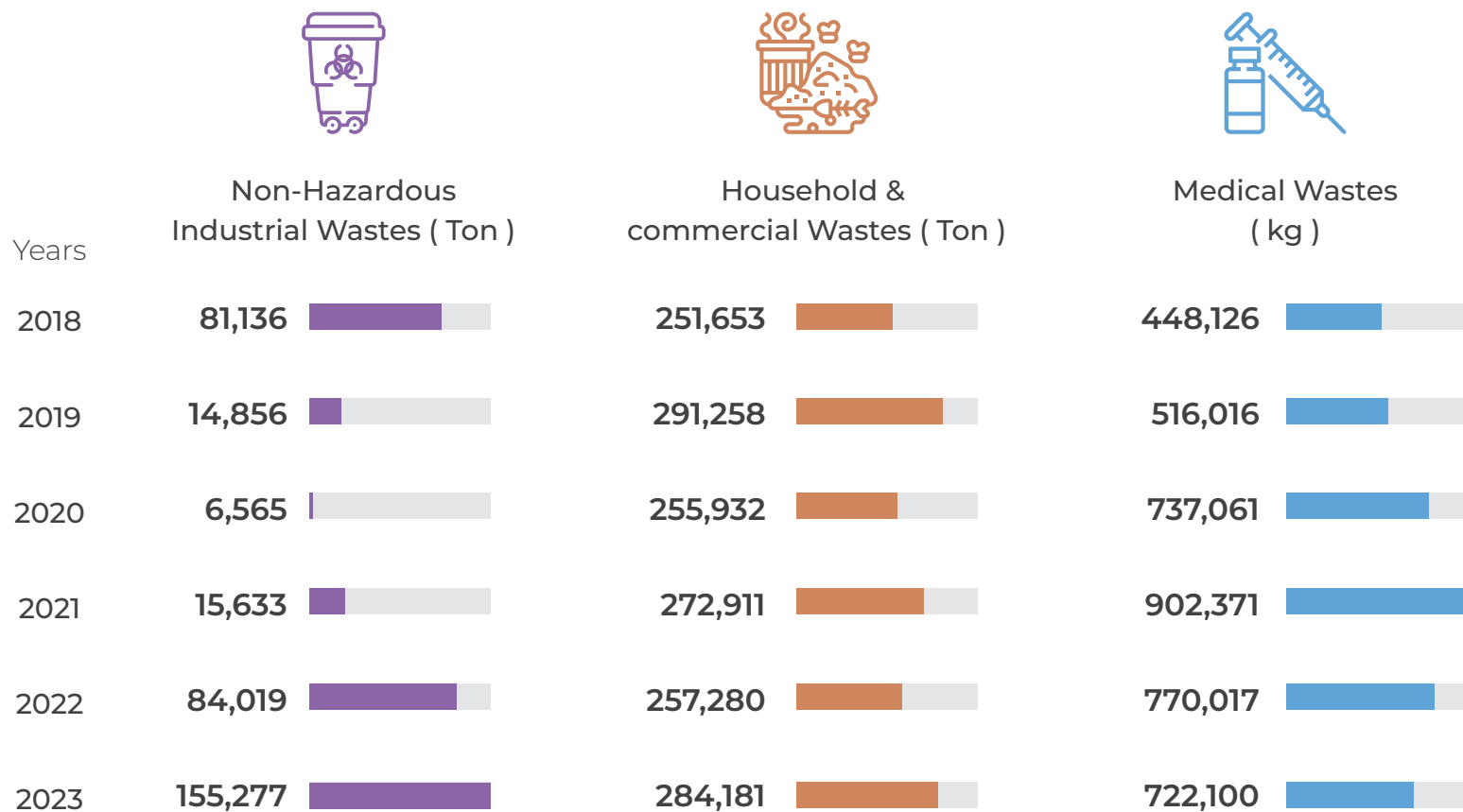




Figure (10-11): Quantity of Waste Received for the Waste Recycling Plant and the Amount of Waste that has been Sorted or Converted to Organic Fertilizer in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023

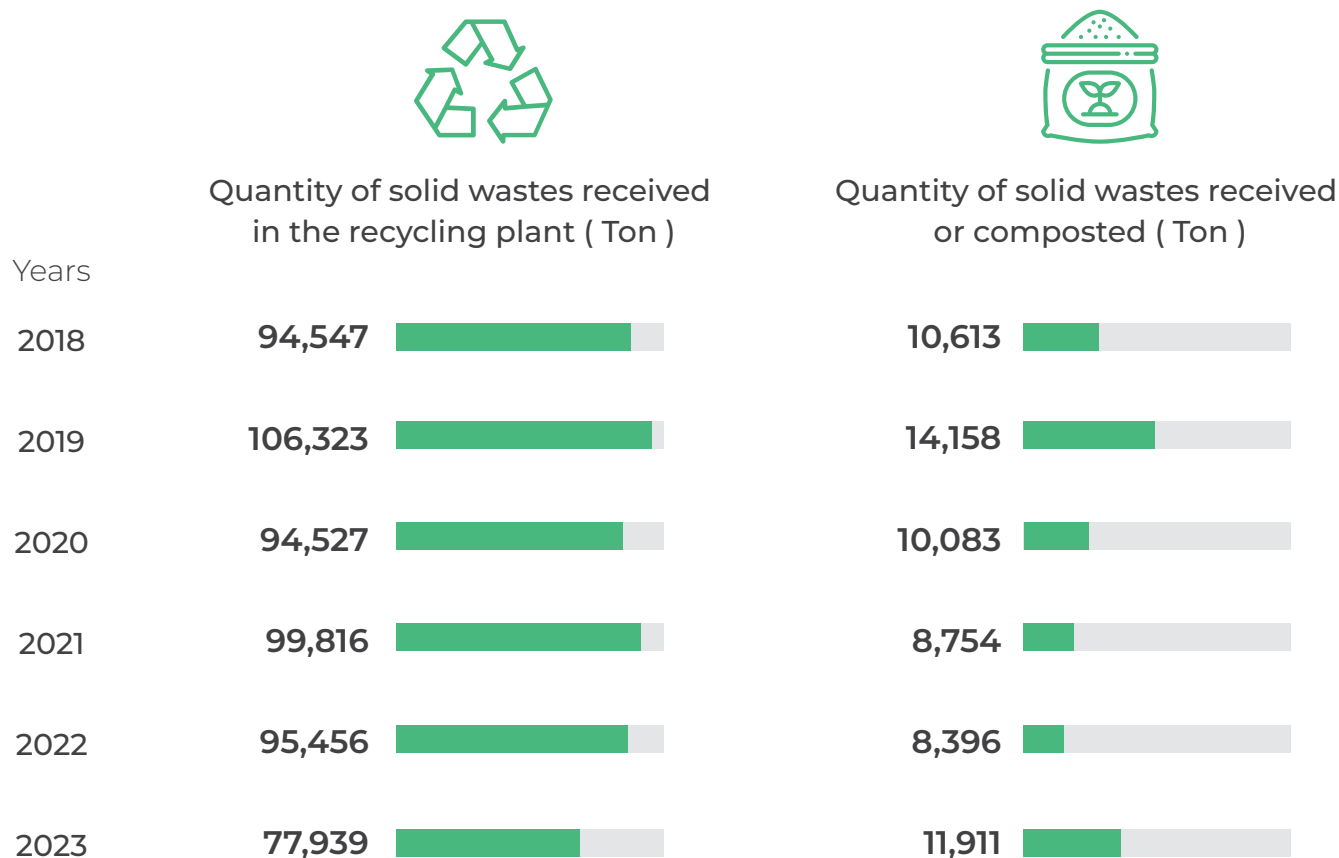




Figure (10-12): Number of Waste Containers in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023

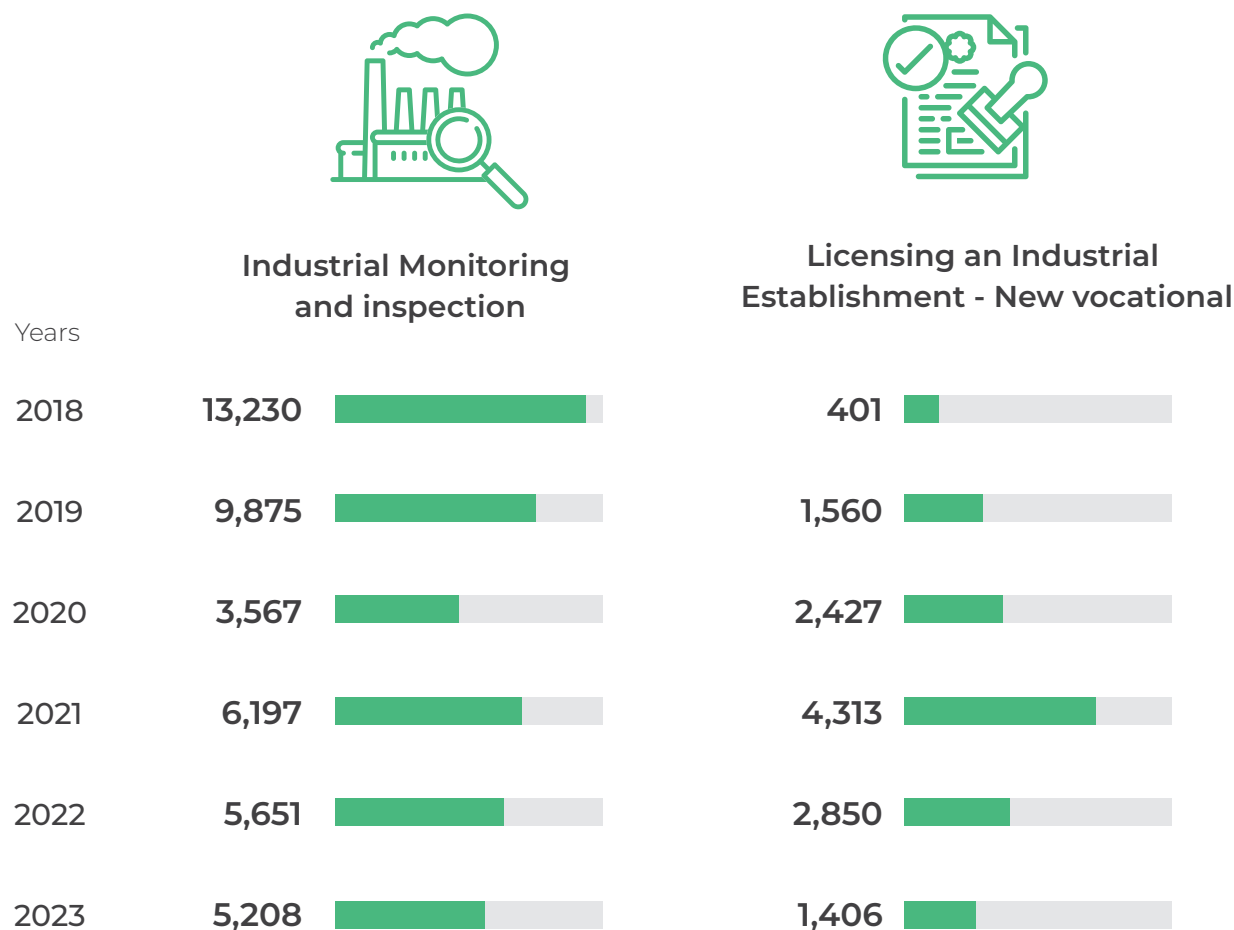

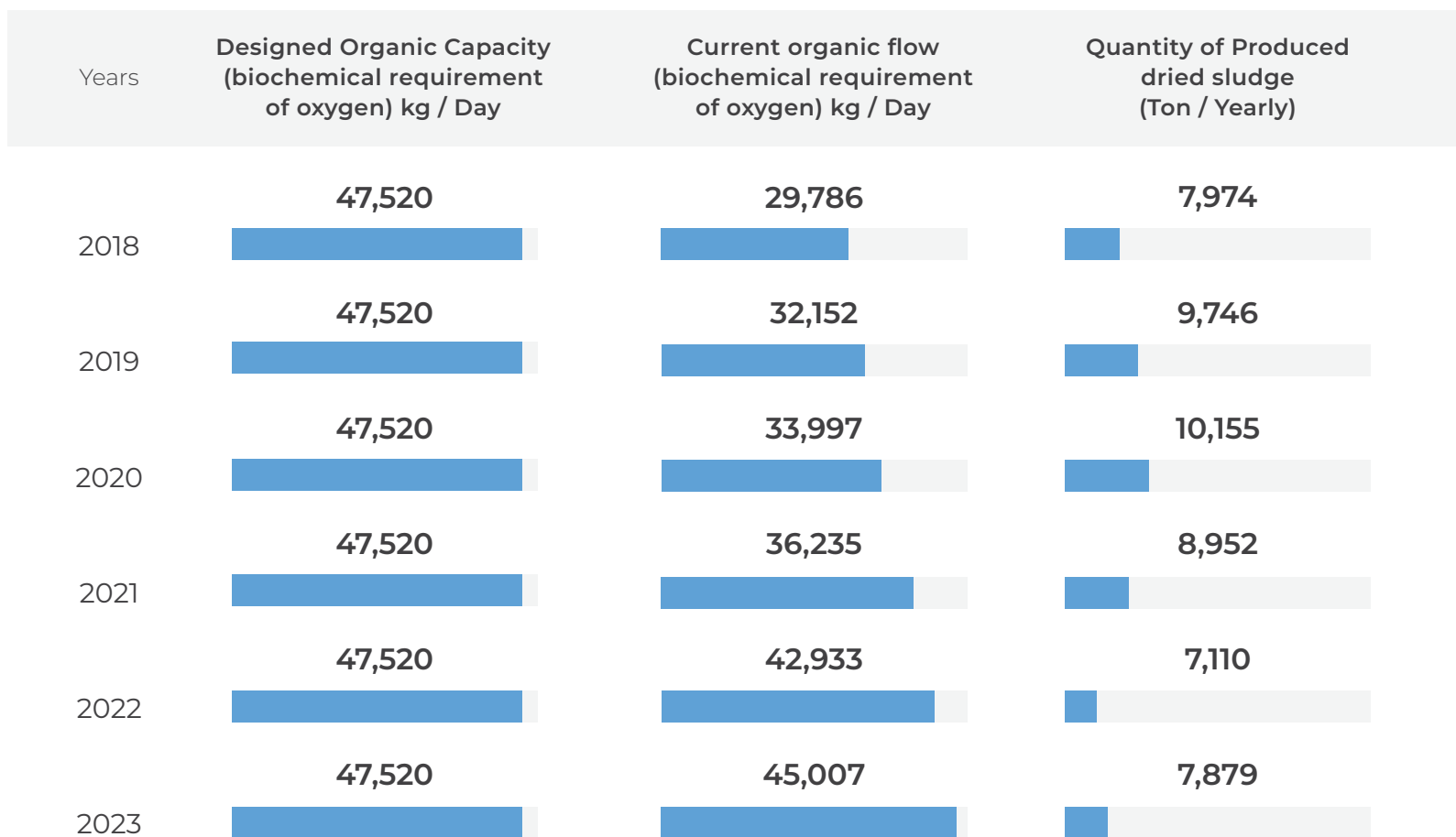
Figure (10-14): Wastewater Treatment Plant According to the Designed Water Capacity, the Actual Water Capacity and the Volume of Treated Water Produced in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018 - 2023

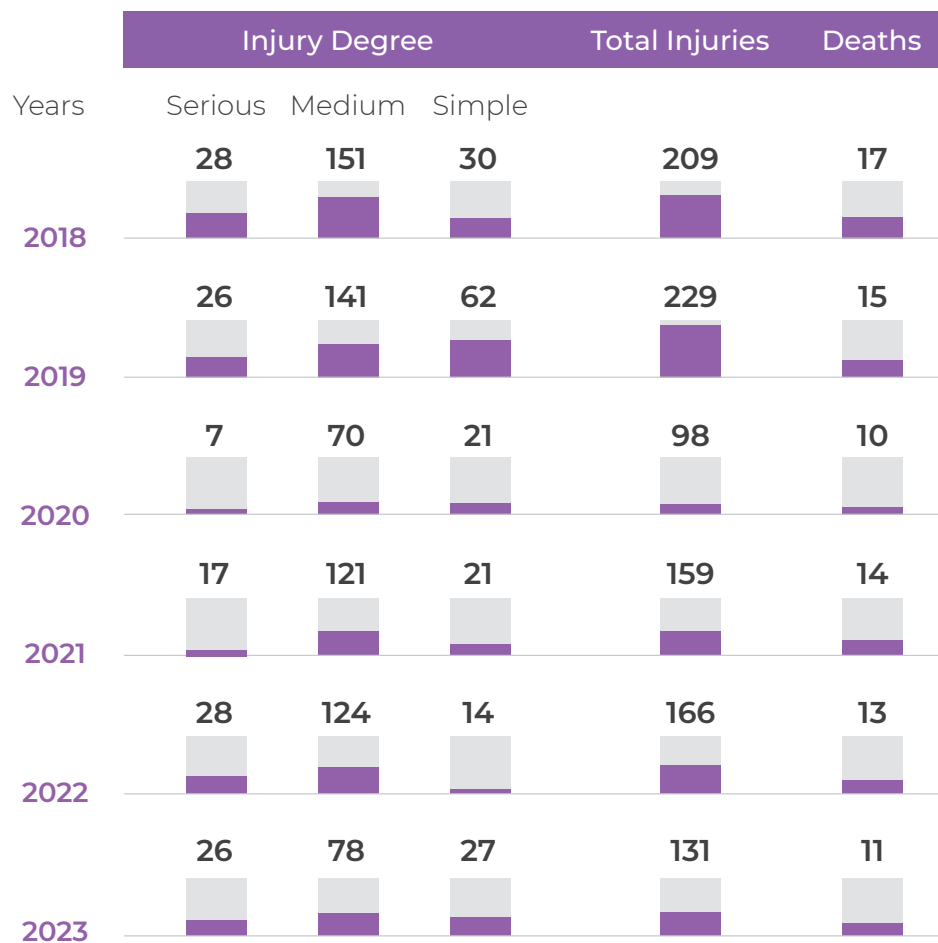

Figure (11-2): Traffic Accidents According to the Degree of Injury and Deaths during the Years 2018-2023





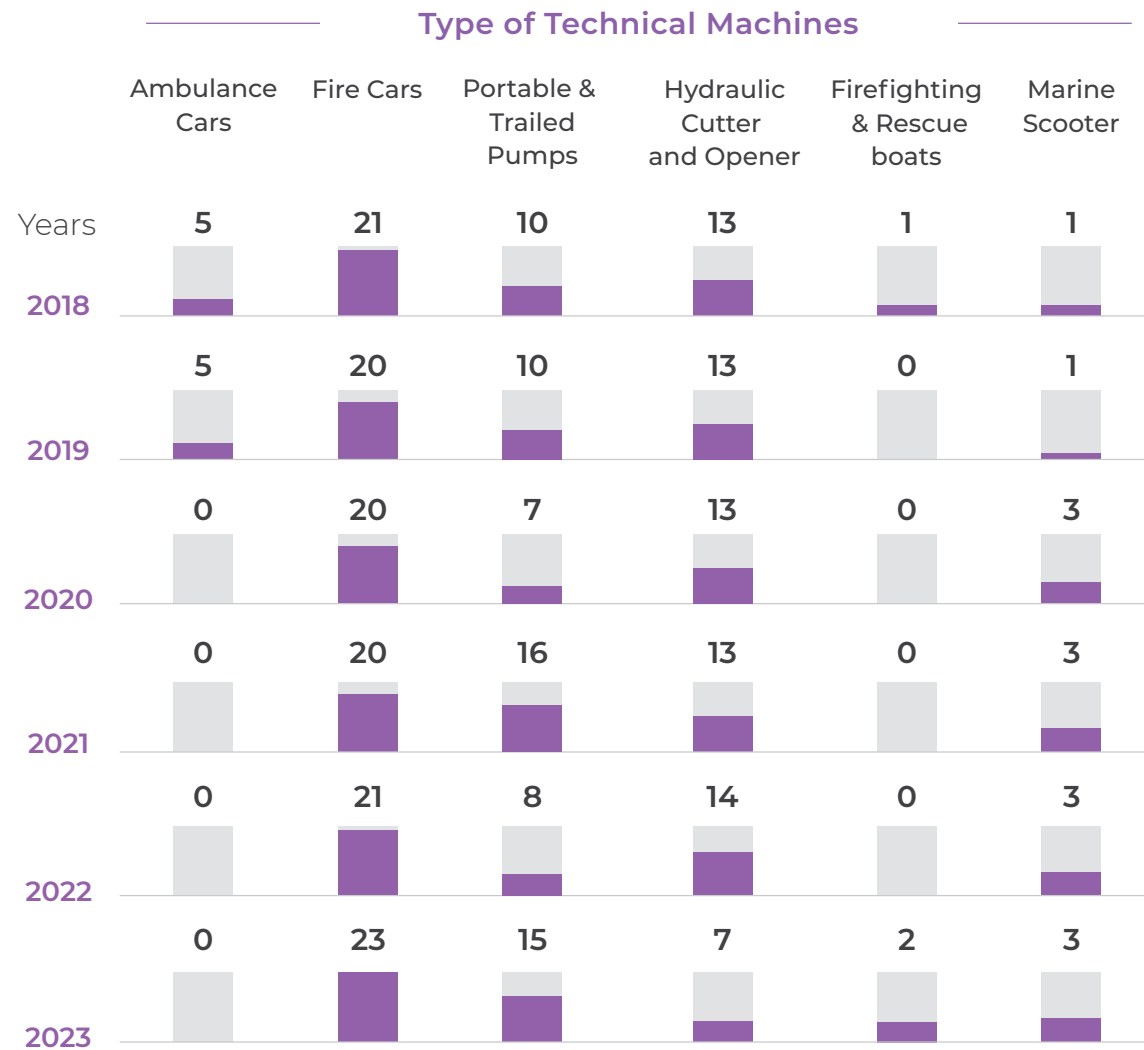


**Figure (11-3): Traffic Accidents According to the Degree of Injury and Deaths by Months during the Year 2023**

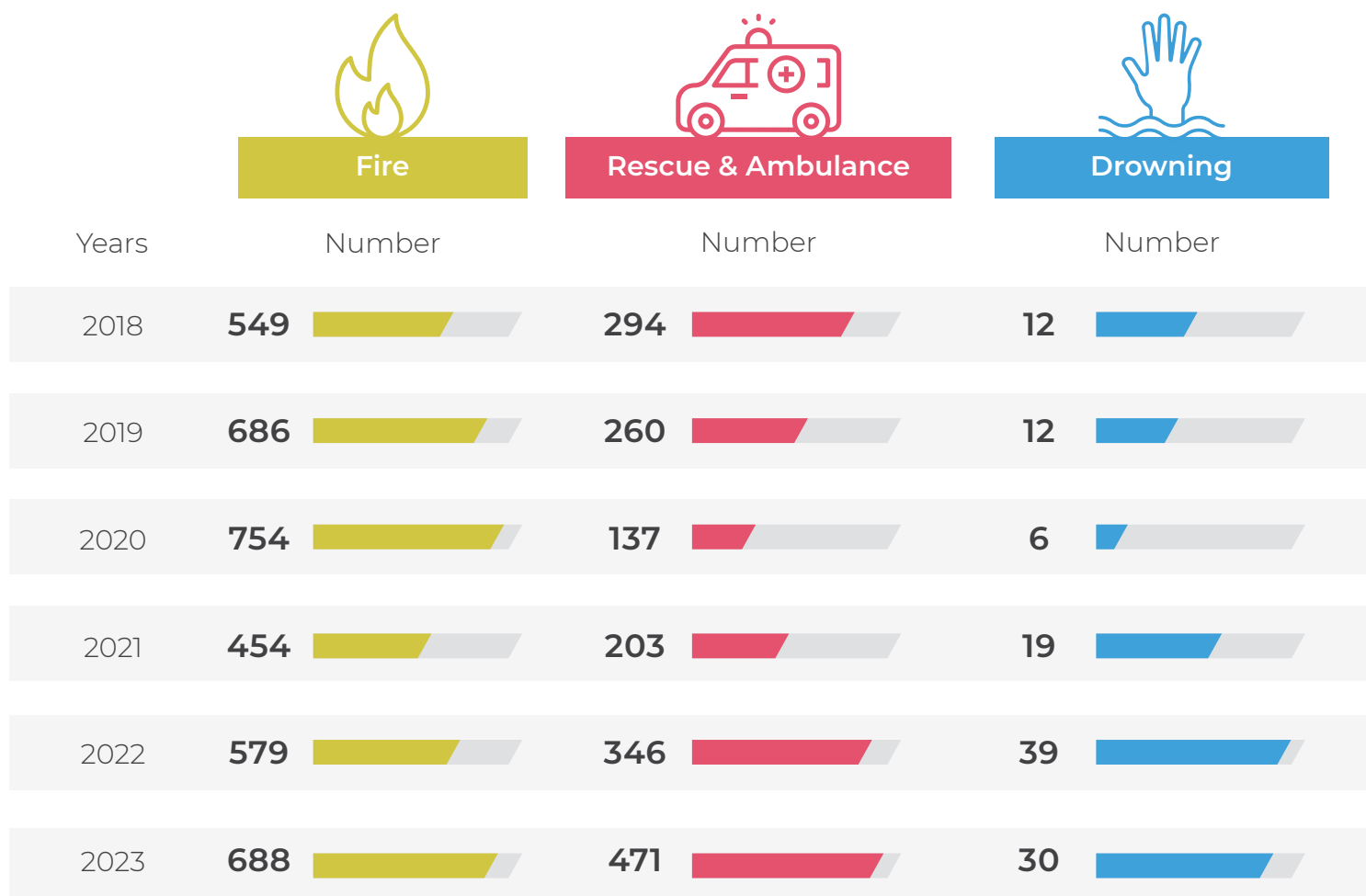
Figure (11-5): Annual Training Courses and their Attendees of Civil Defense Department in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023

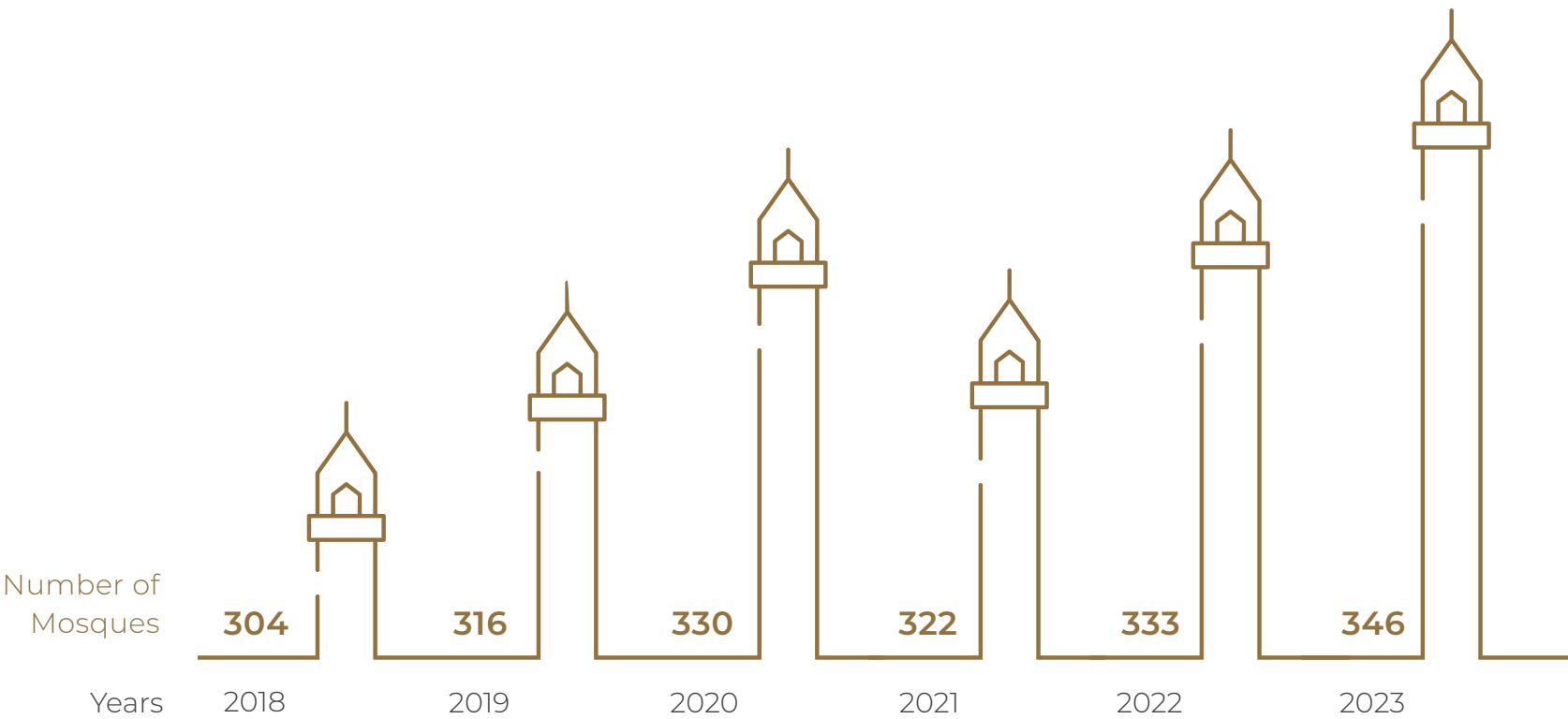

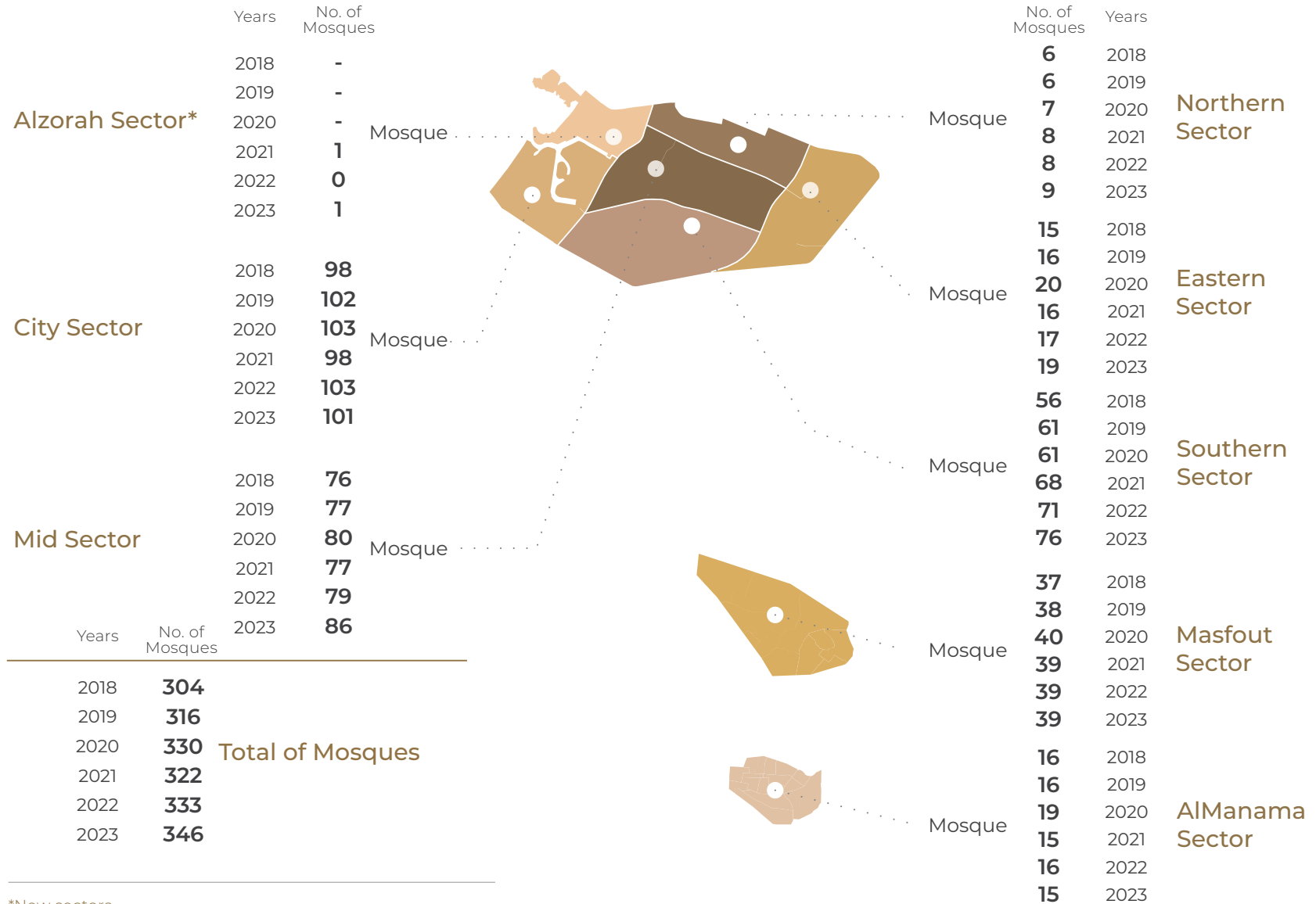

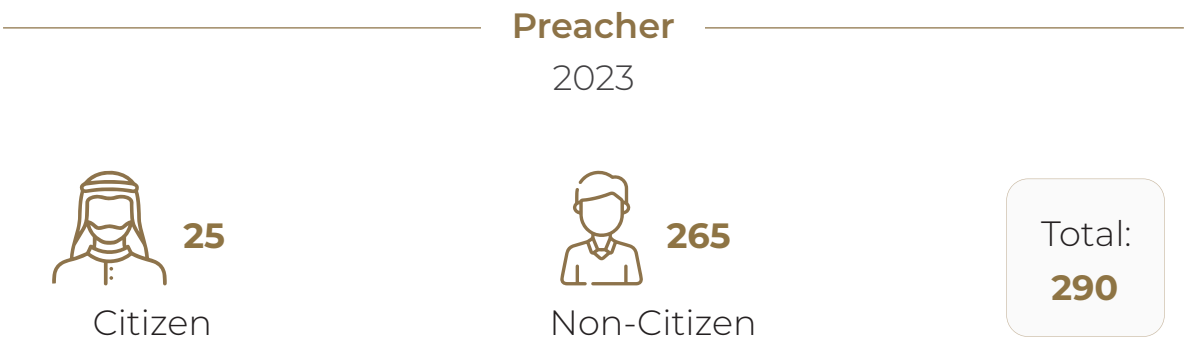
Figure (12-8): Quran Memorization Centers by Regions in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

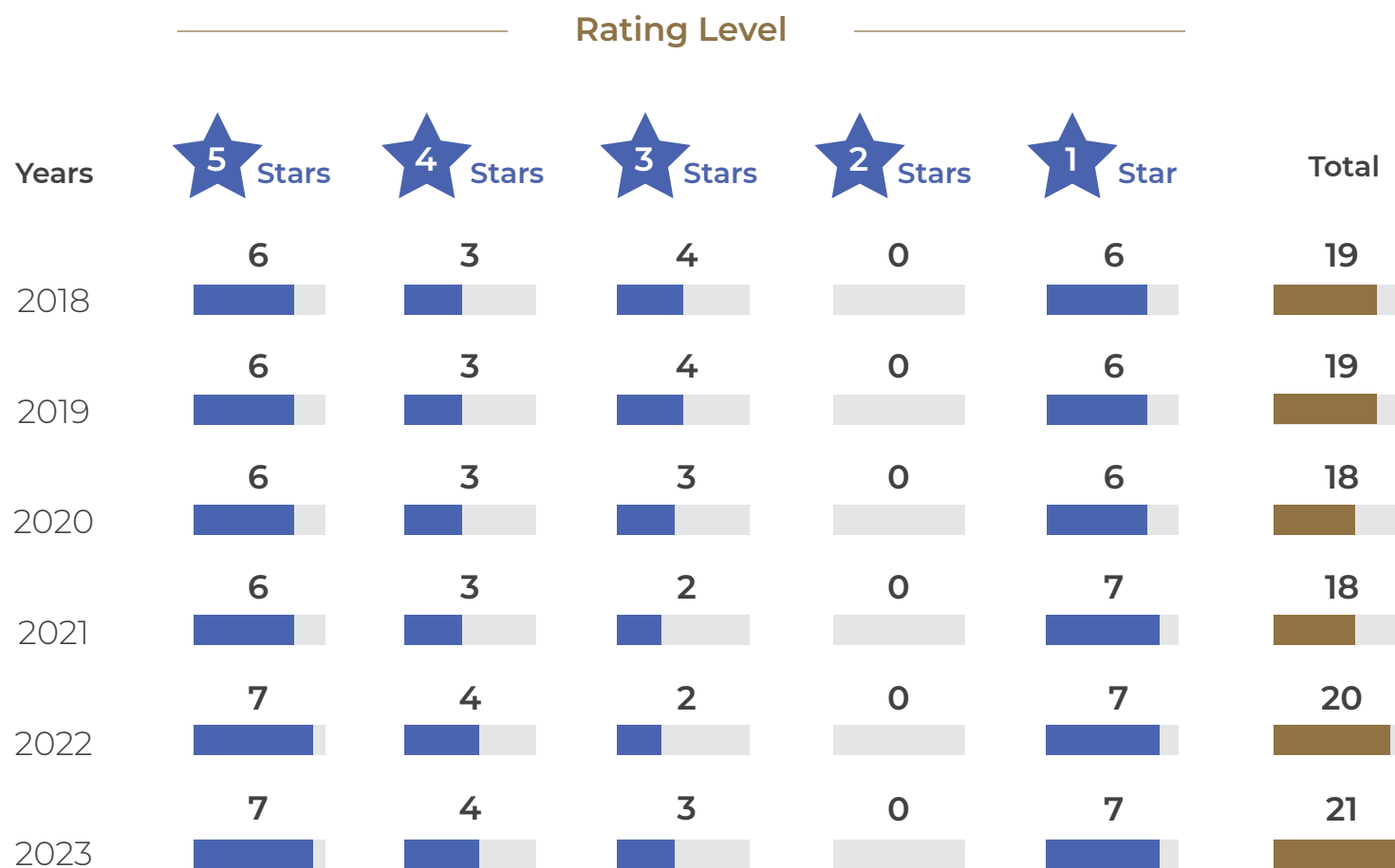

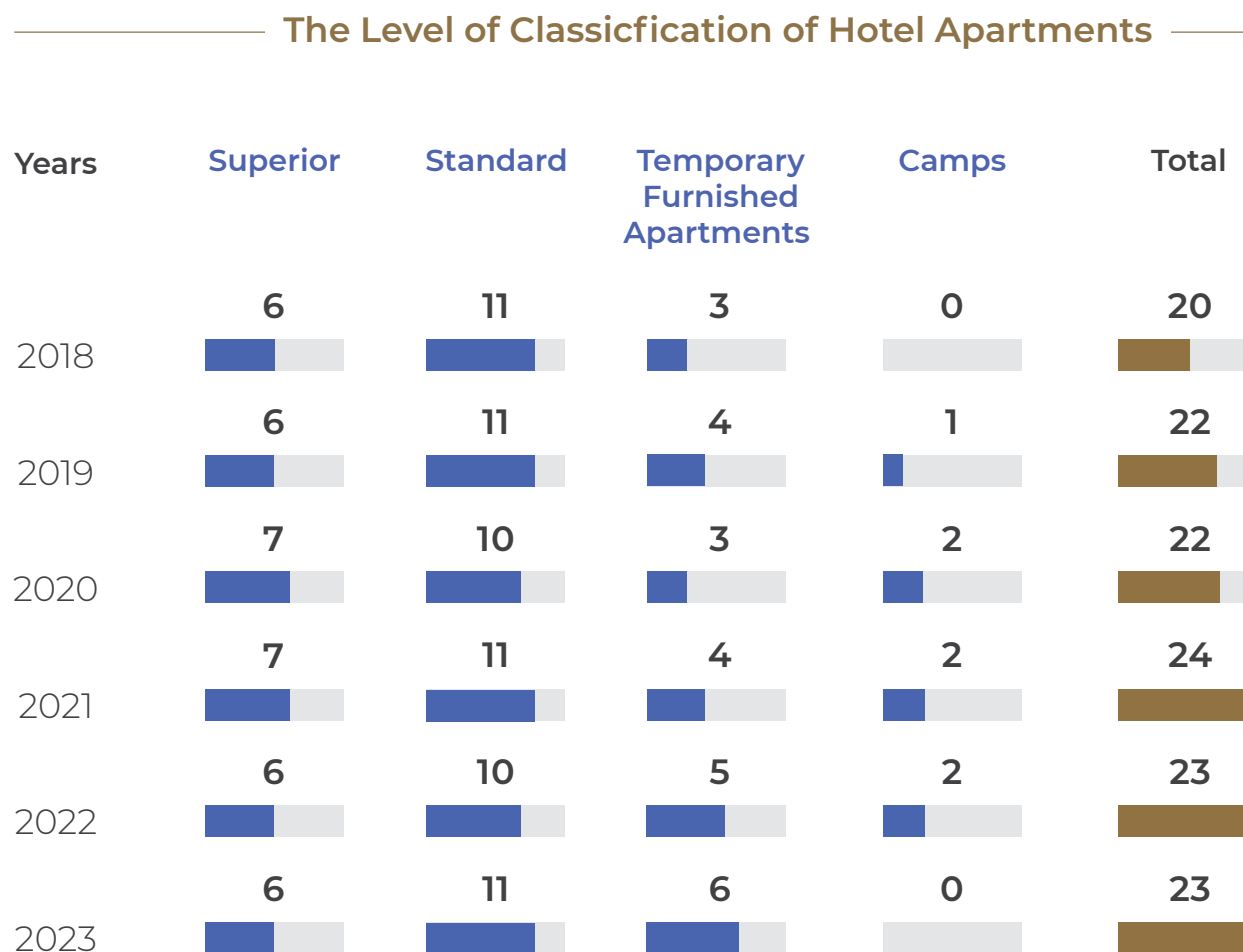


Figure (13-1): Hotels by Rating Level in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023

**Figure (13-3): Number of Hotels Establishments, Beds and Rooms in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023**

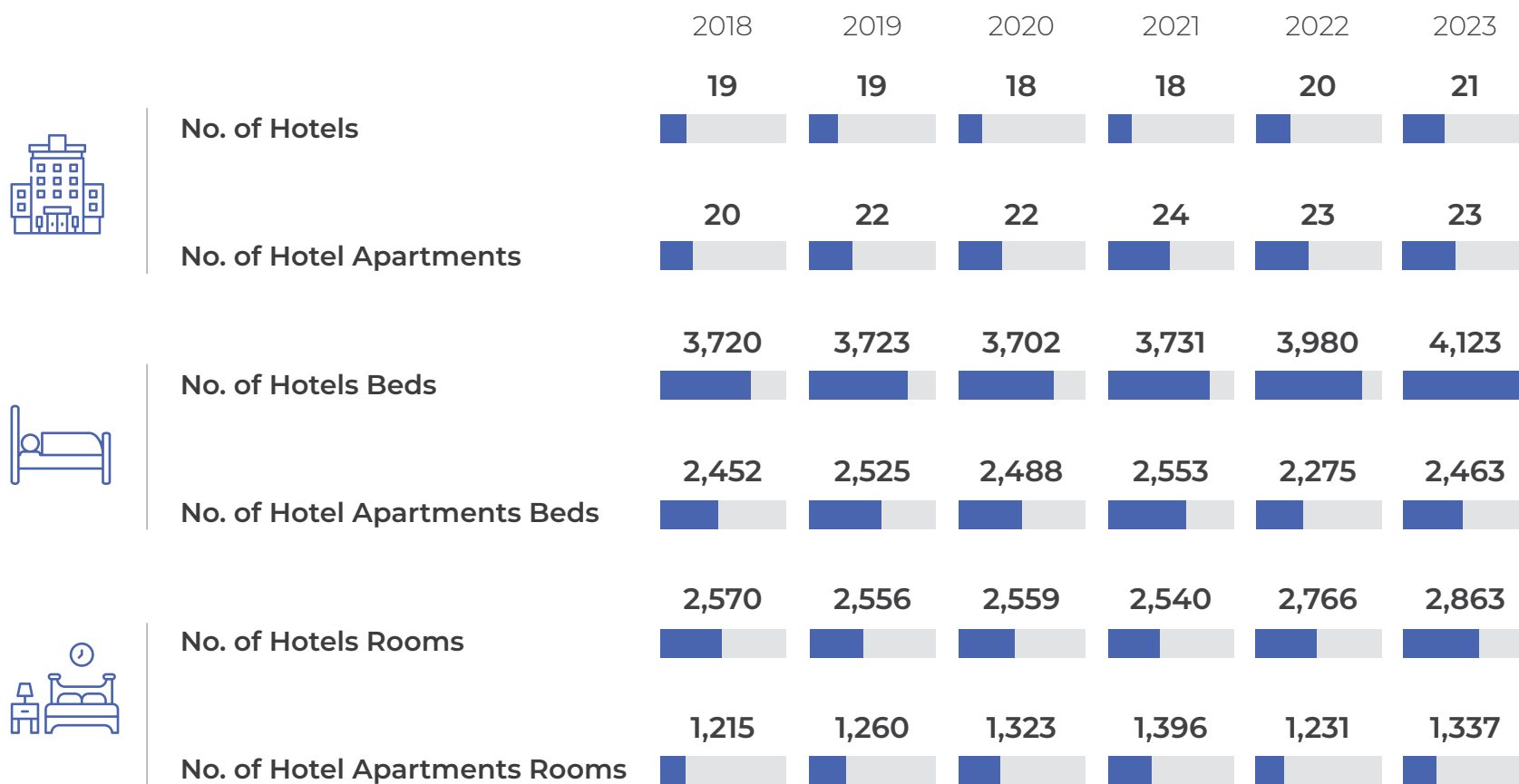
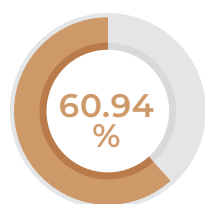




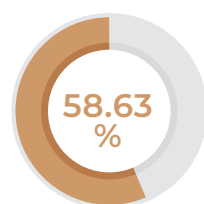
Figure (13-4): Hotel Room & Hotel Apartments Occupancy in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2018-2023



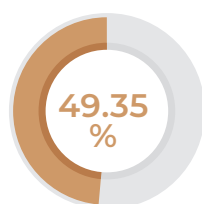

Figure (13-6): Number of Ajman Museum Visitors during the Years 2018-2023

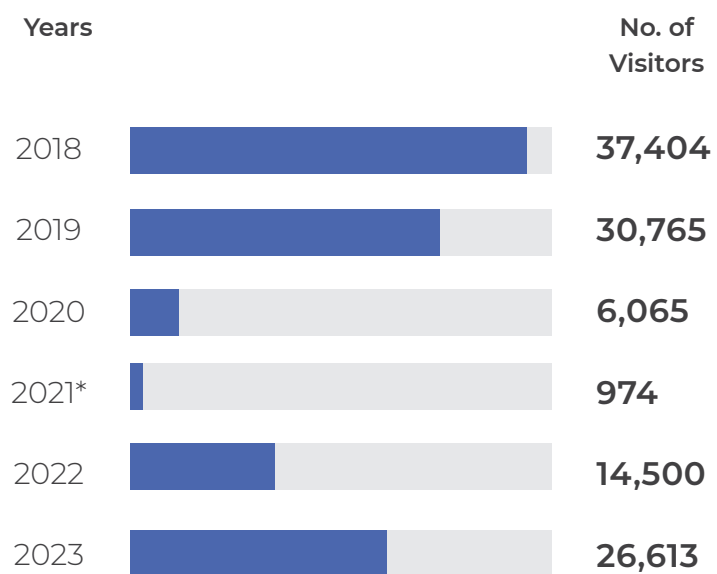




Figure (13-7): Number of Ajman Museum Visitors by Months during the Year 2023

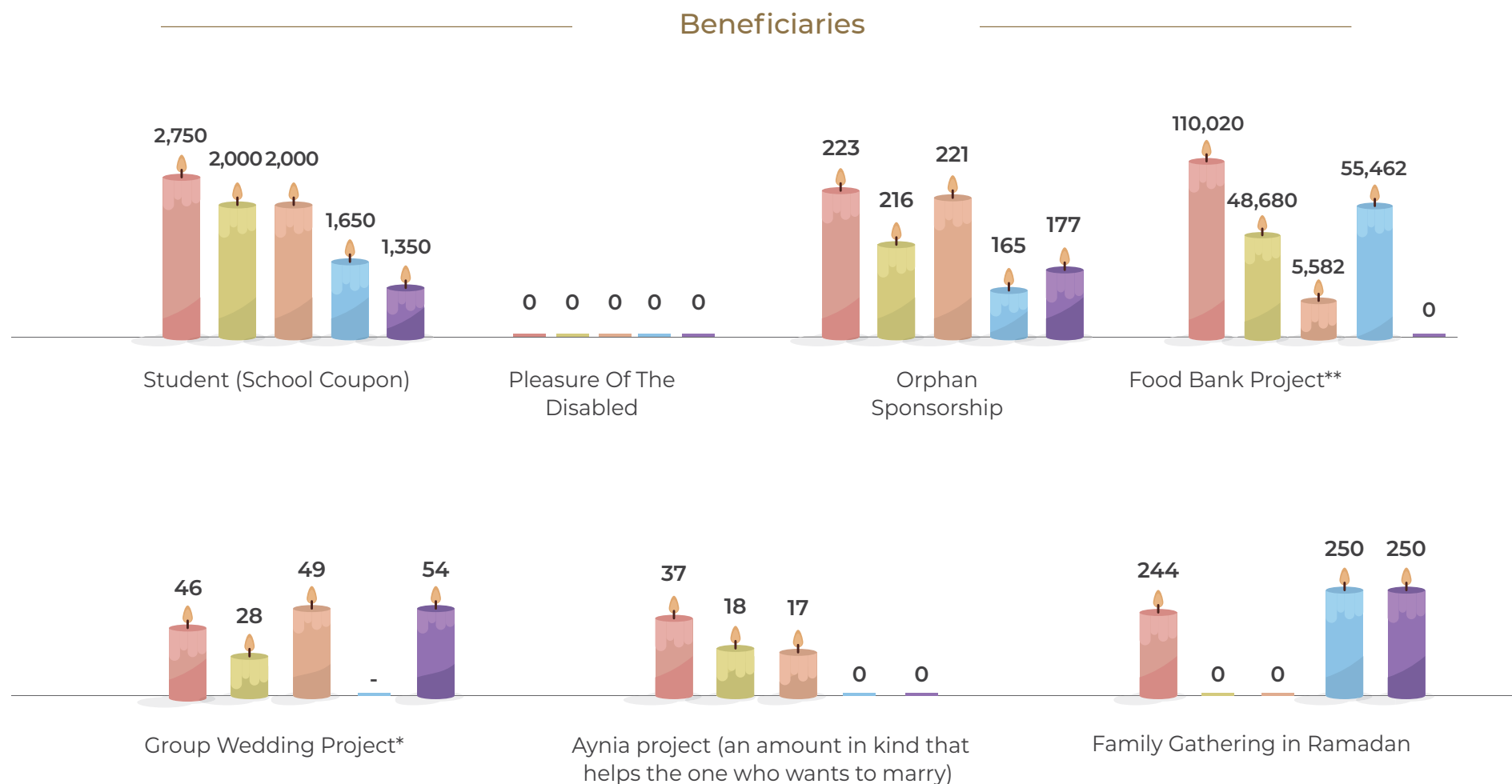

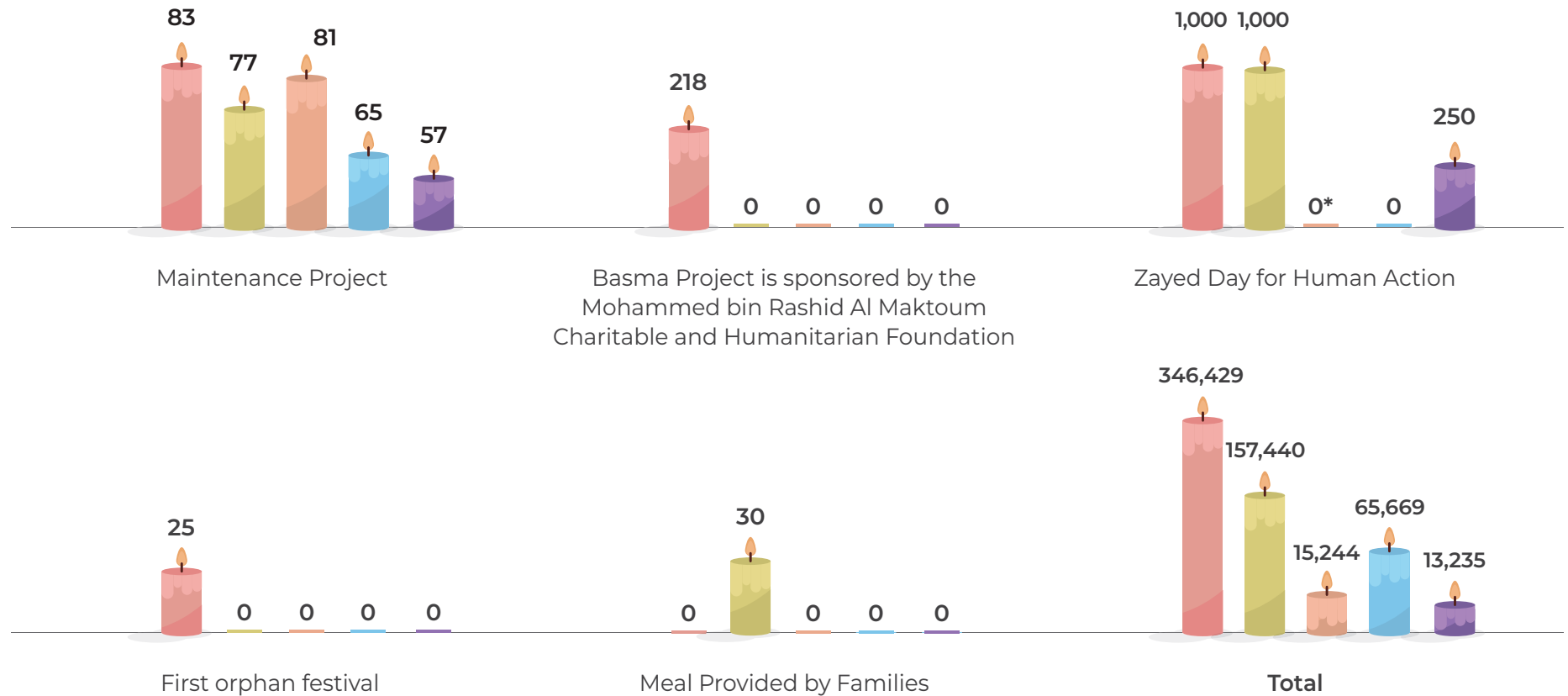

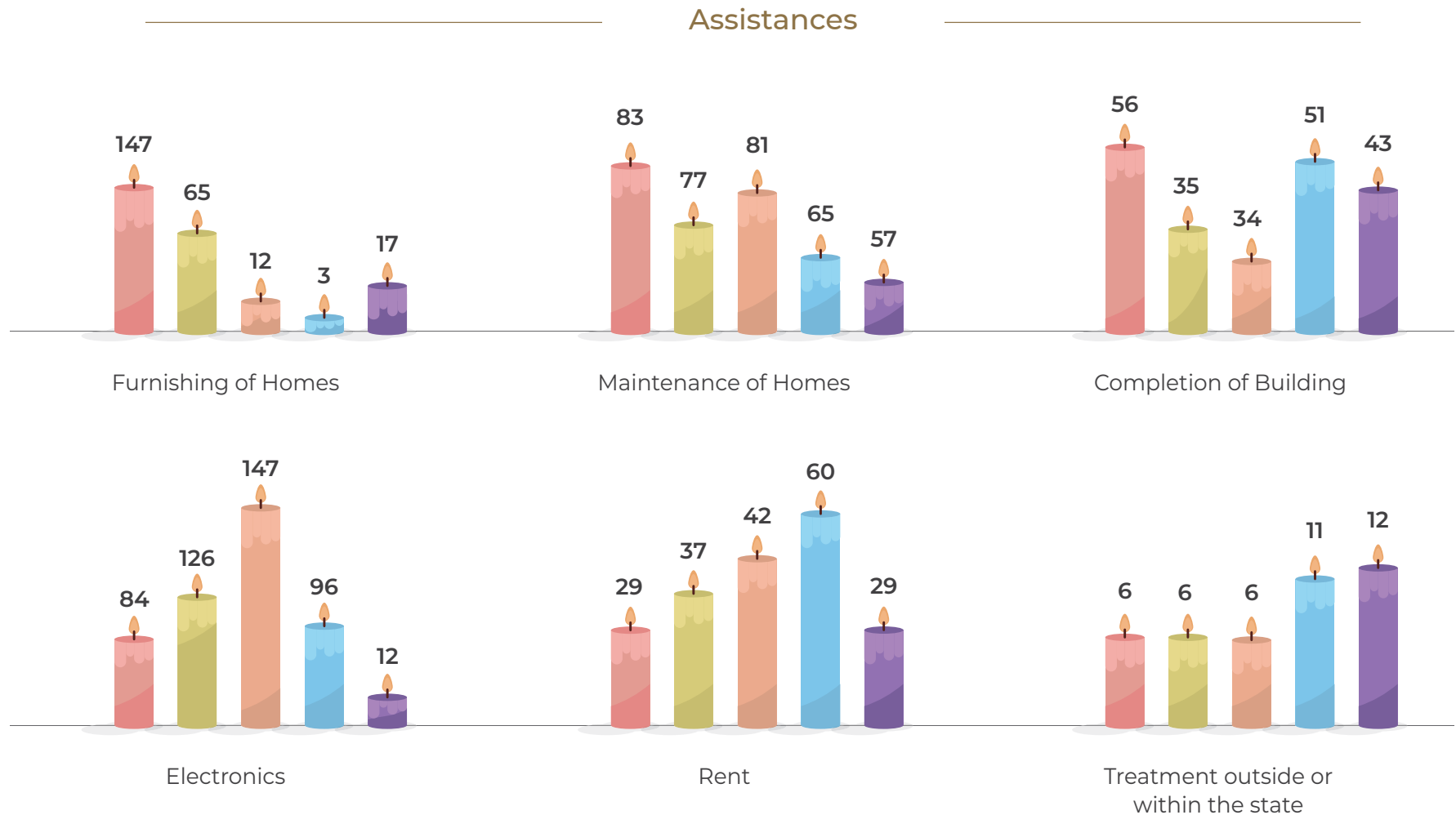

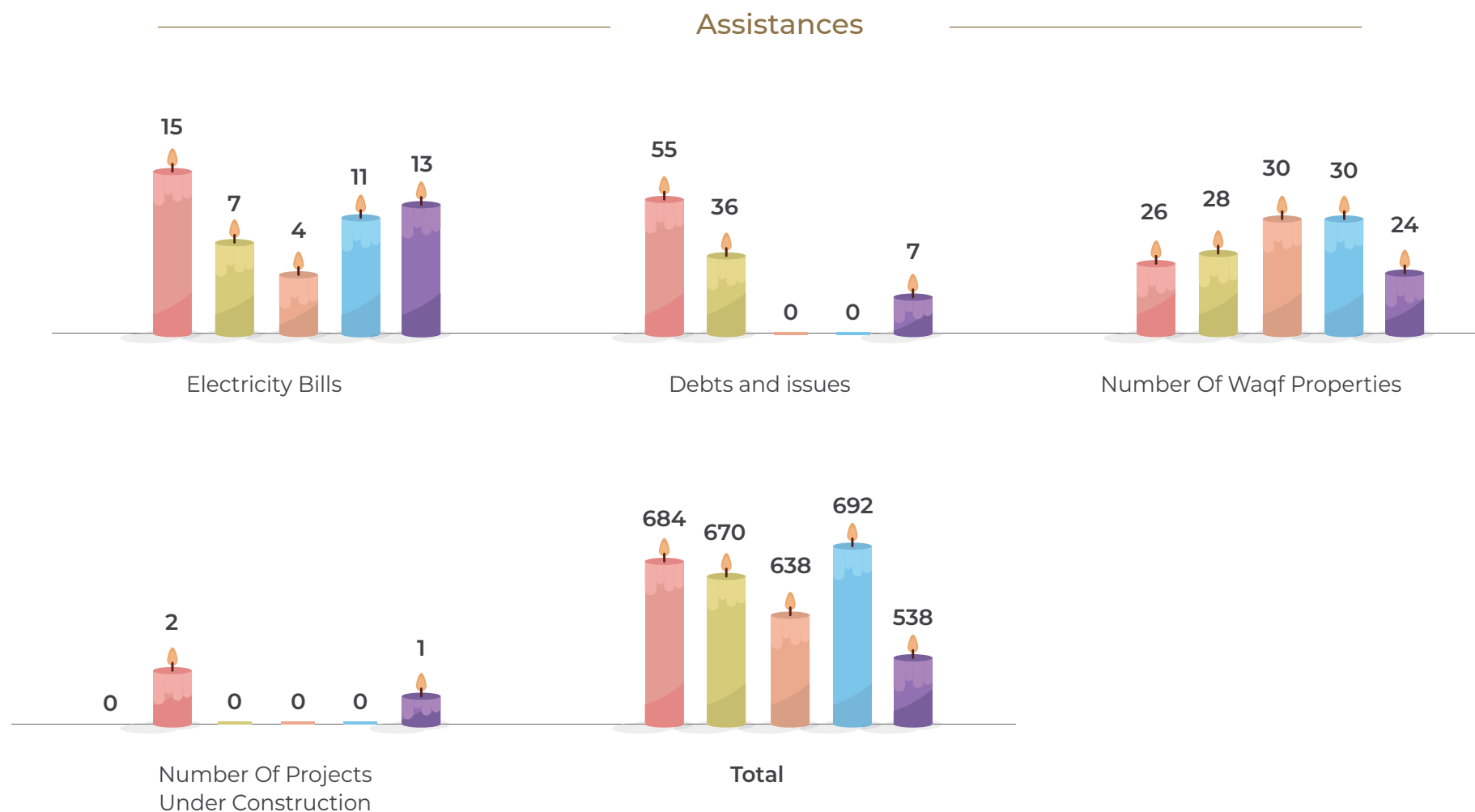

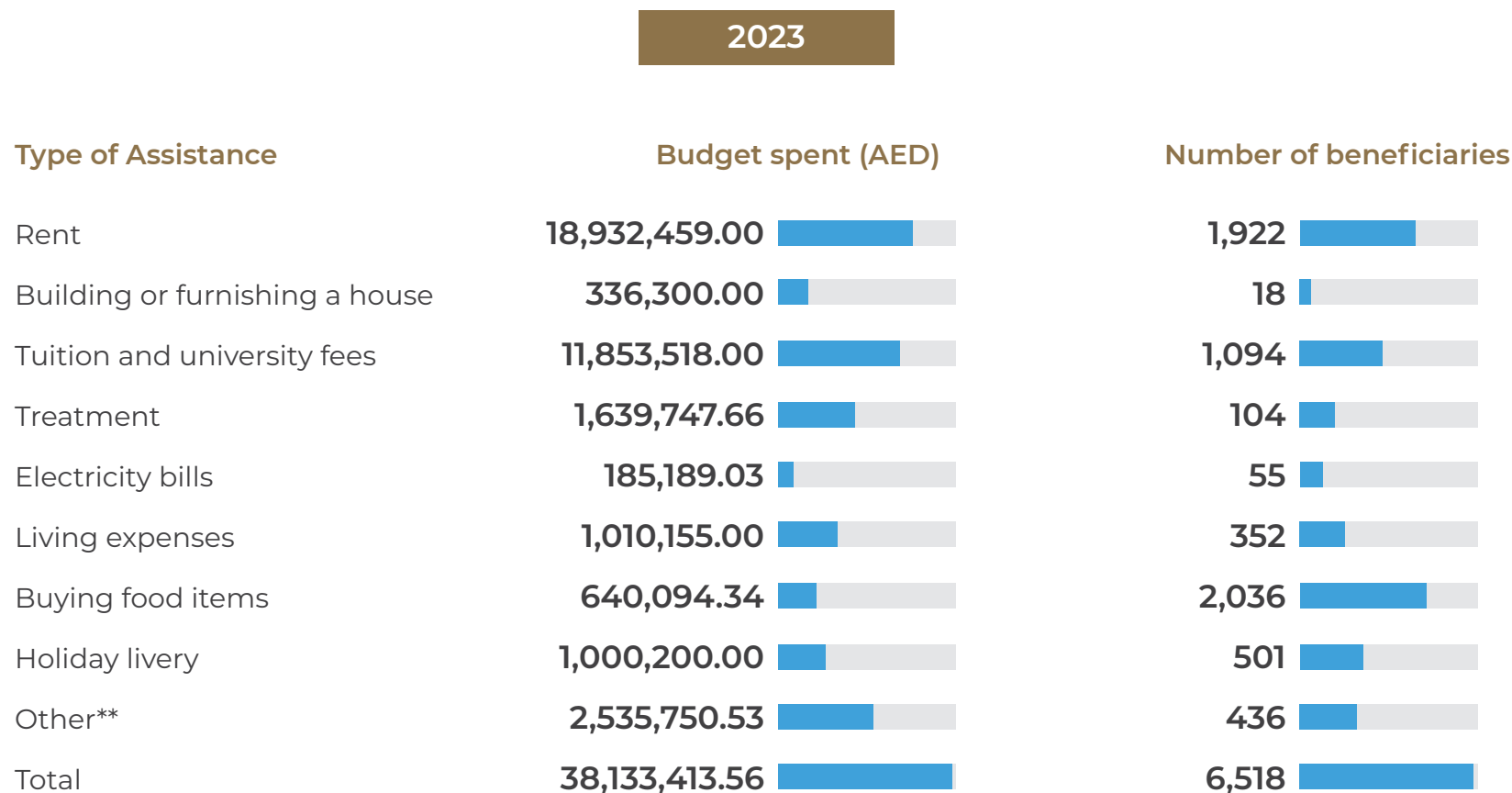

Figure (15-5): Programs and projects of Dar Al-Ber Association Ajman branch outside the country during the year 2023

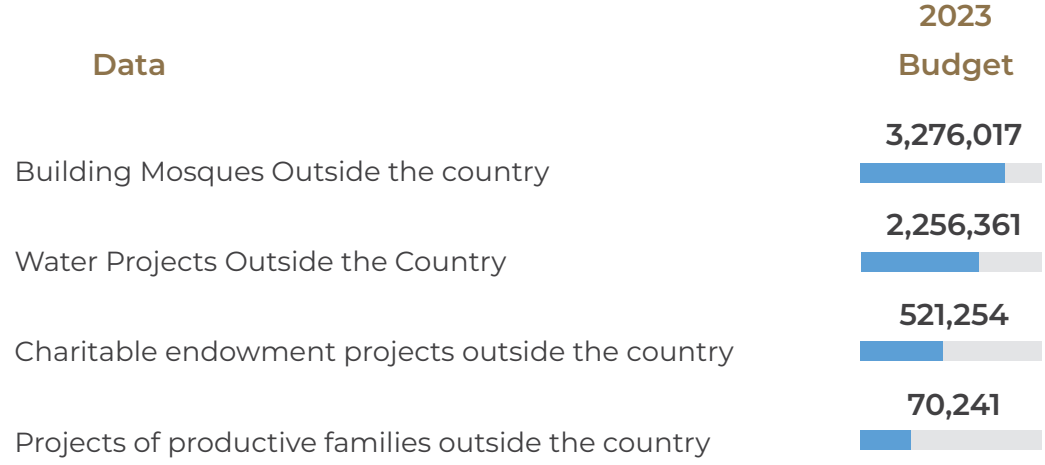








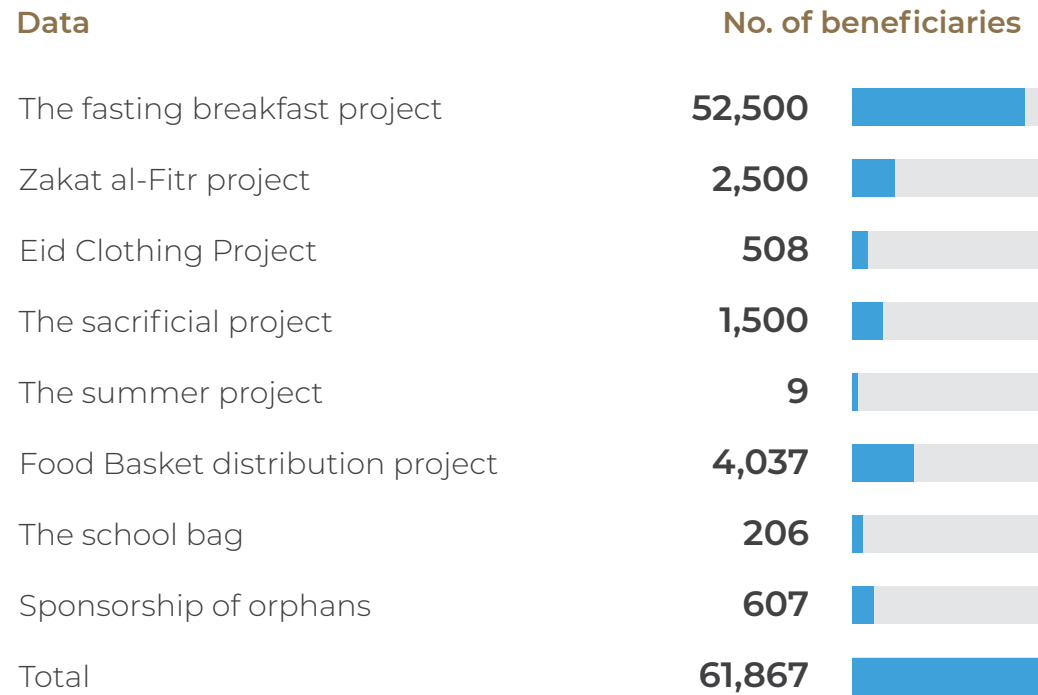
Figure (15-6): Developed and Beneficiary Families by Type of Assistance and Nationality from Dar Al Ber Society Ajman Branch during the Year 2023

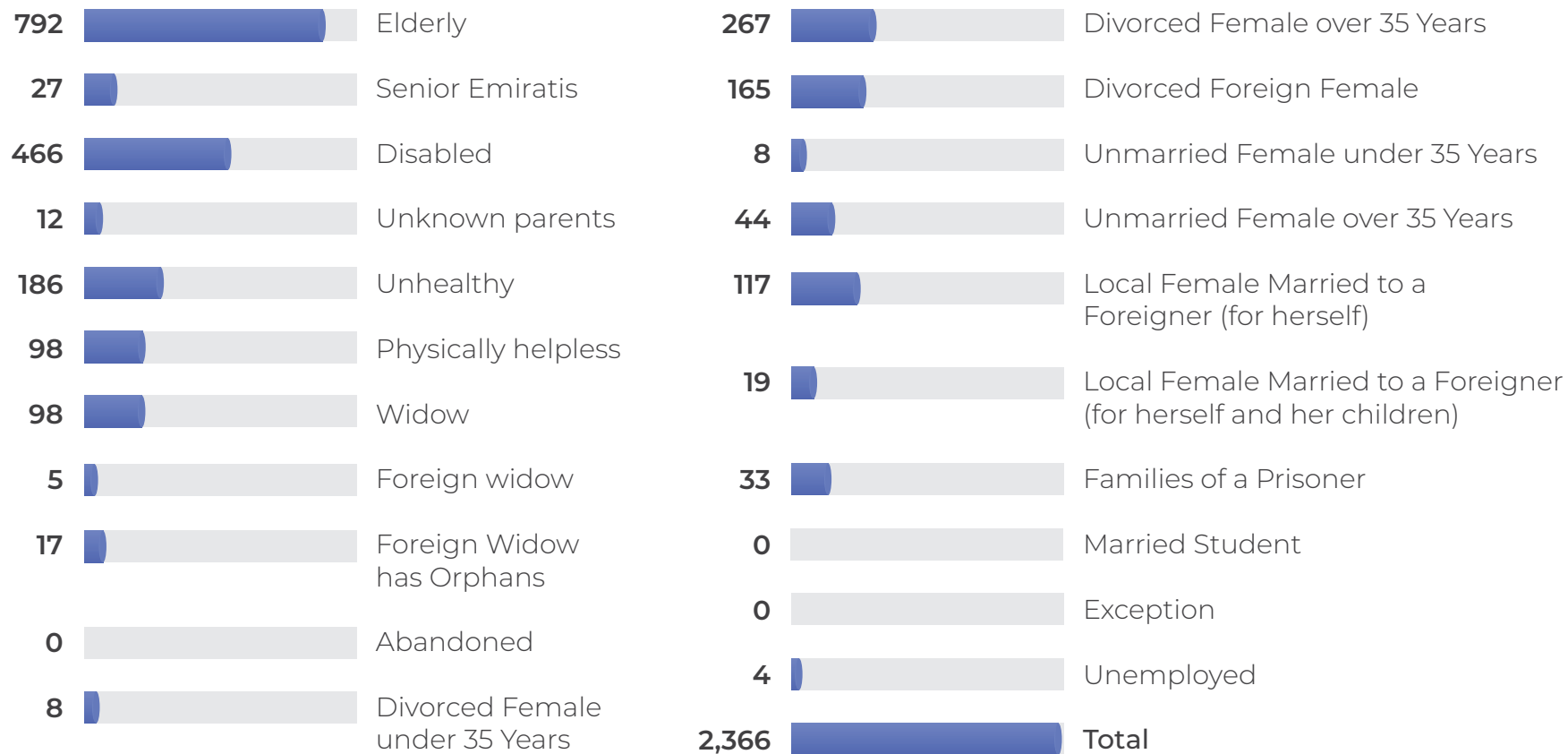
Figure (15-7): Beneficiaries from Programs and projects of Dar Al-Albar Association Ajman branch in the Emirate of Ajman during year 2023

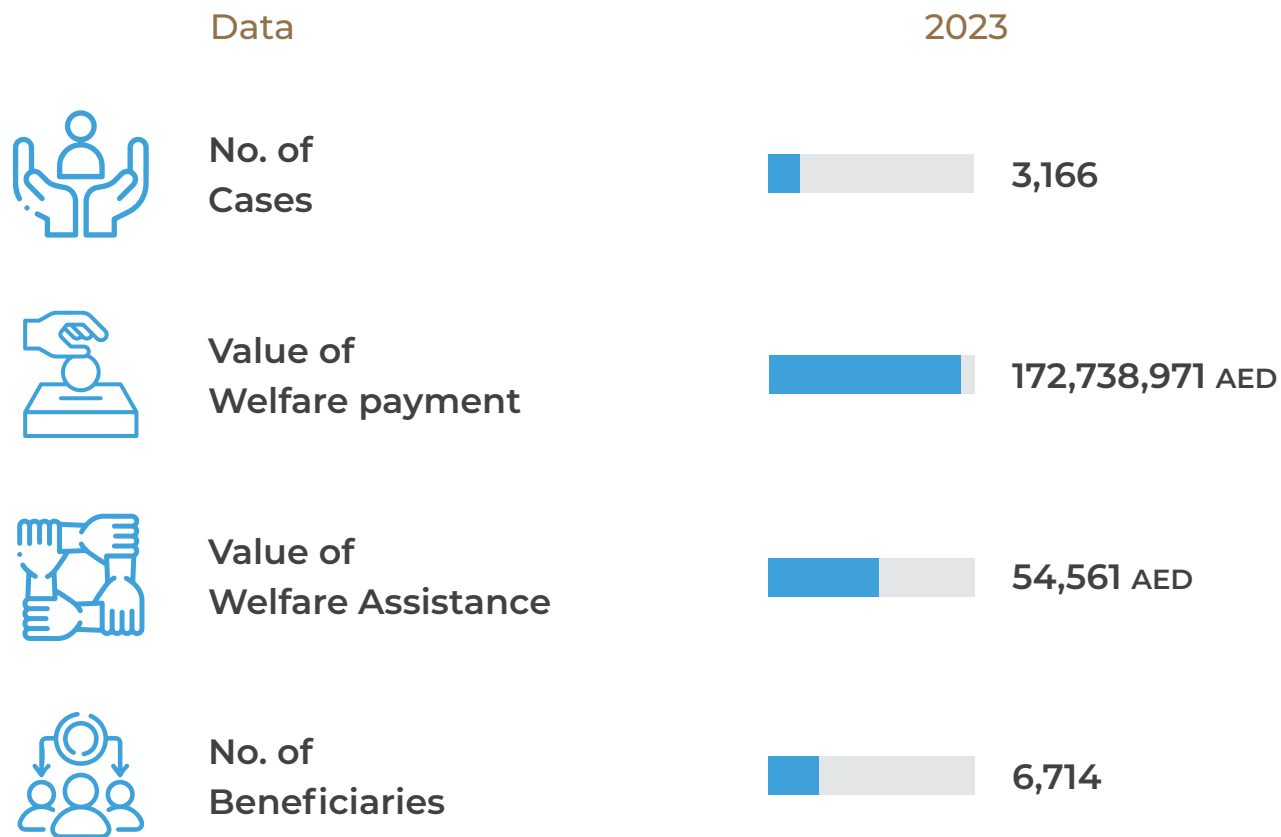
**Figure (15-8): Number of Social Assistance Cases (Cards) by Type of Case by categories in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023**

Figure (15-9): Social Assistance Cases, Values and No. of Beneficiaries in the Emirate of Ajman during the year 2023







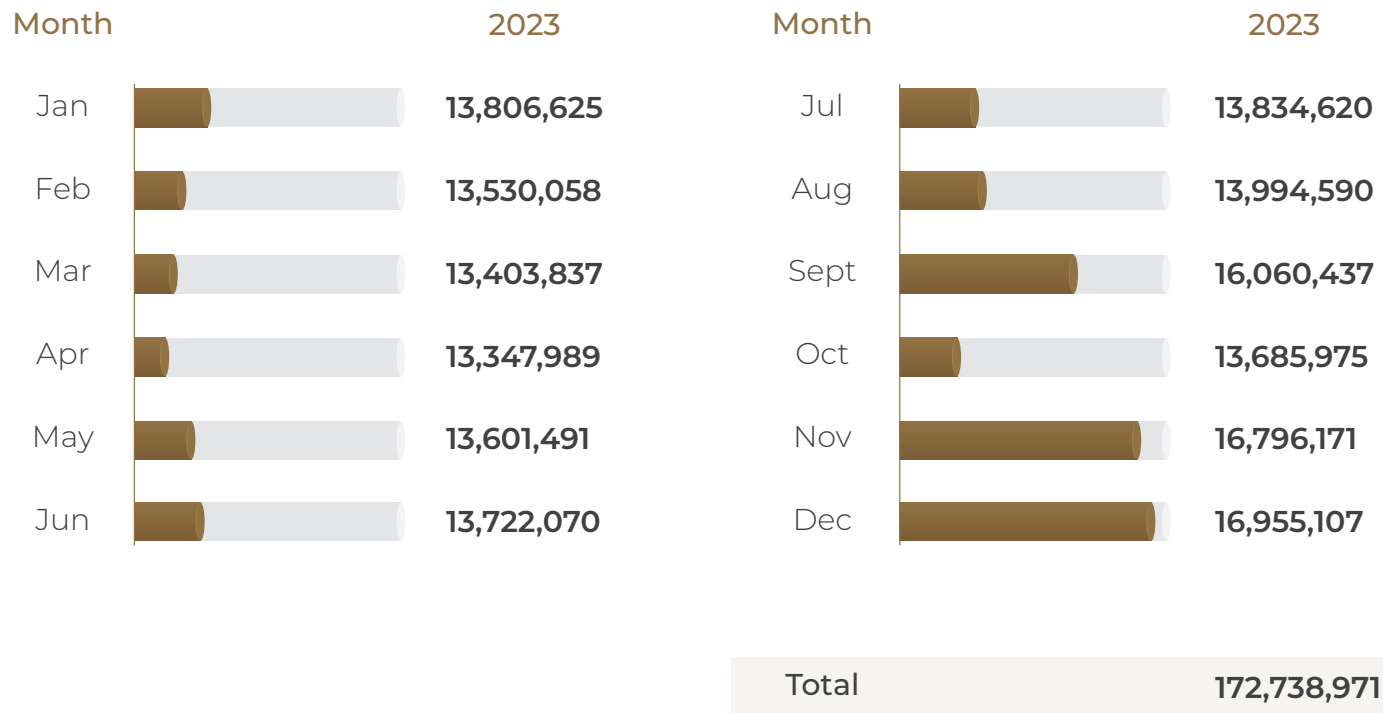
**Figure (15-10): Social Assistance Cases (Cards) by Category in the Emirate of Ajman during the year 2023**

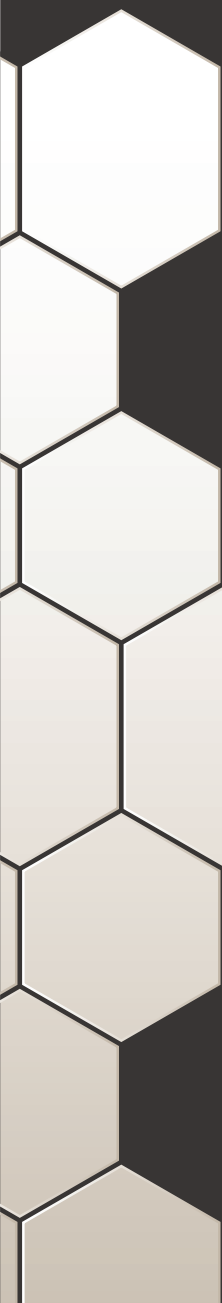

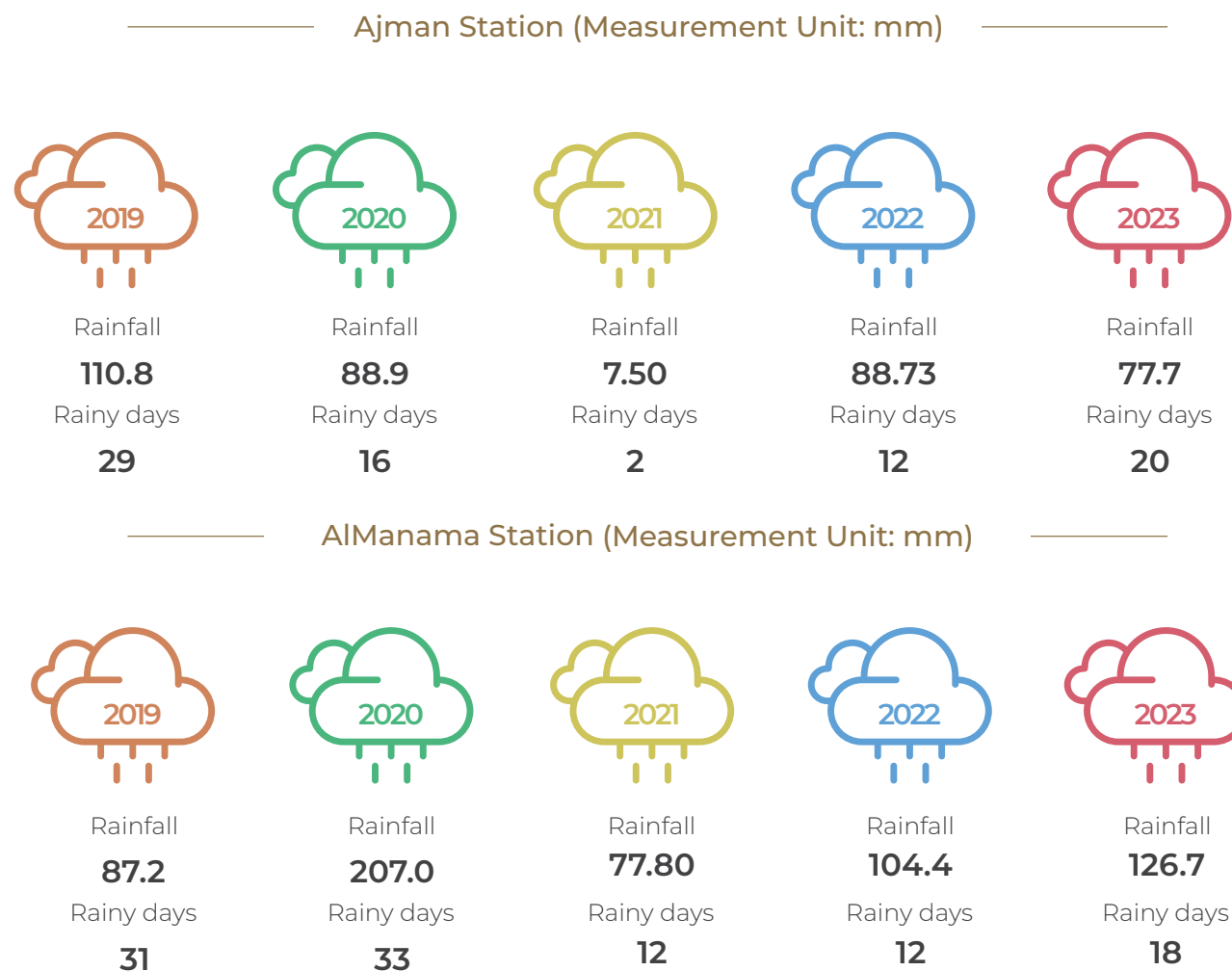
**Figure (17-2): Average Temperature (Maximum and Minimum) by Month and Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023**

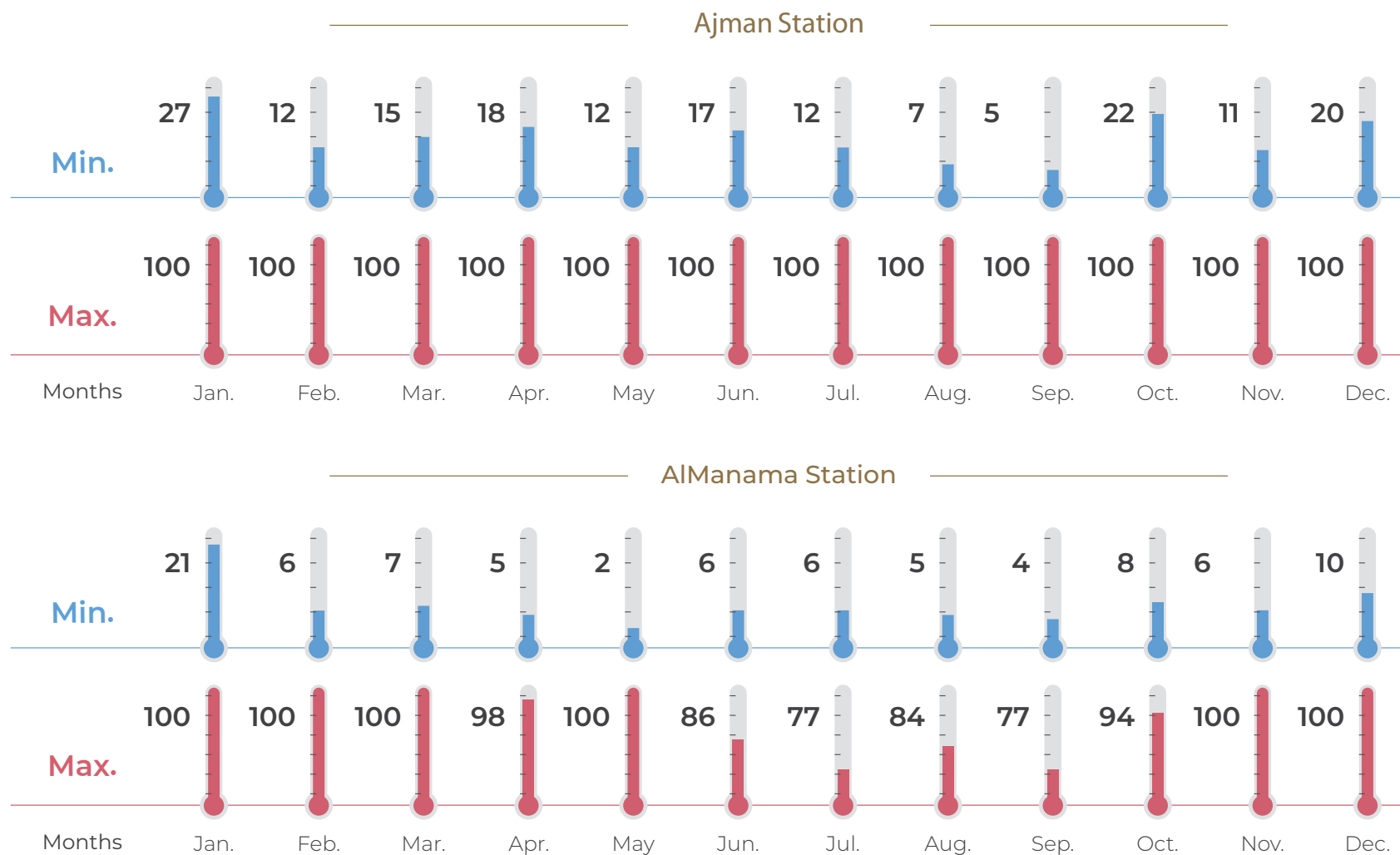
Figure (17-3): Total Rainfall Quantity and Number of Rainy Days by Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Years 2019-2023

Figure (17-4): Maximum and Minimum of Relative Humidity by Month and Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

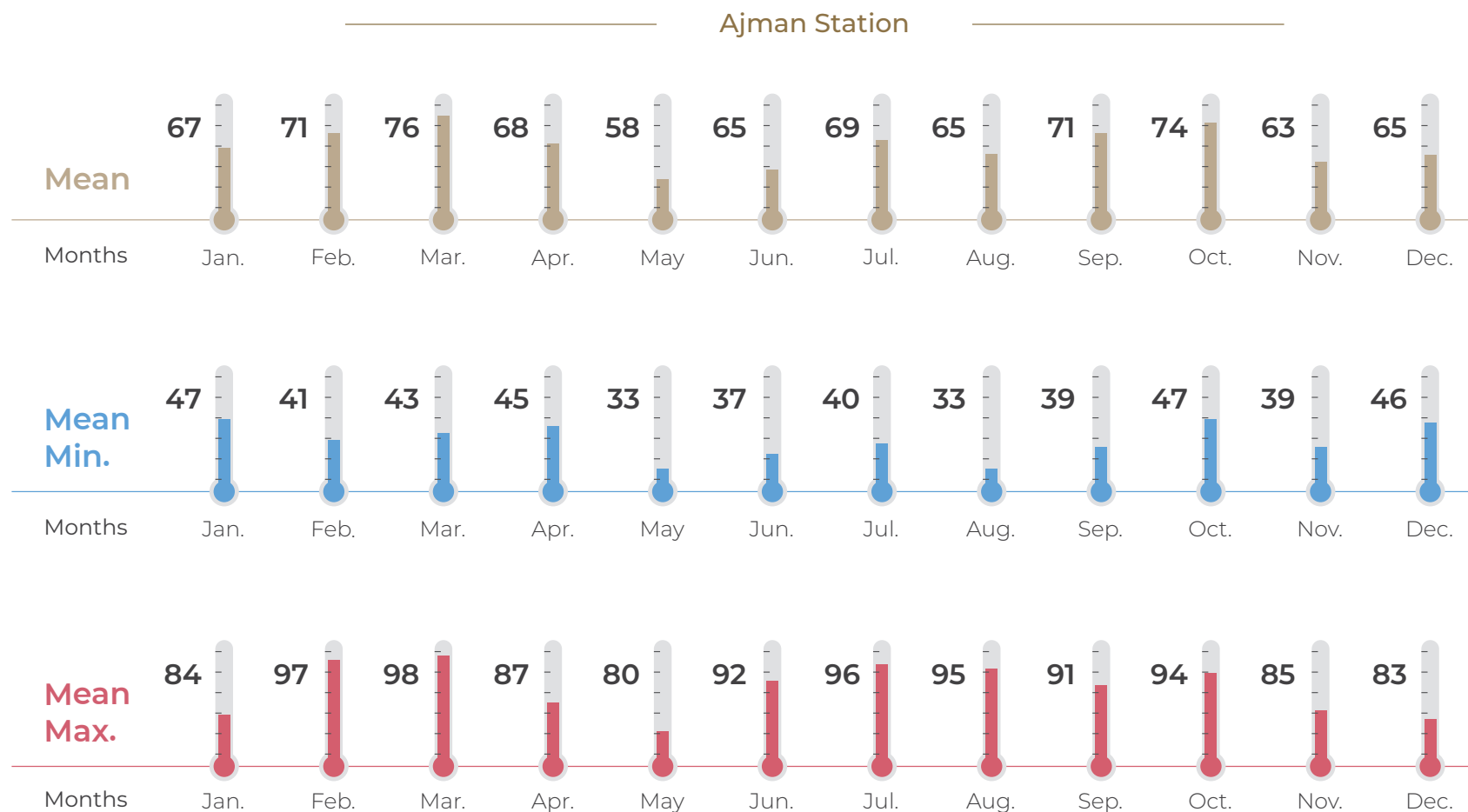

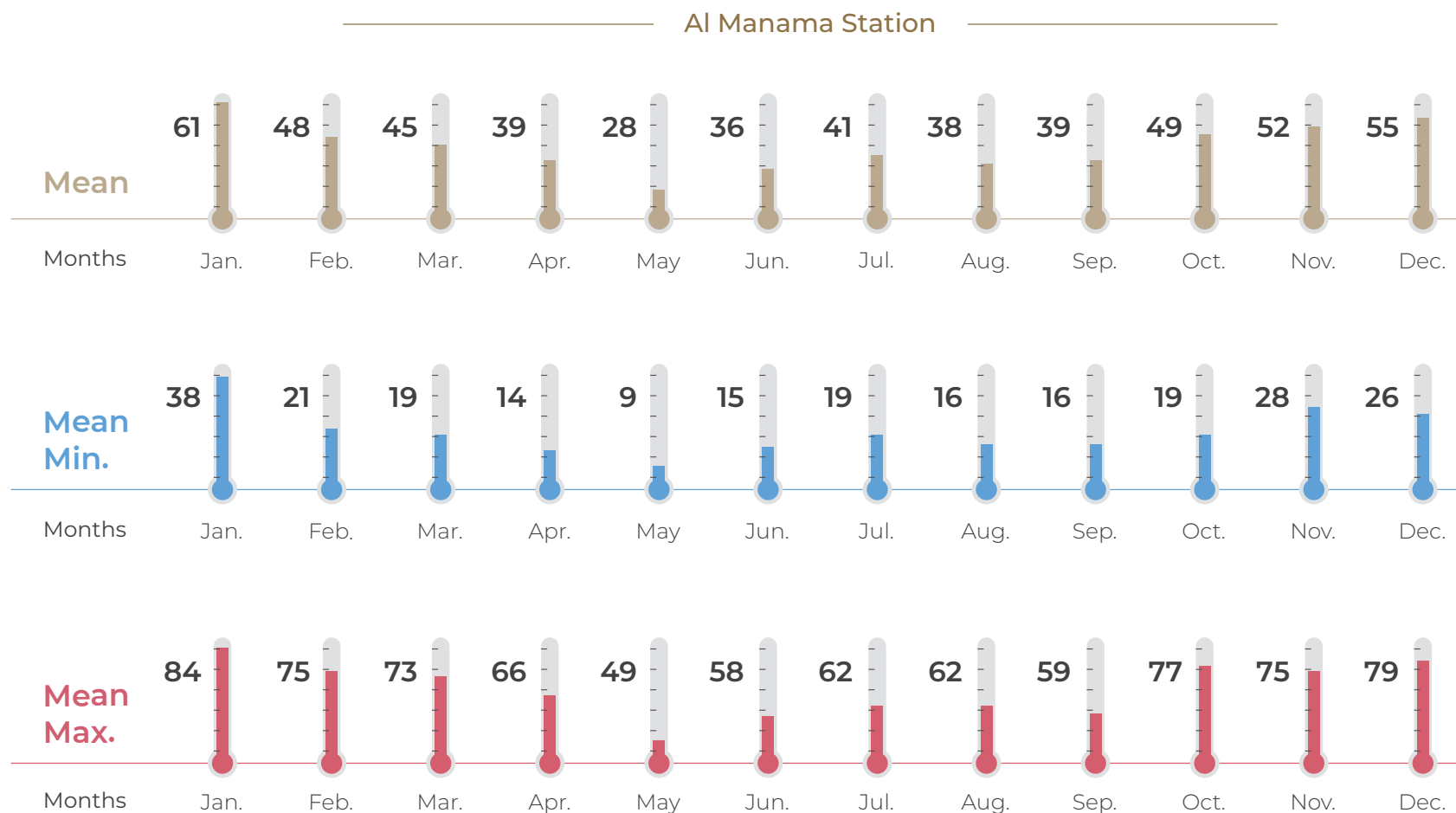
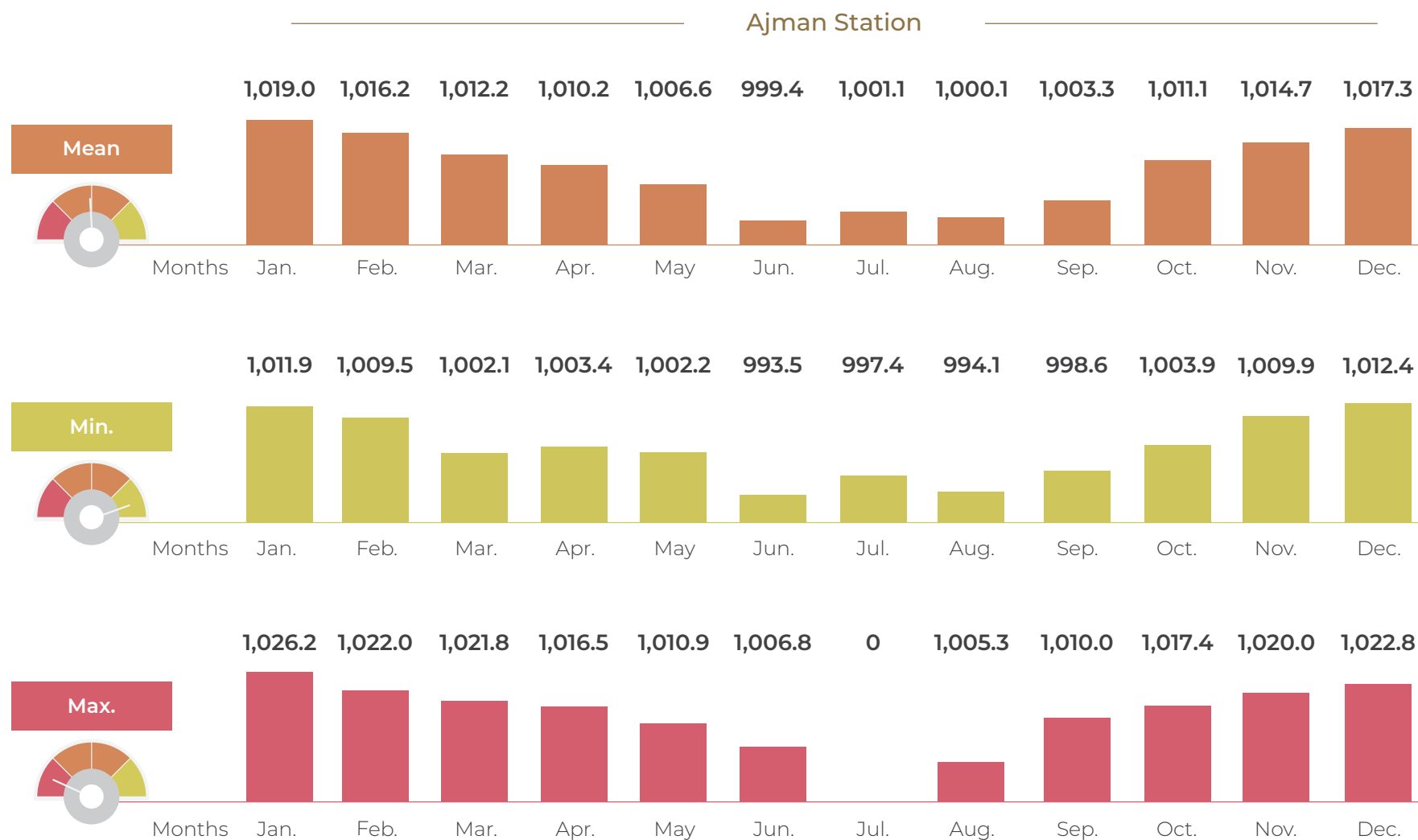




Figure (17-6): Measurements of Atmospheric Pressure at Sea Level by Month and Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

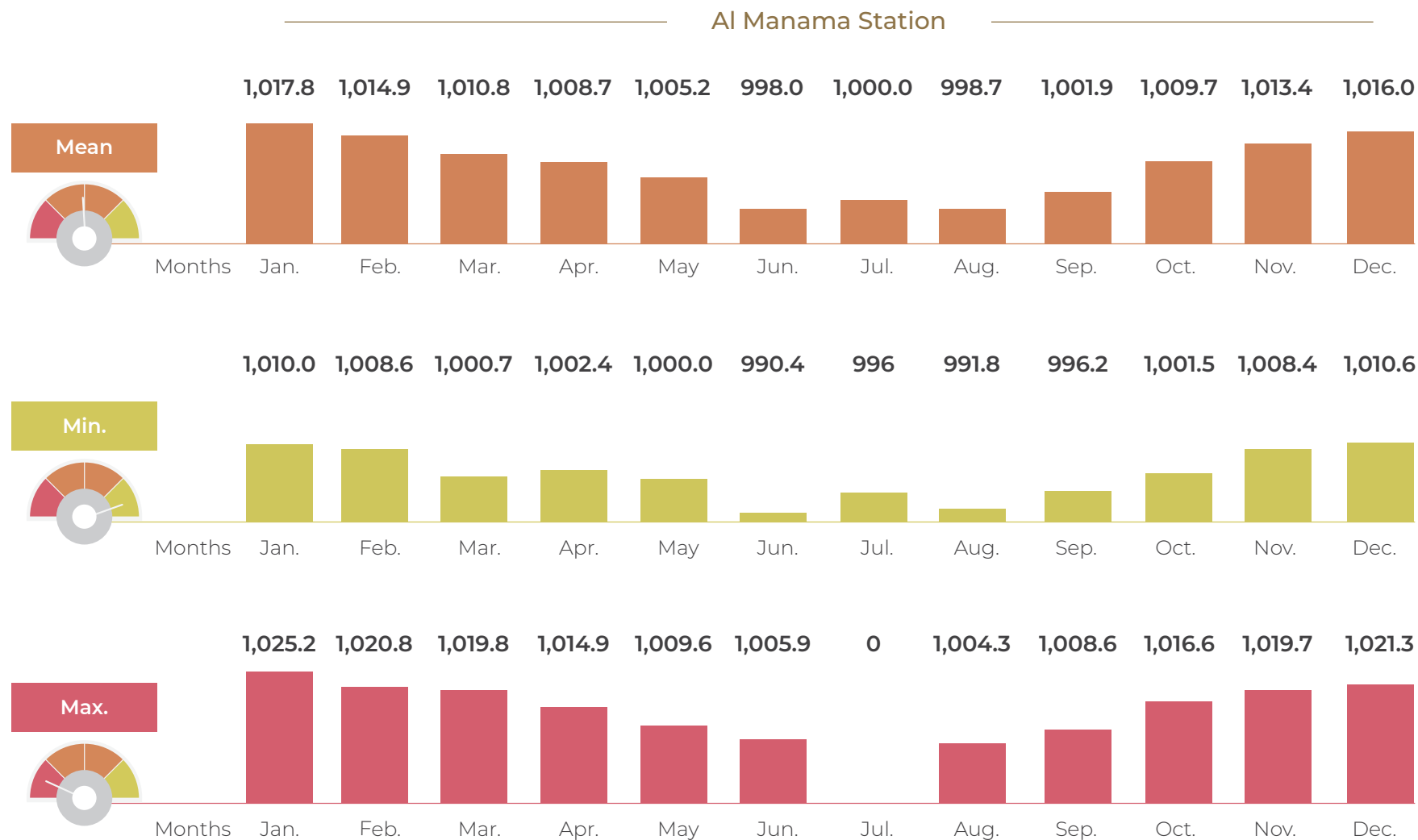

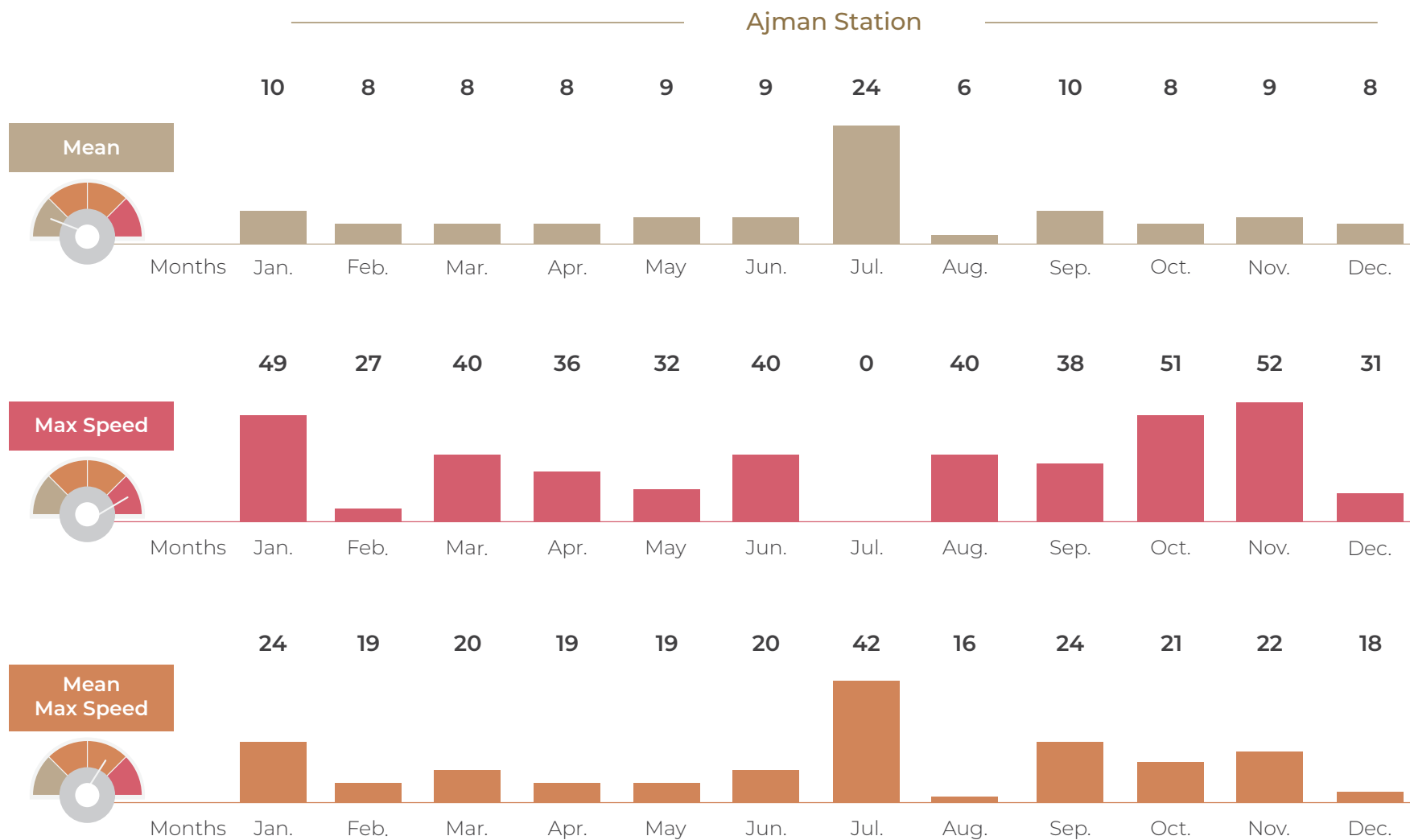

Figure (17-7): Wind Speed by Month & Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the Year 2023

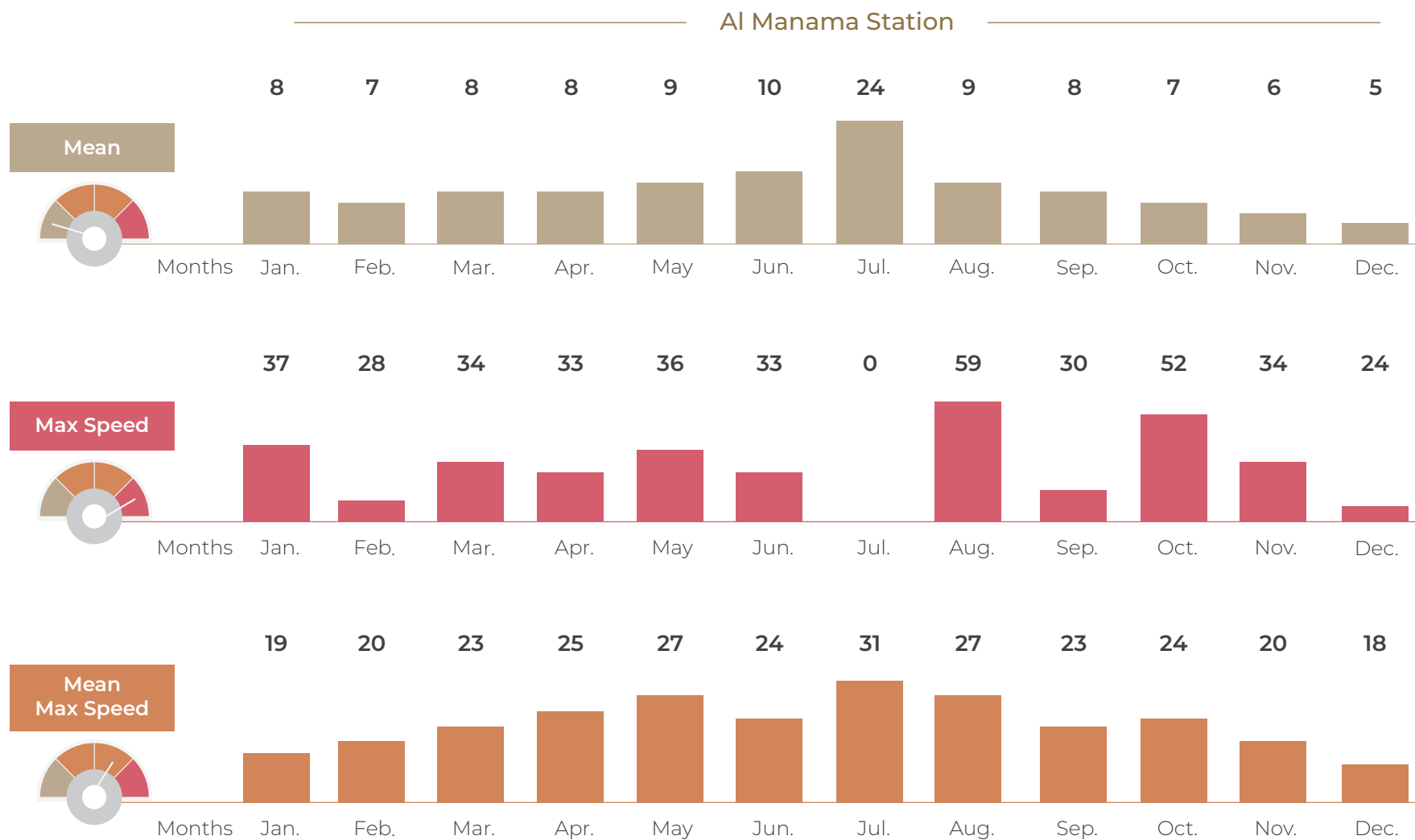

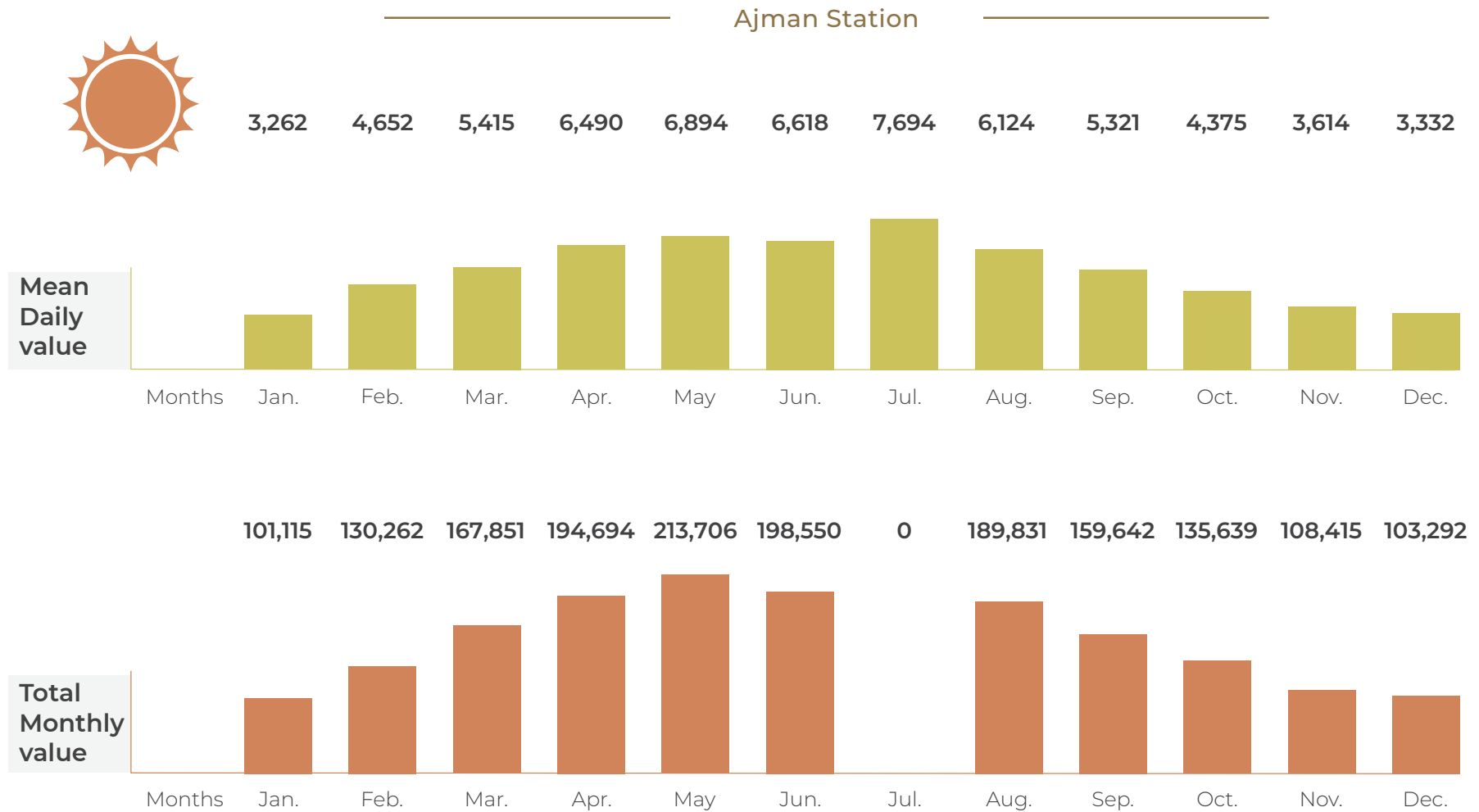

Figure (17-8): Daily Mean and Total Monthly of Solar Radiation by Month & Station in the Emirate of Ajman during the year 2023

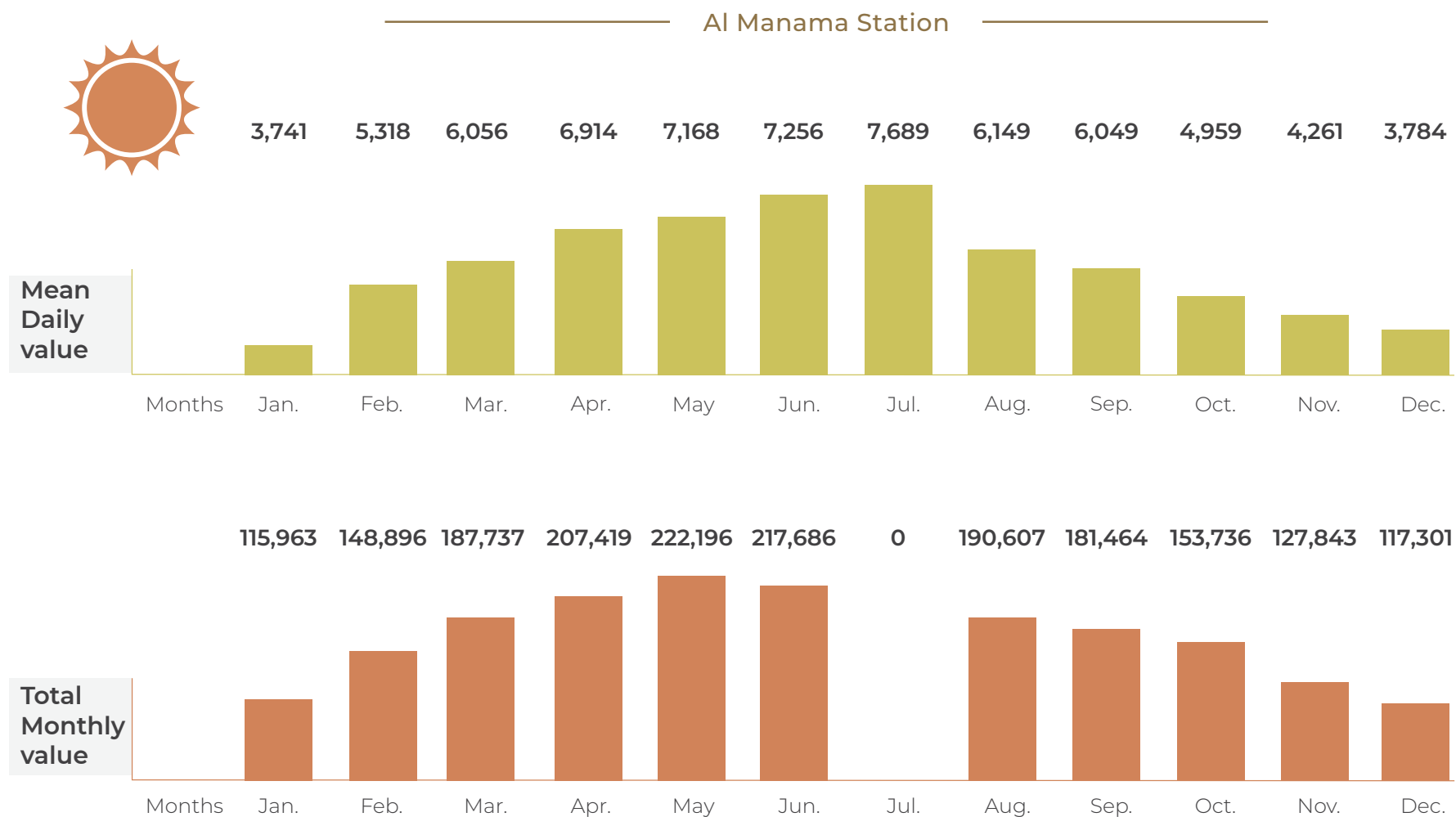
